SETTING THE STAGE

- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will make its home debut after opening the first two weeks on the road on Saturday, Sept. 15 when the Skyhawks play host to in-state foe Chattanooga. Kickoff from Hardy M. Graham Stadium is scheduled for 3 p.m. as part of UT Martin Family Weekend and will be broadcast live on ESPN+.
- The Skyhawks (0-2) enter the contest looking to pick up their first victory of the season after opening the year with a pair of Football Championship Subdivision (FBS) opponents in Missouri (L, 51-14) and Middle Tennessee (61-37). In the team's most recent outing, the Skyhawks pushed the Blue Raiders late into the contest, trimming the deficit to as close at 10 points in the fourth quarter while notching the most total points against a FBS program in school history.
- Sophomore quarterback Dresser Winn put on a show in Murfreesboro en route to OVC Offensive Player of the Week honors, setting new career highs in completions (34), attempts (53), yards (355) and touchdowns (four) against Middle Tennessee. The sophomore notched a touchdown in each quarter, tallying touchdown completions of 16, 11, 51 and 8 yards, respectively. Joining in the action was newcomer Terry Williams (11 and 8-yard receptions) who tallied a pair of touchdown receptions while Devonte Howard (16-yard reception), LaDarius Galloway (51-yard reception) and Jaimiee Bowe (37-yard rush) also notched touchdowns in the contest.
- Once again the linebacker duo of James Gilleylen and Kevin Prather, Jr. proved dynamic on defense. The pair combined to tally 19 tackles – including 16 solos – while each notching a sack in the contest. As a whole, the Skyhawks tallied seven tackles for loss and four sacks in the game.
- UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson is currently in his 13th season at the helm of the Skyhawks with an overall record of 78-61. Simpson currently ranks seventh in OVC history in career victories while serving as the league's longest active tenured head coach. Chattanooga is coached by Tom Arth who has posted a 45-16 mark in five seasons - including 5-8 mark in his second season at Chattanooga.
- Chattanooga (2-0) enters the contest unbeaten after knocking off OVC foe Tennessee Tech (34-10) and The Citadel (29-28) in overtime. The Mocs boast junior quarterback Nick Tiano who has completed 37-of-60 pass attempts for 665 yards and four touchdowns on the year. Junior Tyrell Price leads the ground attack with 37 carries for 169 yards and three touchdowns while sophomore Bryce Nunnelly has hauled in 17 receptions for 429 yards and three touchdowns. Meanwhile on defense, the duo of Isaiah Mack and Marshall Cooper has combined for 44 tackles, 2.5 TFL and 1.5 sacks.
- Saturday's contest serves as the sixth meeting between the two programs with the Mocs holding a narrow 3-2 series advantage. The Skyhawks have won the last two matchups, a 31-21 contest in 2013 and a 21-7 game a year ago, in which both times the Mocs were nationally ranked.

PLAYER TO WATCH

#3 • Dresser Winn • QB So. • Dresden, Tenn.

Winn posted career-highs in completions (34), attempts (53), yards (355) and touchdowns (four) in UT Martin's contest at Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent Middle Tennessee. The sophomore notched a touchdown in each quarter – keeping the Skyhawks in a game in which the team trailed by only 10 points in the fourth quarter. Winn had touchdowns of 16, 11, 51 and 8 yards, including a pair to junior Terry Williams.

Winn's 34 completions and 54 attempts were the sixth-most in program history while the 355 yards ranked as the 20th-most passing yards in program history in just his seventh collegiate start. Winn currently ranks eighth nationally in passing touchdowns (five), 10th in completions per game (24.5) and 22nd in passing yards per game (261.5). This marks Winn's first OVC Offensive Player of the Week honor after being named OVC Newcomer of the Week twice last season.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE AT A GLANCE

UT Martin posted a strong offensive showing against Middle Tennessee in the squad's second consecutive matchup against a FBS foe. The Skyhawks would tally 460 yards of total offense and score five touchdowns on the night to tally 37 points - ranking as the most points scored against a FBS opponent in program history. Sophomore quarterback, Dresser Winn set new career highs in nearly every statistical category with 34-of-53 completions for 355 yards and four touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Terry Williams tallied a pair of touchdown receptions while Jaylon Moore eclipsed the 100-yard mark with 113 receiving yards. The Skyhawks also forced and recovered one fumble and a onside kick.

THE JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

UT Martin football coach Jason Simpson has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now entering his 13th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 78 wins - sitting seventh in OVC history. In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 61-34 through 12 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 61 conference wins currently ranks sixth in OVC history.

WILLIAMS FINDS HIS WAY

Junior transfer Terry Williams proved ellusive at Itawamba Community College, earning several All-American honors. In just two games for the Skyhawks, he has shown that his nine touchdown receptions in 2017 was no fluke. Williams posted the best game of his young Skyhawk career by tallying 10 receptions for 70 yards and a pair of touchdowns against Conference USA foe Middle Tennessee on Saturday, Sept. 8.

BOWE RETURNS TO THE FOLD

With 9:34 to play in the second quarter of the season opener at Missouri, junior Jaimiee Bowe returned to the endzone for the first time since 2016. Bowe – a 2017 Preseason All-OVC honoree – missed the entire 2017 campaign after suffering an Achilles injury early in fall camp. After battling through months of rehab, Bowe punctuated a seven-play scoring drive with his 11th career rushing touchdown to put the Skyhawks on the board. Bowe then broke lose for a 37-yard rushing touchdown against Middle Tennessee to notch his 12th career touchdown.

DUAL-HEADED LINEBACKER DUO

UT Martin knew that its senior duo of Kevin Prather, Jr. and James Gilleylen would be formidable, the duo is proving to be destructive all over the field. Prather enters Saturday's contest with 223 tackles, 28.5 tackles for loss and 7.0 sacks in his career meanwhile Gilleylen is right next to him with 226 tackles, 26.0 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks. The pair has combined to tally 20.3 (337/1659) percent of the team's total tackles over the past two seasons while notching 36 tackles, 7.0 TFLs and a pair of sacks in 2018.

NEW SKYHAWKS MAKE THEIR DEBUT

20 different players made their Skyhawk debut in the season opener against Missouri. Senior Nick Allen received the first game reps of his career while starting at left tackle while returners Mark Garrett (right guard), Austin Pickett (nose tackle), Andrew Horton-Martindale (cornerback) and Antonio Clifton (safety) also earned their first career starts. Meanwhile, a pair of JUCO transfers Ben Phillips, Jr. and DaVonte Maura garnered a start in their first games in a UT Martin uniform.

HIGH SCORING OUTPUT AGAINST FBS FOES

In Saturday's contest against Conference USA foe Middle Tennessee, the Skyhawks posted 37 points which ranked as the most points scored against a member of the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in program history. The Skyhawks' previous single-game high was a 36-point performance against Hawai'i on Sept. 10, 2016.

SEASON 99

The 2018 campaign is UT Martin's 99th season of football. The Skyhawks are in their 27th season at the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and compiled an overall record of 115-179 with one Ohio Valley Conference title (2006) and one NCAA Playoff appearance (2006) as a D-I program.

SKYHAWKS GARNER ESPN SPOTLIGHT

UT Martin currently has all 11 of the team's games available to a national audience through the ESPN family of networks. The Skyhawks will open the season against Missouri on SEC Network Alternate. UT Martin will then play on newly-launched ESPN+ for nine of the remaining 10 contests - minus the ESPN3 Game of the Week against Eastern Illinois on Oct. 20.

SKYHAWKS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The Ohio Valley Conference announced its preseason polls and all-conference performers in conjunction with the league's Football Media Day festivities held at Embassy Suites Nashville Airport on July 23. UT Martin was selected to finish third in the preseason poll as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors as well as the Preseason Media Poll. The Skyhawks tallied 95 overall points.

OVC SUPREMACY

Since the 2006 season, UT Martin has ranked as one of the best programs in the Ohio Valley Conference after winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league. The Skyhawks have clinched four winning season in the past six years while finishing .500 or above in conference play since 2006 - posting four top-two finishes during the span.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 12 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to a 78-59 record (.569 winning percentage) and a 61-34 mark against OVC opponents (.642 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 80 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 78 career victories rank seventh in OVC history while his 61 conference wins come in at sixth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 14 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013) and Tony Bell (2013, 2014).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011. Bell (Tennessee Titans). Butler (Baltimore Rayens). Derek Carr (New York Giants), Joe Este (Tennessee Titans), Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Brett Thompson (Pittsburgh Steelers), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts) and Caylon Weathers (Chicago Bears) have all received opportunities with NFL

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee five times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012 before reclaiming the trophy in 2014 and defending it in 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 23-10 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.
