• The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will hit the road for the Ohio Valley Conference ESPN3 Game of the Week with a matchup against Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Oct. 5. Kickoff from Roy Kidd Stadium is scheduled for 2 p.m.

• The game serves as a matchup of two of the best OVC programs in recent history. Since 2008, Eastern Kentucky (67) and UT Martin (64) rank second and third, respectively, in league victories. The two programs have combined for nine top-two OVC finishes during that span.

• The Skyhawks (2-2, 1-0 OVC) dominated from start to finish, scoring in every quarter against Murray State their last time out. The Racers were limited to 17 rushing yards, ranking as the fewest rushing yards allowed since also limiting Murray State to 17 yards in 2017 while being held scoreless in the second half. Offensively, the Skyhawks eclipsed the 500-yard mark for total offense for the first time since tallying 509 yards against Eastern Kentucky in 2016 while recording zero turnovers for the first time in over two seasons.

• Redshirt-sophomore quarterback John Bachus III was rewarded for his strong play after setting career-highs in completions (26), attempts (40) and yards (312) in the contest while also adding a pair of touchdowns – through the air and on the ground – to earn OVC Newcomer of the Week honors. Defensive standouts came in the form of JaQuez Akins and Kameron Bowdry. Akins boasted his team-lead with nine tackles while both forcing and recovering a fumble in the contest. Bowdry recorded four tackles but also forced a pair of fumbles along with tallying 1.5 tackles for loss.

• UT Martin is led by 14th-year head coach Jason Simpson who enters the contest boasting an 82-70 career mark, ranking sixth in OVC history in victories. Eastern Kentucky is led by head coach Mark Elder who has posted a 16-21 record in four seasons at the helm.

• Eastern Kentucky (3-2, 1-0 OVC) enters the contest having rushed for 379 yards while tallying 525 yards of total offense against Tennessee State last week. The Colonels saw a pair of rushers eclipse the 100-yard plateau with Daryl McCleskey tallying 202 yards and a pair of touchdowns on just 16 carries – averaging 12.6 yards per attempt – while Alonzo Booth ripped 12 carries for 115 yards and a pair of touchdowns. So far this season, the tandem has tallied 115 carries for 955 yards and 11 touchdowns.

• Saturday's contest marks the 30th matchup between UT Martin and Eastern Kentucky with the Colonels holding a significant advantage in the series with a 25-4 mark. Despite the overall record, the Skyhawks have tallied four wins against the Colonels during the Simpson era while posting a 4-5 mark in the last nine meetings.

Redshirt-freshman John Bachus III found his stride in his fourth career start, completing 65 percent of his passes (26-of-40) for 312 yards while tallying two total touchdowns. He tallied new career-highs in completions, attempts and yards in the contest. His first touchdown came on a 47-yard completion in the first quarter before recording his first rushing touchdown midway through the second quarter.

THE JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

UT Martin football coach Jason Simpson has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now in his 14th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 82 wins - sitting sixth in OVC history. In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 64-40 through 14 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 64 conference wins currently ranks sixth in OVC history.

OVC SUPREMACY

Since the 2006 season, UT Martin has ranked as one of the best programs in the Ohio Valley Conference after winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league. The Skyhawks have clinched four winning seasons in the past seven years while finishing .500 or above in conference play in 12 of the last 13 seasons - posting four top-two finishes during the span.

BACHUS NAMED OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

John Bachus III accounted for 345 yards of total offense and two touchdowns as UT Martin began OVC play with a 40-7 win over rival Murray State. The redshirt freshman completed 26-of-40 passes for 312 yards and connected with Lamarqus Young on a 47-yard touchdown strike in the first quarter. In the second quarter he added a 1-yard touchdown score that put the Skyhawks ahead 24-0. Bachus tallied new career-highs in completions, attempts and yards in the victory.

This year marks the 150th anniversary of college football which began on November 6, 1869 when Princeton played Rutgers. QUICK HITS

MURRAY STATE AT A GLANCE

UT Martin jumped out to an early lead and never looked back, scoring in every quarter of the game while holding Murray State scoreless in the second half. The Skyhawks tallied 500 yards of total offense for the first time since 2017 while holding the Racers to just 17 rushing yards in the contest.

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AT A GLANCE

UT Martin tallied a pair of touchdowns on its first two possessions of the game while notching 136 total yards of offense. From that point on, the Skyhawks would give up 28 unanswered points to Southern Illinois while recording just 140 yards throughout the rest of the game. The Salukis would do their damage on the ground, tallying 264 rushing yards.

MOORE BIG PLAYS FOR JAYLON

Senior wide receiver Jaylon Moore has made a knack of making big plays for the Skyhawks throughout his career. Moore has tallied 20 plays of 25 yards or more - including 11 of which were touchdown receptions. As a whole, Moore has tallied touchdowns of 75, 67, 52, 49, 43, 37, 32, 28, 26, 25, and 20 yards.

TOUCHDOWN TRIFECTA

Against Northwestern State, UT Martin scored a touchdown in all three phases of the game: offense, defense and special teams. The Skyhawks tallied four offensive touchdowns, a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown and a 55-yard punt return for a touchdown for the special trifecta. The last time the Skyhawks accomplished such a feat was on Sept. 27, 2008 against Murray State when UT Martin tallied six offensive touchdowns, two defensive scores and an 83-yard kick return for a touchdown.

MOTON EARNS NUMEROUS WEEKLY HONORS

Redshirt-sophomore Wanya Moton picked numerous accolades after an impressive showing against Northwestern State. Moton was named OVC Defensive Player of the Week, TSWA Defensive Player of the Week and an honorable mention STATS FCS Defensive Player of the Week after tallying seven tackles and a pair of interceptions in the season opener. His interceptions came in big situations, tallying a 12-yard return in the second quarter before returning an interception all the way to the house with a 78-yard return in the fourth quarter to give the Skyhawks a two-score advantage. He currently ranks first in the country in interceptions (two) and interceptions per game (2.0).

WILLIAMS NAMED OVC SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

Senior wide receiver Terry Williams played a big role in the Skyhawks opening victory over Northwestern State, tallying 199 all-purpose yards, including a touchdown to earn OVC Specialist of the Week honors. Williams tallied four punt returns for 98 yards, including a 55-yard punt return in the third quarter to give the Skyhawks an eight-point lead. He also tallied four kickoff returns for 73 yards, including a game-long 28-yard return. He leads the country in punt return touchdowns and punt returns while ranking third in kick returns and eighth in all-purpose yards.

LOGAN ECLIPSES THE CENTURY MARK

Peyton Logan recorded the first 100-yard rushing performance for the Skyhawks since Sept. 9, 2017 when LaDarius Galloway tallied 188 yards at Ole Miss. Logan tallied 13 carries for 149 yards and two touchdowns from 21 and 53 yards, respectively.

PICK SIX AND MORE

Sophomore Wanya Moton posted a big game against Northwestern State, tallying two interceptions to go along with his seven tackles. Moton returned his first touchdown 12 yards before notching a pick-six with a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown. His performance marked the first time a Skyhawk had tallied multiple interceptions in the same game since Kahlid Hagens tallied a pair of Nov. 12, 2016 against Southeast Missouri.

FLORIDA AT A GLANCE

UT Martin (1-1) played its third Top-25 squad from the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) with a matchup against No. 11 ranked Florida. The Skyhawks struggled to get its offense going against a fast and athletic defense while being shutout for the first time since 2017 in a 45-0 setback. With the loss, the Skyhawks moved to 0-10 against SEC programs all-time.

SKYHAWKS FIND TEMPORARY HOME IN SEC

The Skyhawks are very familiar with playing teams from the Southeastern Conference. UT Martin has two SEC teams on its schedule in 2019, as it will play Florida and Kentucky. QUICK HITS

SEASON 91

The 2019 campaign is UT Martin's 91th season of football despite suspending play during Great Depression (1933) and World War II (1942-45). The Skyhawks are in their 28th season at the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and compiled an overall record of 117-188 with one Ohio Valley Conference title (2006) and one NCAA Playoff appearance (2006) as a D-I program.

LAST CHANCE U

Junior transfer Marqwell Odom became the second Skyhawk to appear on the Netflix original series Last Chance U as a member of the fourth season, featuring Independence Community College. Former Skyhawk Marcus LeFlore also appeared on the season one of the show as a member of East Mississippi Community College.

NORTHWESTERN STATE AT A GLANCE

The Skyhawks (1-0) overcame a first half deficit in the season opener against Northwestern State, shutting out the Demons in the second half while scoring 28 unanswered points en route to a 42-20 victory. In the contest, UT Martin scored in every facet of the game including offense, defense and special teams for the first time since Sept. 27, 2008 with four offensive touchdowns, a 78-yard interception return and a 55-yard punt return against NSU.

NEW SKYHAWKS MAKE THEIR DEBUT

11 different players made their Skyhawk debut in the season opener against Northwestern State. Kelton Edwards (left guard), Malcolm Miller (right tackle) and Cam Ordway (defensive back) each earned their first career starts. Meanwhile, JaQuez Akins, Jamarius Landers, Cecil Cherry, Marquis Traylor, Christian LaBreche, Marqwell Odom, Deray Lawrence and Kenyonte Davis each played their first games in a UT Martin uniform.

SKYHAWKS GARNER ESPN SPOTLIGHT

UT Martin currently has all 12 of the team's games available to a national audience through the ESPN family of networks. The Skyhawks will open the season with nine of their 12 games on ESPN+ while matchups against Florida and Kentucky will be broadcast on one of the ESPNU in addition to the team's ESPN3 Game of the Week against Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Oct. 12.

THREE SKYHAWKS TABBED TO PRESEASON ALL-OVC SQUAD

The Skyhawk senior trio of Terry Fultz, Julian Crutchfield and Austin Pickett were each honored at the OVC's annual Media Day by being tabbed to the Preseason All-OVC squad as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors. Fultz started all 11 games on the offensive line a season ago while the defensive line pair of Crutchfield and Pickett started all 11 games and combined for 77 tackles.

UT MARTIN PICKED TO FINISH SEVENTH

The Ohio Valley Conference announced its preseason polls and all-conference performers in conjunction with the league's Football Media Day festivities held at Embassy Suites Nashville Airport on July 22. UT Martin was selected to finish seventh in the preseason poll as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors as well as the Preseason Media Poll. The Skyhawks tallied 60 overall points.

SKYHAWKS GARNER NINE SPOTS ON PHIL STEELE PRESEASON ALL-OVC LIST

A total of eight UT Martin football players garnered nine spots on the annual Phil Steele Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference teams. The pair of Julian Crutchfield (defensive line) and Ryan Courtright (place kicker) took home first team honors while Jaylon Moore (wide receiver), Terry Fultz (offensive line), Austin Pickett (defensive line), Peyton Logan (kick return) and Terry Williams (punt return) were second team selections. Williams also earned third team honors as a wide receiver while TJ Jefferson made the squad at linebacker.

JASON SIMPSON

HEAD COACH • 14TH YEAR

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 80-68 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 63-42 mark against OVC opponents (.600 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 83 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 81 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 63 conference wins come in at sixth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 14 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013) and Tony Bell (2013, 2014).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - six times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012 and 2018 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 25-11 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.
