- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will open its 28th season of Ohio Valley Conference competition with a matchup against Murray State on Saturday, Sept. 28. Kickoff from Hardy Graham Stadium is scheduled for 6 p.m. and is a marquee feature of Family Weekend. The game will be broadcast exclusively on ESPN+.
- The Skyhawks (1-2, 0-0 OVC) are looking to pick up their second win of the season after suffering a pair of road setbacks at No. 11 Florida (45-0) and Southern Illinois (28-14) in consecutive weeks prior to the Bye Week.
- UT Martin has relied on the play of freshman John Bachus III to lead the offense at quarterback. Bachus has completed 56.7 percent of his passes for 443 yards, two touchdowns and three interceptions in three career starts. Junior running back Peyton Logan paces the ground attack with 28 carries for 216 yards and three touchdowns while senior Jaylon Moore had tallied five receptions for 122 yards and a touchdown – averaging 24.7 yards per reception.
- Defensively, junior safety JaQuez Akins paces the team with 31 tackles – including 20 unassisted stops. Senior linebacker TJ Jefferson leads the linebacker core with 29 tackles and one tackle for loss while senior Austin Pickett has a team-best three tackles for loss, including two sacks.
- The game pits two of the league's veteran head coaches in UT Martin's Jason Simpson and Murray State's Mitch Stewart. Simpson currently ranks tied for sixth in OVC history with 81 career victories with Tennessee Tech's Don Wade. Meanwhile, Stewart has compiled a record of 16-31 in five seasons.
- Murray State (2-2, 0-0 OVC) cruised past Morehead State 59-7 in its previous contest, tallying 566 yards of total offense in front of a record-setting crowd at Roy Stewart Stadium. The Racers are led offensively by the play of sophomore quarterback Preston Rice which has completed 71.6 percent of his passes for 824 yards and seven touchdowns while carrying the ball 45 times for 229 yards. Meanwhile, six different Racers have tallied touchdown receptions, led by the play of LaMartz Brooks with 10 catches for 254 yards and three touchdowns. On the defensive side, Anthony Koclanakis paces the team with 28 tackles, including two tackles for loss and an interception and fumble recovery each.
- Saturday's matchup marks the 59th meeting between the two regional rivals in a series which dates back to 1924 with Murray State holding a 37-20-1 record. UT Martin has controlled the series for much of the past decade and a half, winning 11 of the last 14 meetings. The Racers have outmatched the Skyhawks in the last two meetings however, winning in 2017 and 2018 by a combined 10 points.

Senior linebacker TJ Jefferson has continued to be a force for the defense in his first season as a starter. Jefferson ranks second on the team with 29 tackles on the season while tallying a sack, a pair of pass breakups and a fumble recovery.

Jefferson has already tallied a pair of 12-tackle performances against Northwestern State and Southern Illinois.

THE JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

UT Martin football coach Jason Simpson has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now in his 14th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 81 wins - sitting tied for sixth in OVC history. In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 63-40 through 13 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 63 conference wins currently ranks sixth in OVC history.

UT Martin opens the 2019 season looking to regain control of the annual Sgt. York Trophy trophy series which pits Tennessee members of the Ohio Valley Conference for state supremacy.

UT Martin has won or shared the Sgt. York Trophy in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2018. The Skyhawks hold a 25-11 all-time record in the series - the best mark of the four Tennessee OVC schools (Austin Peay, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech).

OVC SUPREMACY

Since the 2006 season, UT Martin has ranked as one of the best programs in the Ohio Valley Conference after winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league. The Skyhawks have clinched four winning seasons in the past seven years while finishing .500 or above in conference play in 12 of the last 13 seasons - posting four top-two finishes during the span.

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS AT A GLANCE

UT Martin tallied a pair of touchdowns on its first two possessions of the game while notching 136 total yards of offense. From that point on, the Skyhawks would give up 28 unanswered points to Southern Illinois while recording just 140 yards throughout the rest of the game. The Salukis would do their damage on the ground, tallying 264 rushing yards.

MOORE BIG PLAYS FOR JAYLON

Senior wide receiver Jaylon Moore has made a knack of making big plays for the Skyhawks throughout his career. Moore has tallied 20 plays of 25 yards or more - including 11 of which were touchdown receptions. As a whole, Moore has tallied touchdowns of 75, 67, 52, 49, 43, 37, 32, 28, 26, 25, and 20 yards.

This year marks the 150th anniversary of college football which began on November 6, 1869 when Princeton played Rutgers. QUICK HITS

TOUCHDOWN TRIFECTA

Against Northwestern State, UT Martin scored a touchdown in all three phases of the game: offense, defense and special teams. The Skyhawks tallied four offensive touchdowns, a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown and a 55-yard punt return for a touchdown for the special trifecta. The last time the Skyhawks accomplished such a feat was on Sept. 27, 2008 against Murray State when UT Martin tallied six offensive touchdowns, two defensive scores and an 83-yard kick return for a touchdown.

MOTON EARNS NUMEROUS WEEKLY HONORS

Redshirt-sophomore Wanya Moton picked numerous accolades after an impressive showing against Northwestern State. Moton was named OVC Defensive Player of the Week, TSWA Defensive Player of the Week and an honorable mention STATS FCS Defensive Player of the Week after tallying seven tackles and a pair of interceptions in the season opener. His interceptions came in big situations, tallying a 12-yard return in the second quarter before returning an interception all the way to the house with a 78-yard return in the fourth quarter to give the Skyhawks a two-score advantage. He currently ranks first in the country in interceptions (two) and interceptions per game (2.0).

WILLIAMS NAMED OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Senior wide receiver Terry Williams played a big role in the Skyhawks opening victory over Northwestern State, tallying 199 all-purpose yards, including a touchdown to earn OVC Specialist of the Week honors. Williams tallied four punt returns for 98 yards, including a 55-yard punt return in the third quarter to give the Skyhawks an eight-point lead. He also tallied four kickoff returns for 73 yards, including a game-long 28-yard return. He leads the country in punt return touchdowns and punt returns while ranking third in kick returns and eighth in all-purpose yards.

LOGAN ECLIPSES THE CENTURY MARK

Peyton Logan recorded the first 100-yard rushing performance for the Skyhawks since Sept. 9, 2017 when LaDarius Galloway tallied 188 yards at Ole Miss. Logan tallied 13 carries for 149 yards and two touchdowns from 21 and 53 yards, respectively.

PICK SIX AND MORE

Sophomore Wanya Moton posted a big game against Northwestern State, tallying two interceptions to go along with his seven tackles. Moton returned his first touchdown 12 yards before notching a pick-six with a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown. His performance marked the first time a Skyhawk had tallied multiple interceptions in the same game since Kahlid Hagens tallied a pair of Nov. 12, 2016 against Southeast Missouri.

FLORIDA AT A GLANCE

UT Martin (1-1) played its third Top-25 squad from the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) with a matchup against No. 11 ranked Florida. The Skyhawks struggled to get its offense going against a fast and athletic defense while being shutout for the first time since 2017 in a 45-0 setback. With the loss, the Skyhawks moved to 0-10 against SEC programs all-time.

SKYHAWKS FIND TEMPORARY HOME IN SEC

The Skyhawks are very familiar with playing teams from the Southeastern Conference. UT Martin has two SEC teams on its schedule in 2019, as it will play Florida and Kentucky. In the last 11 years, the Skyhawks have played Auburn (2008), Tennessee (2010), Mississippi State (2011, 2014), Kentucky (2014), Ole Miss (2015, 2017) and Missouri (2018). UT Martin will also play Alabama in 2020.

SKYHAWKS UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS

When UT Martin traveled to Ben Hill Griffin Stadium on Saturday, Sept. 7 to play in "The Swamp" the Skyhawks played in front of 80,007 fans. The contest marked the third biggest crowd that UT Martin has ever played in front of.

NORTHWESTERN STATE AT A GLANCE

The Skyhawks (1-0) overcame a first half deficit in the season opener against Northwestern State, shutting out the Demons in the second half while scoring 28 unanswered points en route to a 42-20 victory. In the contest, UT Martin scored in every facet of the game including offense, defense and special teams for the first time since Sept. 27, 2008 with four offensive touchdowns, a 78-yard interception return and a 55-yard punt return against NSU.

NEW SKYHAWKS MAKE THEIR DEBUT

SKYHAWKS GARNER ESPN SPOTLIGHT

UT Martin currently has all 12 of the team's games available to a national audience through the ESPN family of networks. The Skyhawks will open the season with nine of their 12 games on ESPN+ while matchups against Florida and Kentucky will be broadcast on one of the ESPNU in addition to the team's ESPN3 Game of the Week against Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Oct. 12.

THREE SKYHAWKS TABBED TO PRESEASON ALL-OVC SQUAD

The Skyhawk senior trio of Terry Fultz, Julian Crutchfield and Austin Pickett were each honored at the OVC's annual Media Day by being tabbed to the Preseason All-OVC squad as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors. Fultz started all 11 games on the offensive line a season ago while the defensive line pair of Crutchfield and Pickett started all 11 games and combined for 77 tackles.

JASON SIMPSON

HEAD COACH • 14TH YEAR

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 81-68 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 63-42 mark against OVC opponents (.600 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 83 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 81 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 63 conference wins come in at sixth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 14 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013) and Tony Bell (2013, 2014).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - six times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012 and 2018 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 25-11 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.
