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- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will officially open the regular season with a matchup against Southland Conference member Northwestern State on Thursday, Aug. 29. Kickoff from Hardy M. Graham Stadium is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. and will be broadcast live on ESPN+.
- The Skyhawks (0-0) open their 91st season of football and 28th as a Division I program in 2019. Overall, UT Martin is 4-9 in season openers under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson but have posted an 11-2 record in home openers during the same time frame.
- UT Martin is looking to rebound from a 2-9 campaign in 2018, ranking as the first losing season for the Skyhawks since 2011 and the first season sub-.500 year in conference play since 2004.
- The Skyhawks boast eight players who have earned preseason all-conference honors by various publications, including the trio of seniors Julian Crutchfield, Austin Pickett and Terry Fultz which each garnered Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference recognitions. Overall, the Skyhawks return 13 starters plus two key specialist for a squad which was picked to finish seventh in the OVC.
- Returning for his 14th season at the helm of the Skyhawks, head coach Jason Simpson possesses a career record of 80-68. Simpson ranks as the OVC's seventh winningest coach and needs just one victory to move into a tie for sixth on the league's leaderboard with Tennessee Tech's Don Wade.
- Northwestern State (0-0) features 17 returning starters from a squad which went 5-6 and finished eighth in the Southland Conference. The Demons are highlighted by all-conference honorees Hayden Bourgeois, Chris Zirkle, O'Shea Jackson and Myles Ward along with quarterback Shelton Eppler was named to the CFP National Performer of the Year Trophy watch list.
- Thursday's contest serves as the third meeting between the two programs with the series tied at one game apiece. UT Martin picked up a win in 1965 before Northwestern State recorded the equalizer in 1967.

THE JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

UT Martin football coach Jason Simpson has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now entering his 14th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 80 wins - sitting seventh in OVC history. In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 63-40 through 13 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 63 conference wins currently ranks sixth in OVC history.

OVC SUPREMACY

Since the 2006 season, UT Martin has ranked as one of the best programs in the Ohio Valley Conference after winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league. The Skyhawks have clinched four winning season in the past seven years while finishing .500 or above in conference play in 12 of the last 13 seasons - posting four top-two finishes during the span.

SKYHAWKS GARNER ESPN SPOTLIGHT

UT Martin currently has all 12 of the team's games available to a national audience through the ESPN family of networks. The Skyhawks will open the season with nine of their 12 games on ESPN+ while matchups against Florida and Kentucky will be broadcast on one of the ESPN/SEC channels in addition to the team's ESPN3 Game of the Week against Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Oct. 12.

THREE SKYHAWKS TABBED TO PRESEASON ALL-OVC SQUAD

The Skyhawk senior trio of Terry Fultz, Julian Crutchfield and Austin Pickett were each honored at the OVC's annual Media Day by being tabbed to the Preseason All-OVC squad as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors. Fultz started all 11 games on the offensive line a season ago while the defensive line pair of Crutchfield and Pickett started all 11 games and combined for 77 tackles.

SKYHAWKS GARNER NINE SPOTS ON PHIL STEELE PRESEASON ALL-OVC LIST

A total of eight UT Martin football players garnered nine spots on the annual Phil Steele Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference teams. The pair of Julian Crutchfield (defensive line) and Ryan Courtright (place kicker) took home first team honors while Jaylon Moore (wide receiver), Terry Fultz (offensive line), Austin Pickett (defensive line), Peyton Logan (kick return) and Terry Williams (punt return) were second team selections. Williams also earned third team honors as a wide receiver while TJ Jefferson made the squad at linebacker.

UT MARTIN PICKED TO FINISH SEVENTH

The Ohio Valley Conference announced its preseason polls and all-conference performers in conjunction with the league's Football Media Day festivities held at Embassy Suites Nashville Airport on July 22. UT Martin was selected to finish seventh in the preseason poll as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors as well as the Preseason Media Poll. The Skyhawks tallied 60 overall points.

SEASON 91

The 2019 campaign is UT Martin's 91th season of football despite suspending play during Great Depression (1933) and World War II (1942-45). The Skyhawks are in their 28th season at the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and compiled an overall record of 117-187 with one Ohio Valley Conference title (2006) and one NCAA Playoff appearance (2006) as a D-I program.

This year marks the 150th anniversary of college football which began on November 6, 1869 when Princeton played Rutgers. The commemoration will showcase the rich history and traditions of the sport and its positive impact on lives and communities, while also promoting the opportunity it continues to provide to thousands of student-athletes across all levels of the sport. UT Martin opens the 2019 season looking to regain control of the annual Sgt. York Trophy trophy series which pits Tennessee members of the Ohio Valley Conference for state supremacy. UT Martin has won or shared the Sgt. York Trophy in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2018. The Skyhawks hold a 25-11 all-time record in the series – the best mark of the four Tennessee OVC schools (Austin Peay, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech).

BOWE RUSHES INTO PROGRAM'S TOP-10

UT Martin graduate running back Jaimiee Bowe has proven to be a dynamic player in the ground attack throughout his Skyhawk career. Since playing as a true-freshman in 2015, Bowe has accumulated 17 career touchdowns to rank seventh in program history.

MOORE BIG PLAYS FOR JAYLON

Senior wide receiver Jaylon Moore had a knack of making big plays for the Skyhawks last season. Moore has tallied 14 plays of 25 yards or more - including seven of which were touchdown receptions. Moore notched the season's longest offensive play against Tennessee State, tallying a 75-yard touchdown reception. As a whole, Moore tallied touchdowns of 75, 52, 49, 32, 26, 25, 20 and four yards last season.

WILLIAMS FINDS HIS WAY

Senior wide receiver Terry Williams wasted little time making his presence known in his debut season. After tallying 67 receptions for 736 yards and three touchdowns, Williams recorded the fourth most receptions in program history for a single season - tying Taurean Stephens's mark from 2004.

LAST CHANCE U

Junior transfer Marqwell Odom became the second Skyhawk to appear on the Netflix original series Last Chance U as a member of the fourth season, featuring Independence Community College. Former Skyhawk Marcus LeFlore also appeared on the season one of the show as a member of East Mississippi Community College.

SKYHAWKS FIND TEMPORARY HOME IN SEC

The Skyhawks are very familiar with playing teams from the Southeastern Conference. UT Martin has two SEC teams on its schedule in 2019, as it will play Florida and Kentucky. In the last 11 years, the Skyhawks have played Auburn (2008), Tennessee (2010), Mississippi State (2011, 2014), Kentucky (2014), Ole Miss (2015, 2017) and Missouri (2018). UT Martin will also play Alabama in 2020.

TAKING IT UP A NOTCH

UT Martin has been no stranger to playing competition from the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) over the years. The Skyhawks will have played 21 different FBS games since 2006, including a stretch from 2011-16 in which UT Martin played at least two FBS games per year. The Skyhawks are 1-21 in games against FBS opponents under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson

JASON SIMPSON

HEAD COACH • 14TH YEAR

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 13 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 80-68 record (.540 winning percentage) and a 63-42 mark against OVC opponents (.600 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 83 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 80 career victories rank seventh in OVC history while his 63 conference wins come in at sixth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 14 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013) and Tony Bell (2013, 2014).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - six times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012 and 2018 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 25-11 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.
