- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will hit the road for an Ohio Valley Conference matchup against No. 24 ranked Southeast Missouri on Saturday, Oct. 26. Kickoff from Houck Stadium is scheduled for 1 p.m. and will be broadcast exclusively on ESPN+.
- The Skyhawks (5-2, 4-0 OVC) enter the contest off to their best start in OVC play since 2006 with a 4-0 record, outscoring its league opponents by an average of 23.25 points per game. Currently, the Skyhawks rank in the top-25 in 21 statistical categories nationally while leading the league in fourth down conversion percentage, defensive touchdowns, fewest penalties, interceptions, fewest interceptions thrown, punt returns, team passing efficiency, team sacks, turnover margin, turnovers lost and winning percentage.
- UT Martin is led offensively by quarterback John Bachus III who has completed 60.6 percent of his passes for 1,361 yards and 10 touchdowns. Running back Peyton Logan has been explosive, tallying four 100-yard rushing performance on the season while notching 639 yards and six touchdowns. Wide receiver Terry Williams leads the team with 25 receptions while tallying 258 yards and a touchdown. Defensively, JaQuez Akins has a team-high 62 tackles while recording two pass breakups, an interception and a pair of forced fumbles.
- The game will feature two of the league's veteran coaches in UT Martin's Jason Simpson and Southeast Missouri's Tom Matukewicz. Simpson ranks sixth in OVC history with an 85-70 overall mark in 14 seasons after recently becoming tied for the program's all-time career wins' mark. Conversely, Matukewicz has posted a 28-37 mark in his sixth season at the helm of the Redhawks.
- Southeast Missouri (4-3, 2-1 OVC) enters the game ranked No. 24 nationally in the STATS FCS Poll. The Redhawks are coming off a historic victory, ending formerly No. 14 ranked Jacksonville State's 32-game home winning streak by a score of 24-21 after forcing four turnovers. The pair of Kristian Wilkerson (Offensive) and Justin Swift (Defensive) picked up OVC Player of the Week honors after impressive performances in the victory.
- Saturday's game serves as the 35th meeting between the two programs with UT Martin holding a narrow 18-16 advantage. The Skyhawks have won six of the last eight meetings against the Redhawks with SEMO tallying victories in 2014 and 2018. Dating back to 2008, nine of the last 11 contests have been decided by 10 points or fewer.

Running back Peyton Logan has become a consistent producer for the Skyhawks this season, averaging 7.7 yards per carry - which ranks sixth nationally - while accumulating 639 yards and six touchdowns this season. Logan has eclipsed the 100-yard rushing plateau four times this season, including 109 yards against Eastern Illinois.

**THE JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES**

UT Martin football coach Jason Simpson has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now in his 14th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 85 wins - sitting sixth in OVC history. In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 67-40 through 14 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 64 conference wins currently ranks sixth in OVC history.

**OVC SUPREMACY**

Since the 2006 season, UT Martin has ranked as one of the best programs in the Ohio Valley Conference after winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league. The Skyhawks have clinched four winning season in the past seven years while finishing .500 or above in conference play in 12 of the last 13 seasons - posting four top-two finishes during the span.

**LOGAN ECLIPSES THE CENTURY MARK ONCE AGAIN**

After not having a 100-yard rusher for nearly two season, Peyton Logan has tallied four 100-yard rushing performances this season against Northwestern State (149), Eastern Kentucky (113), Tennessee Tech (107) and Eastern Illinois (109). He is the first Skyhawk running back to tally four 100-yard rushing performances in a single season since Abou Toure accomplished the feat four times in 2014. He currently ranks sixth nationally in rush yards per carry (7.7) and 25th in rushing yards (639).

**DEFENSE TAKES IT TO THE HOUSE**

UT Martin ranks fourth in the country with three defensive touchdowns on the season. Wanya Moton returned an interception 78 yards against Northwestern State, TJ Jefferson returned a fumble 44 yards against Eastern Kentucky and D'Carrious Stephens returned an interception 31 yards against Eastern Illinois. The team's three defensive touchdowns rank as the best single-season output for the Skyhawks since tallying six in 2016.

# QUICK HITS

## COURTRIGHT SPLITS THE UPRIGHTS

Junior specialist Ryan Courtright has been perfect this season in his kicking duties. Courtright ranks first in the nation in field goal percentage, making 7-of-8 attempts on the season while converting all 27 point after attempts. For his career, Courtright has made 22-of-25 field goal attempts while notching a career-long 46-yard field goal against Eastern Illinois.

## SPECIAL TEAMS SPECIALIST

Senior wide receiver/return specialist Terry Williams has proved the ability to flip the field at any moment. Williams ranks first in the nation in punt return touchdowns (one), fourth in punt returns (17.5 yards) and 14th in combined kick returns (477 yards). He tallied a 71-yard punt return against Eastern Kentucky along with a 55-yard return for a touchdown against Northwestern State.

## MOORE BIG PLAYS FOR JAYLON

Senior wide receiver Jaylon Moore has made a knack of making big plays for the Skyhawks throughout his career. Moore has tallied 20 plays of 25 yards or more - including 11 of which were touchdown receptions. As a whole, Moore has tallied touchdowns of 75, 67, 52, 49, 43, 37, 32, 28, 26, 25, and 20 yards.

## BACHUS EARNS NUMEROUS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Freshman quarterback John Bachus III was recognized for his remarkable performance against Tennessee Tech by being named OVC Offensive Player of the Week, College Football Performance Awards FCS National Performer of the Week and OVC Newcomer of the Week. Bachus threw for five touchdown passes while completing 16-of-22 passes for 331 yards (and no interceptions), tallying career-highs in both yards and touchdown passes. He had touchdown passes of 22, 24, 73, 21 and 66 yards and completed passes to eight different receivers while averaging 20.7 yards per completion. His five touchdown passes ranked as the most by a Skyhawk since 2015.

## COURTRIGHT NAMED OVC SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

Junior placekicker Ryan Courtright has been named OVC Specialist of the Week after a strong performance against Tennessee Tech. Courtright remained perfect on the season by making a pair of field goal attempts and seven point after attempts against Tennessee Tech. He gave the Skyhawks a double-digit advantage in the first quarter with a season-long 45-yard field goal attempt before adding another 30-yard attempt in midway through the second quarter.

## JEFFERSON NAMED OVC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

TJ Jefferson posted several key contributions en route to his first career OVC weekly honor. Jefferson tallied five tackles in the contest while recording two quarterback hurries and a fumble recovery. His fumble recovery came late in the third quarter when he picked up a strip-sack fumble and returned it 44 yards for a touchdown to give the Skyhawks a two-score advantage.

## BACHUS NAMED OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

John Bachus III accounted for 345 yards of total offense and two touchdowns as UT Martin began OVC play with a 40-7 win over rival Murray State. The redshirt freshman completed 26-of-40 passes for 312 yards and connected with Lamarus Young on a 47-yard touchdown strike in the first quarter. In the second quarter he added a 1-yard touchdown score that put the Skyhawks ahead 24-0. Bachus tallied new career-highs in completions, attempts and yards in the victory.

## TOUCHDOWN TRIFECTA

Against Northwestern State, UT Martin scored a touchdown in all three phases of the game: offense, defense and special teams. The Skyhawks tallied four offensive touchdowns, a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown and a 55-yard punt return for a touchdown for the special trifecta. The last time the Skyhawks accomplished such a feat was on Sept. 27, 2008 against Murray State when UT Martin tallied six offensive touchdowns, two defensive scores and an 83-yard kick return for a touchdown.

## MOTON EARNS NUMEROUS WEEKLY HONORS

Redshirt-sophomore Wanya Moton picked numerous accolades after an impressive showing against Northwestern State. Moton was named OVC Defensive Player of the Week, TSWA Defensive Player of the Week and an honorable mention STATS FCS Defensive Player of the Week after tallying seven tackles and a pair of interceptions in the season opener. His interceptions came in big situations, tallying a 12-yard return in the second quarter before returning an interception all the way to the house with a 78-yard return in the fourth quarter to give the Skyhawks a two-score advantage. He currently ranks first in the country in interceptions (two) and interceptions per game (2.0).

## WILLIAMS NAMED OVC SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

Senior wide receiver Terry Williams played a big role in the Skyhawks opening victory over Northwestern State, tallying 199 all-purpose yards, including a touchdown to earn OVC Specialist of the Week honors. Williams tallied four punt returns for 98 yards, including a 55-yard punt return in the third quarter to give the Skyhawks an eight-point lead. He also tallied four kickoff returns for 73 yards, including a game-long 28-yard return. He leads the country in punt return touchdowns and punt returns while ranking third in kick returns and eighth in all-purpose yards.

## TAKING IT UP A NOTCH

UT Martin has been no stranger to playing competition from the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) over the years. The Skyhawks will have played 21 different FBS games since 2006, including a stretch from 2011-16 in which UT Martin played at least two FBS games per year. The Skyhawks are 1-22 in games against FBS opponents under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson

## SKYHAWKS FIND TEMPORARY HOME IN SEC

The Skyhawks are very familiar with playing teams from the Southeastern Conference. UT Martin has two SEC teams on its schedule in 2019, as it will play Florida and Kentucky. In the last 11 years, the Skyhawks have played Auburn (2008), Tennessee (2010), Mississippi State (2011, 2014), Kentucky (2014), Ole Miss (2015, 2017) and Missouri (2018). UT Martin will also play Alabama in 2020.

## PICK SIX AND MORE

Sophomore Wanya Moton posted a big game against Northwestern State, tallying two interceptions to go along with his seven tackles. Moton returned his first touchdown 12 yards before notching a pick-six with a 78-yard interception return for a touchdown. His performance marked the first time a Skyhawk had tallied multiple interceptions in the same game since Kahlid Hagens tallied a pair of Nov. 12, 2016 against Southeast Missouri.

## SEASON 91

The 2019 campaign is UT Martin's 91th season of football despite suspending play during Great Depression (1933) and World War II (1942-45). The Skyhawks are in their 28th season at the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and compiled an overall record of 117-188 with one Ohio Valley Conference title (2006) and one NCAA Playoff appearance (2006) as a D-I program.

## LAST CHANCE U

Junior transfer Marqwell Odom became the second Skyhawk to appear on the Netflix original series Last Chance U as a member of the fourth season, featuring Independence Community College. Former Skyhawk Marcus LeFlore also appeared on the season one of the show as a member of East Mississippi Community College.

## NEW SKYHAWKS MAKE THEIR DEBUT

11 different players made their Skyhawk debut in the season opener against Northwestern State. Kelton Edwards (left guard), Malcolm Miller (right tackle) and Cam Ordway (defensive back) each earned their first career starts. Meanwhile, JaQuez Akins, Jamarius Landers, Cecil Cherry, Marquis Traylor, Christian LaBrecche, Marqwell Odom, Deray Lawrence and Kenyonte Davis each played their first games in a UT Martin uniform.

## UT MARTIN PICKED TO FINISH SEVENTH

The Ohio Valley Conference announced its preseason polls and all-conference performers in conjunction with the league's Football Media Day festivities held at Embassy Suites Nashville Airport on July 22. # JASON SIMPSON

**HEAD COACH • 14<sup>TH</sup> YEAR**

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 80-68 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 60-40 mark against OVC opponents (.600 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 83 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 81 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 63 conference wins come in at sixth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 14 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013) and Tony Bell (2013, 2014).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - six times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012 and 2018 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 25-11 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.

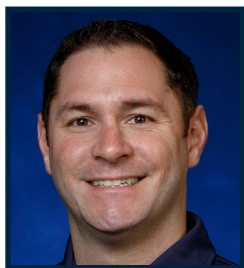
