- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will look to build upon the team's recent three-game winning streak with an Ohio Valley Conference home matchup against league rival Eastern Illinois on Saturday, Oct. 19. Kickoff from Hardy M. Graham Stadium is scheduled for 2 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- The game serves as a matchup of two of the best OVC programs in recent history. Since 2008, UT Martin and Eastern Illinois rank third and fourth, respectively, in league victories during the span. The contest also serves as the 25th meeting between the two program since 1995 with the Panthers holding a 15-9 series advantage. Despite trailing in the overall series, the Skyhawks have won six of the last nine matchups against the Panthers.
- The Skyhawks (4-2, 3-0 OVC) continued their hot play by winning their third consecutive OVC matchup with a commanding 55-14 road victory at Tennessee Tech. UT Martin would score a total of seven touchdowns while adding a pair of field goals to cap off an evening in which the team tallied a season-high 553 yards of total offense. The Skyhawks also scored a season-high 55 points which ranked as the high scoring output against an OVC foe since 2014 against Murray State. With the victory, UT Martin is 3-0 in OVC play for the first time since 2006 and just the second time in program history.
- Freshman quarterback John Bachus III was recognized as the OVC Offensive Player of the Week, CFPA FCS National Performer of the Week and OVC Newcomer of the Week after setting new career-highs with 331 passing yards and five touchdowns. Highlighting the playmakers was Peyton Logan and Colton Dowell. Logan tallied his third 100-yard rushing performance of the season along with a touchdown while Dowell recorded five receptions for 154 yards and two touchdowns. On the defensive side, TJ Jefferson tallied 12 tackles and 2.5 sacks while the team notched seven sacks in the contest.
- UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson enters the contest with a career mark of 84-70 to rank sixth in OVC history. Simpson needs just one win to tie former UT Martin head coach Bob Carroll for the program's all-time wins record of 85 victories.
- Eastern Illinois (0-7, 0-3 OVC) is looking to record its first win of the season under first-year head coach Adam Cushing. The Panthers average 12.1 points and 271.9 yards of total offense per game. Despite the team's recent struggles, the average margin of defeat in OVC play is 8.6 points per game.

John Bachus III was highly efficient en route to a career night against Tennessee Tech. Bachus completed 16-of-22 pass attempts (72.7 percent) for 331 yards and five touchdowns against the Golden Eagles. He tallied career-highs in both yards and touchdowns - the most since 2015. He would find eight different receivers in the contest while averaging 20.7 yards per completion.

THE JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

UT Martin football coach Jason Simpson has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now in his 14th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 84 wins - sitting sixth in OVC history. In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 66-40 through 14 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 64 conference wins currently ranks sixth in OVC history.

OVC SUPREMACY

Since the 2006 season, UT Martin has ranked as one of the best programs in the Ohio Valley Conference after winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league. The Skyhawks have clinched four winning season in the past seven years while finishing .500 or above in conference play in 12 of the last 13 seasons - posting four top-two finishes during the span.

TENNESSEE TECH AT A GLANCE

The Skyhawks continued their hot play by winning their third consecutive OVC matchup with a commanding 55-14 road victory at Tennessee Tech. UT Martin would score a total of seven touchdowns while adding a pair of field goals to cap off an evening in which the team tallied a season-high 553 yards of total offense. The Skyhawks also scored a season-high 55 points which ranked as the high scoring output against an OVC foe since 2014 against Murray State. With the victory, UT Martin is 3-0 in OVC play for the first time since 2006 and just the second time in program history. The win also moved the Skyhawks to 1-0 in the highly-contested Sgt. York Trophy series.

LOGAN ECLIPSES THE CENTURY MARK ONCE AGAIN

After not having a 100-yard rusher for nearly two season, Peyton Logan has tallied three 100-yard rushing performances this season against Northwestern State (149), Eastern Kentucky (113) and Tennessee Tech (107). Logan recorded the first 100-yard rushing performance for the Skyhawks since Sept. 9, 2017 when LaDarius Galloway tallied 188 yards at Ole Miss.

QUICK HITS

BACHUS EARNS NUMEROUS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Freshman quarterback John Bachus III was recognized for his remarkable performance against Tennessee Tech by being named OVC Offensive Player of the Week, College Football Performance Awards FCS National Performer of the Week and OVC Newcomer of the Week. Bachus threw for five touchdown passes while completing 16-of-22 passes for 331 yards (and no interceptions), tallying career-highs in both yards and touchdown passes. He had touchdown passes of 22, 24, 73, 21 and 66 yards and completed passes to eight different receivers while averaging 20.7 yards per completion. His five touchdown passes ranked as the most by a Skyhawk since 2015.

COURTRIGHT NAMED OVC SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

Junior placekicker Ryan Courtright has been named OVC Specialist of the Week after a strong performance against Tennessee Tech. Courtright remained perfect on the season by making a pair of field goal attempts and seven point after attempts against Tennessee Tech. He gave the Skyhawks a double-digit advantage in the first quarter with a season-long 45-yard field goal attempt before adding another 30-yard attempt in midway through the second quarter.

EASTERN KENTUCKY AT A GLANCE

The Skyhawks recorded arguably their biggest win of the season by notching their first road victory of the season while leaving victorious from Roy Kidd Stadium for just the third time in program history. UT Martin remained unbeaten in OVC play with a strong showing in every phase of the game. The Skyhawks would pound the ball on the ground, tallying a season-high 234 rushing yards and four touchdowns in the game. On defense, UT Martin would limit a squad which entered the game averaging 243.8 rushing yards per game to just 94 yards on the ground, ranking as the third time the Skyhawks have held its opponent to less than 100 rushing yards this season. Then on special teams, the Skyhawks converted their lone field goal attempt from 22 yards while Terry Williams returned a punt 71 yards to set up a scoring drive.

JEFFERSON NAMED OVC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

TJ Jefferson posted several key contributions en route to his first career OVC weekly honor. Jefferson tallied five tackles in the contest while recording two quarterback hurries and a fumble recovery. His fumble recovery came late in the third quarter when he picked up a strip-sack fumble and returned it 44 yards for a touchdown to give the Skyhawks a two-score advantage.

MOORE BIG PLAYS FOR JAYLON

Senior wide receiver Jaylon Moore has made a knack of making big plays for the Skyhawks throughout his career. Moore has tallied 20 plays of 25 yards or more - including 11 of which were touchdown receptions. As a whole, Moore has tallied touchdowns of 75, 67, 52, 49, 43, 37, 32, 28, 26, 25, and 20 yards.

BACHUS NAMED OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

John Bachus III accounted for 345 yards of total offense and two touchdowns as UT Martin began OVC play with a 40-7 win over rival Murray State. The redshirt freshman completed 26-of-40 passes for 312 yards and connected with Lamarqus Young on a 47-yard touchdown strike in the first quarter. In the second quarter he added a 1-yard touchdown score that put the Skyhawks ahead 24-0. Bachus tallied new career-highs in completions, attempts and yards in the victory.

MURRAY STATE AT A GLANCE

UT Martin jumped out to an early lead and never looked back, scoring in every quarter of the game while holding Murray State scoreless in the second half. The Skyhawks tallied 500 yards of total offense for the first time since 2017 while holding the Racers to just 17 rushing yards in the contest.

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AT A GLANCE

UT Martin tallied a pair of touchdowns on its first two possessions of the game while notching 136 total yards of offense. From that point on, the Skyhawks would give up 28 unanswered points to Southern Illinois while recording just 140 yards throughout the rest of the game. The Salukis would do their damage on the ground, tallying 264 rushing yards.

TOUCHDOWN TRIFECTA

Against Northwestern State, UT Martin scored a touchdown in all three phases of the game: offense, defense and special teams. The Skyhawks tallied four offensive touchdowns, a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown and a 55-yard punt return for a touchdown for the special trifecta. The last time the Skyhawks accomplished such a feat was on Sept. 27, 2008 against Murray State when UT Martin tallied six offensive touchdowns, two defensive scores and an 83-yard kick return for a touchdown.

MOTON EARNS NUMEROUS WEEKLY HONORS

Redshirt-sophomore Wanya Moton picked numerous accolades after an impressive showing against Northwestern State. Moton was named OVC Defensive Player of the Week, TSWA Defensive Player of the Week and an honorable mention STATS FCS Defensive Player of the Week after tallying seven tackles and a pair of interceptions in the season opener. His interceptions came in big situations, tallying a 12-yard return in the second quarter before returning an interception all the way to the house with a 78-yard return in the fourth quarter to give the Skyhawks a two-score advantage. He currently ranks first in the country in interceptions (two) and interceptions per game (2.0).

WILLIAMS NAMED OVC SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

Senior wide receiver Terry Williams played a big role in the Skyhawks opening victory over Northwestern State, tallying 199 all-purpose yards, including a touchdown to earn OVC Specialist of the Week honors. Williams tallied four punt returns for 98 yards, including a 55-yard punt return in the third quarter to give the Skyhawks an eight-point lead. He also tallied four kickoff returns for 73 yards, including a game-long 28-yard return. He leads the country in punt return touchdowns and punt returns while ranking third in kick returns and eighth in all-purpose yards.

SKYHAWKS UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS

When UT Martin traveled to Ben Hill Griffin Stadium on Saturday, Sept. 7 to play in "The Swamp" the Skyhawks played in front of 80,007 fans. The contest marked the third biggest crowd that UT Martin has ever played in front of.

FLORIDA AT A GLANCE

UT Martin (1-1) played its third Top-25 squad from the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) with a matchup against No. 11 ranked Florida. The Skyhawks struggled to get its offense going against a fast and athletic defense while being shutout for the first time since 2017 in a 45-0 setback. With the loss, the Skyhawks moved to 0-10 against SEC programs all-time.

SKYHAWKS FIND TEMPORARY HOME IN SEC

The Skyhawks are very familiar with playing teams from the Southeastern Conference. UT Martin has two SEC teams on its schedule in 2019, as it will play Florida and Kentucky. In the last 11 years, the Skyhawks have played Auburn (2008), Tennessee (2010), Mississippi State (2011, 2014), Kentucky (2014), Ole Miss (2015, 2017) and Missouri (2018). UT Martin will also play Alabama in 2020.

TAKING IT UP A NOTCH

UT Martin has been no stranger to playing competition from the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) over the years. The Skyhawks will have played 21 different FBS games since 2006, including a stretch from 2011-16 in which UT Martin played at least two FBS games per year. The Skyhawks are 1-22 in games against FBS opponents under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson

PICK SIX AND MORE

Sophomore Wanya Moton posted a big game against Northwestern State, tallying two interceptions to go along with his seven tackles. Moton returned his first touchdown 12 yards before notching a pick-six with a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown. His performance marked the first time a Skyhawk had tallied multiple interceptions in the same game since Kahlid Hagens tallied a pair of Nov. 12, 2016 against Southeast Missouri.

NORTHWESTERN STATE AT A GLANCE

The Skyhawks (1-0) overcame a first half deficit in the season opener against Northwestern State, shutting out the Demons in the second half while scoring 28 unanswered points en route to a 42-20 victory. In the contest, UT Martin scored in every facet of the game including offense, defense and special teams for the first time since Sept. 27, 2008 with four offensive touchdowns, a 78-yard interception return and a 55-yard punt return against NSU.

SEASON 91

The 2019 campaign is UT Martin's 91th season of football despite suspending play during Great Depression (1933) and World War II (1942-45). The Skyhawks are in their 28th season at the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and compiled an overall record of 117-188 with one Ohio Valley Conference title (2006) and one NCAA Playoff appearance (2006) as a D-I program.

LAST CHANCE U

Junior transfer Marqwell Odom became the second Skyhawk to appear on the Netflix original series Last Chance U as a member of the fourth season, featuring Independence Community College. Former Skyhawk Marcus LeFlore also appeared on the season one of the show as a member of East Mississippi Community College.

NEW SKYHAWKS MAKE THEIR DEBUT

11 different players made their Skyhawk debut in the season opener against Northwestern State. Kelton Edwards (left guard), Malcolm Miller (right tackle) and Cam Ordway (defensive back) each earned their first career starts. Meanwhile, Jaquez Akins, Jamarius Landers, Cecil Cherry, Marquis Traylor, Christian LaBrecche, Marqwell Odom, Deray Lawrence and Kenyonte Davis each played their first games in a UT Martin uniform.

The Skyhawks will open the season with nine of their 12 games on ESPN+ while matchups against Florida and Kentucky will be broadcast on one of the ESPNU in additional to the team's ESPN3 Game of the Week against Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Oct. 12.

THREE SKYHAWKS TABBED TO PRESEASON ALL-OVC SQUAD

The Skyhawk senior trio of Terry Fultz, Julian Crutchfield and Austin Pickett were each honored at the OVC's annual Media Day by being tabbed to the Preseason All-OVC squad as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

JASON SIMPSON

HEAD COACH • 14TH YEAR

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 80-68 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 60-40 mark against OVC opponents (.600 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 83 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 81 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 63 conference wins come in at sixth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 14 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013) and Tony Bell (2013, 2014).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - six times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012 and 2018 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 25-11 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.

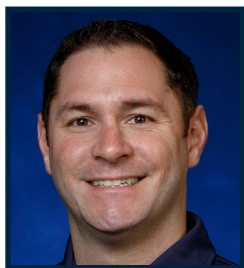

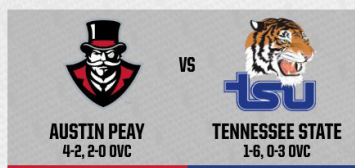
