SETTING THE STAGE

- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will leave the state of Tennessee for the first time in 28 days for a matchup across the border into the Bluegrass State with a matchup at Ohio Valley Conference foe Murray State on Saturday, Sept. 29. Kickoff from Stewart Stadium is scheduled for 6 p.m. and can be seen on ESPN+.
- The Skyhawks (1-3, 1-0 OVC) are looking to build upon some recent success after knocking off No. 21 ranked Austin Peay (37-7) convincingly at home last weekend for the team's first win of the season. The Skyhawks posted a complete team effort in the contest as the offense matched its high scoring output of the season while holding one of the league's best offenses to just seven points and 60 yards of total offense in the final three quarters of play. Included in the game, the Skyhawks tallied 15 tackles for loss totaling 70 yards which tied the program's single-game Division I record.
- Senior linebacker Garrett Wall was one of many bright spots for the Skyhawk defense, earning OVC Defensive Player of the Week honors after notching a career-best 13 tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss, a half-sack, a forced fumble and a quarterback hurry. The pair of Kevin Prather, Jr. (11 tackles, 3.0 TFL) and Brandon Anderson (10 tackles, 1.5 TFL) also notched double-digit tackle performances while Andrew Horton-Martindale and Wayna Moton each tallied interceptions.
- Offensively, the team is led by sophomore quarterback Dresser Winn who leads the league in passing yards (255.8 ypg) and ranks second in total offense (262.8 ypg). Winn has completed 65.5 percent of his passes for 1,022 yards and eight touchdowns. The pair of wide receiver Terry Williams (113.3 ypg) and running back LaDarius Galloway (98.0 ypg) each average close to 100-all-purpose yards per game to highlight the skill positions.
- The game will feature a head coaching matchup of UT Martin's Jason Simpson and Murray State's Mitch Stewart. Simpson ranks sixth in OVC history with a 62 conference wins while boasting a 79-62 overall mark in 13 seasons. Meanwhile, Stewart has posted a 10-26 record in his fourth season at the helm of the Racers.
- Murray State (0-3, 0-0 OVC) is still searching for its first win of the season coming off a bye in Week 4 of the season. The Racers enter the contest averaging 11.0 points per game while droppings contest to Southern Illinois (49-10), nationally ranked Central Arkansas (26-13) and Kentucky (48-10) prior to an off week in the schedule. The team has scored just three touchdowns to date by the trio of D.J. Penick, Preston Price and James Sappington. Defensively, the squad is led by Quincy Williams with 27 tackles and 2.5 TFL.
- Rivals located just 50 miles apart will meet for the 58th time on the gridiron on Saturday with Murray State holding a 36-20-1 series advantage. Despite the lopsided series results, UT Martin has held its own as of late, winning 11 of the last 13 meetings while averaging 46.5 points per game during that span.

AUSTIN PEAY AT A GLANCE

The Skyhawks picked up their first win of the season while taking an early lead in the Sgt. York Trophy series with a dominating 37-7 victory over Austin Peay in the two teams' OVC opener. After allowing a first quarter touchdown to the Govs, UT Martin would control the game from there by shutting out the Govs and allowing just 60 yards of total offense over the final three quarters of play. The defense unit would tie the school's Division I record with 15 tackles for loss, totaling 70 yards. On the offensive side, Dresser Winn found Jaylon Moore for a 20-yard reception while keeping one for himself on a 13-yard rushing scamper. Along with a 75-yard kick return touchdown by Peyton Logan, the Skyhawks capped off their scoring performance with rushing touchdowns by Jaimiee Bowe and Joe Hudson along with a 36-yard field goal by Ryan Courtright.

THE JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

UT Martin football coach Jason Simpson has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now entering his 13th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 79 wins - sitting seventh in OVC history. In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 62-34 through 12 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 62 conference wins currently ranks sixth in OVC history.

OVC SUPREMACY

Since the 2006 season, UT Martin has ranked as one of the best programs in the Ohio Valley Conference after winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league. SGT YORK TROPHY SERIES

UT Martin opened the 2018 season looking to regain control of the annual Sgt. York Trophy trophy series which pits Tennessee members of the Ohio Valley Conference for state supremacy. UT Martin has won or shared the Sgt. York Trophy in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016. The Skyhawks hold a 24-10 all-time record in the series - the best mark of the four Tennessee OVC schools (Austin Peay, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech). That includes a 15-4 mark since 2012.

SKYHAWKS TIE PROGRAM RECORD AGAINST AUSTIN PEAY

A big part in the Skyhawks' 37-7 victory over Austin Peay on Sept. 22 came on the shoulders of the team's dominant defense. The Govs would be limited to just 60 yards of total offense in the final three quarters of play, due in large part to 15 tackles for loss by the Skyhawks in the contest - tying the program's Division I single-game record. As a whole, UT Martin has tallied five games with 15 tackles for loss as a FCS member institution.

GARRETT WALL NAMED OVC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

A native of Fairview, Tenn., Wall made a huge impact in the Skyhawks' 37-7 OVC-opening victory against the Governors. After tallying just 11 combined tackles in the season's first three games, he collected a career-best 13 tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss, a half-sack, one forced fumble, one pass breakup and a quarterback hurry to create havoc in the contest. He helped anchor a UT Martin defensive unit that tied the school's Division I record in tackles for loss (15) while limiting the high-powered Austin Peay offense to just 60 yards of total offense over the final three quarters.

LOGAN TAKES IT TO THE HOUSE

For the second time in his career, Preseason All-OVC sophomore specialist Peyton Logan found an opening and didn't stop running until he crossed into the endzone. With a short field set up following a penalty, Logan took advantage against Austin Peay on Sept. 22, returning a kickoff return to open the second half 75 yards for a touchdown. The touchdown marked the second return of his career, joining a 95-yard return against Eastern Kentucky on Oct. 21, 2017.

RUNNING BACKS ECLIPSE 1,000-YARD MARK FOR CAREER

The running back duo of LaDarius Galloway and Jaimiee Bowe both reached a career milestone against Austin Peay on Sept. 22, reaching the 1,000-yard rushing mark for their respective Skyhawk careers. Galloway has tallied 1,055 career yards in 14 games while Bowe has notched 1,017 yards in 24 games.

WILLIAMS FINDS HIS WAY

Junior transfer Terry Williams proved elusive at Itawamba Community College, earning several All-American honors. In just three games for the Skyhawks, he has shown that his nine touchdown receptions in 2017 was no fluke. Williams posted the best game of his young Skyhawk career by tallying 10 receptions for 70 yards and a pair of touchdowns against Conference USA foe Middle Tennessee on Saturday, Sept. 8. Then against Chattanooga he tallied 141 receiving yards and 229 yards of all-purpose yards.

BOWE RETURNS TO THE FOLD

With 9:34 to play in the second quarter of the season opener at Missouri, junior Jaimiee Bowe returned to the endzone for the first time since 2016. Bowe - a 2017 Preseason All-OVC honoree - missed the entire 2017 campaign after suffering an Achilles injury early in fall camp. After battling through months of rehab, Bowe punctuated a seven-play scoring drive with his 11th career rushing touchdown to put the Skyhawks on the board. So far this season, Bowe has tallied three touchdowns to bring his career total to 13. Bowe now needs just two more touchdowns to move into the career-top 10, tying Trent Garland and Nate Holmes with 15.

QUICK HITS

DUAL-HEADED LINEBACKER DUO

UT Martin knew that its senior duo of Kevin Prather, Jr. and James Gilleylen would be formidable, the duo is proving to be destructive all over the field. Prather enters Saturday's contest with 243 tackles, 33.5 tackles for loss and 7.0 sacks in his career meanwhile Gilleylen is right next to him with 239 tackles, 26.0 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks. The pair has combined to tally 26.5 (482/1815) percent of the team's total tackles over the past two seasons while notching 69 tackles, 12.0 TFLs and a pair of sacks in 2018.

ON-SIDE TRICKERY

During the 2018 season, the Skyhawks have successfully recovered both of its on-side kick attempts with one at Middle Tennessee and another against Chattanooga in back-to-back contests. The only other season in which the Skyhawks recovered at least two on-side kicks in a single season in the past 20 years was during 2011 when UT Martin was 2-of-4.

CHATTANOOGA AT A GLANCE

The Skyhawks are still looking for their first win of the season despite trimming the margin to as close as 10 points on a pair of occasions in the fourth quarter against Chattanooga. With the deficit down to just 10 points late in the fourth quarter following an onside kick, the Skyhawks would push the ball all the way down to the Chattanooga three-yard line but would see its final offensive stand fall short at the goal line to seal the contest. UT Martin tallied 23 first downs on the day while notching 457 yards of total offense but a pair of first half turnovers kept the squad off the scoreboard until the final seconds of the second period.

DRESSER WINN NAMED OVC AND TSWA OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sophomore quarterback Dresser Winn posted career-highs in completions (34), attempts (53), yards (355) and touchdowns (four) in UT Martin's contest at Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent Middle Tennessee to earn adidas OVC Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Tennessee Sports Writers Association Offensive Player of the Week honors. The sophomore notched a touchdown in each quarter – keeping the Skyhawks in a game in which the team trailed by only 10 points in the fourth quarter. Winn had touchdowns of 16, 11, 51 and 8 yards, including a pair to junior Terry Williams. Winn's 34 completions and 54 attempts were the sixth-most in program history while the 355 yards ranked as the 20th-most passing yards in program history in just his seventh collegiate start.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE AT A GLANCE

UT Martin posted a strong offensive showing against Middle Tennessee in the squad's second consecutive matchup against a FBS foe. The Skyhawks would tally 460 yards of total offense and score five touchdowns on the night to tally 37 points - ranking as the most points scored against a FBS opponent in program history. Sophomore quarterback, Dresser Winn set new career highs in nearly every statistical category with 34-of-53 completions for 355 yards and four touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Terry Williams tallied a pair of touchdown receptions while Jaylon Moore eclipsed the 100-yard mark with 113 receiving yards. The Skyhawks also forced and recovered one fumble and a onside kick.

HIGH SCORING OUTPUT AGAINST FBS FOES

In Saturday's contest against Conference USA foe Middle Tennessee, the Skyhawks posted 37 points which ranked as the most points scored against a member of the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in program history. The Skyhawks' previous single-game high was a 36-point performance against Hawai'i on Sept. 10, 2016.

MISSOURI AT A GLANCE

UT Martin opened the season at SEC foe Missouri, marking its eighth season-opener against a FBS-member program since 2006. The Skyhawks would prove no match to the offensive powerhouse of Drew Luck (four passing touchdowns) and the Tiger offense. The Skyhawks offensive day would be highlighted by a one-yard rushing touchdown by Jaimiee Bowe and a 51-yard touchdown reception from Dresser Winn to LaDarius Galloway down the right sideline.

NEW SKYHAWKS MAKE THEIR DEBUT

20 different players made their Skyhawk debut in the season opener against Missouri. Senior Nick Allen received the first game reps of his career while starting at left tackle while returners Mark Garrett (right guard), Austin Pickett (nose tackle), Andrew Horton-Martindale (cornerback) and Antonio Clifton (safety) also earned their first career starts. Meanwhile, a pair of JUCO transfers Ben Phillips, Jr. and DaVonte Maura garnered a start in their first games in a UT Martin uniform.

SKYHAWKS FIND TEMPORARY HOME IN SEC

The Skyhawks are very familiar with playing teams from the Southeastern Conference. UT Martin has one SEC team on its schedule in 2018, as it will play Missouri on Saturday, Sept. 1. In the last 10 years, the Skyhawks have played Auburn (2008), Tennessee (2010), Mississippi State (2011, 2014), Kentucky (2014) and Ole Miss (2015, 2017). UT Martin will also play Florida and Kentucky in 2019 and Alabama in 2020.

TAKING IT UP A NOTCH

UT Martin has been no stranger to playing competition from the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) over the years. The Skyhawks will have played 21 different FBS games since 2006, including a stretch from 2011-16 in which UT Martin played at least two FBS games per year. The Skyhawks are 1-21 in games against FBS opponents under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson

SKYHAWKS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The Ohio Valley Conference announced its preseason polls and all-conference performers in conjunction with the league's Football Media Day festivities held at Embassy Suites Nashville Airport on July 23. UT Martin was selected to finish third in the preseason poll as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors as well as the Preseason Media Poll. The Skyhawks tallied 95 overall points.

SEASON 99

The 2018 campaign is UT Martin's 99th season of football. The Skyhawks are in their 27th season at the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and compiled an overall record of 115-180 with one Ohio Valley Conference title (2006) and one NCAA Playoff appearance (2006) as a D-I program.

SKYHAWKS GARNER ESPN SPOTLIGHT

UT Martin currently has all 11 of the team's games available to a national audience through the ESPN family of networks. The Skyhawks will open the season against Missouri on SEC Network Alternate. UT Martin will then play on newly-launched ESPN+ for nine of the remaining 10 contests - minus the ESPN3 Game of the Week against Eastern Illinois on Oct. 20.

SKYHAWK DEFENSE LEADS THE WAY

UT Martin relied heavily on its explosive defense to pave the way for success the last two years. In 2017, the Skyhawks - often referred to as the "Darkside" - finished the regular season ranked nationally in the top- 10 in red zone defense (third, 60.6 percent), scoring defense (fourth, 14.3), third down conversion defense (fifth, 28.7 percent), total defense (sixth, 273.8 ypg), punt return defense (seventh, 3.59), first downs defense (eighth, 168 ypg), team passing efficiency defense (eighth, 104.3), fourth down conversion defense (eighth, 28.6 percent), kickoff returns (eighth, 24.33 ypr) and passing yards allowed (ninth, 159.9 ypg). Not only did the team's 14.3 points allowed per game rank fourth nationally, it set a new program record.

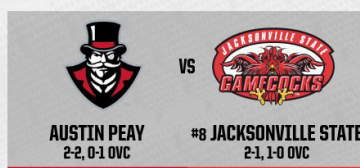

JASON SIMPSON

HEAD COACH • 13TH YEAR

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 12 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to a 78-59 record (.569 winning percentage) and a 61-34 mark against OVC opponents (.642 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 80 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 78 career victories rank seventh in OVC history while his 61 conference wins come in at sixth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 14 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013) and Tony Bell (2013, 2014).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Bell (Tennessee Titans), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Joe Este (Tennessee Titans), Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Brett Thompson (Pittsburgh Steelers), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts) and Caylon Weathers (Chicago Bears) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - five times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012 before reclaiming the trophy in 2014 and defending it in 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 23-10 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.
