- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will host Ohio Valley Conference foe Eastern Illinois on Sunday, March 7 for its home opener. Kickoff from Hardy Graham Stadium is scheduled for 1 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- The game serves as a matchup of two of the best OVC programs in recent history. Since 2008, UT Martin (69) and Eastern Illinois (65) rank third and fourth, respectively in league victories during the span. The contest also serves as the 26th meeting between the two programs since 1995 with the Panthers holding a 15-10 series advantage. Despite trailing in the overall series, the Skyhawks have won seven of the last 10 matchups against the Panthers.
- The Skyhawks (0-1, 0-1 OVC) dropped their season opener last week at Murray State, falling on the road 14-10. UT Martin found its scoring from a 34-yard field goal by Tyler Larco and a one-yard rushing touchdown by Dresser Winn in the setback. UT Martin boasts four Preseason All-OVC selections in running back Peyton Logan, wide receiver Colton Dowell, defensive tackle Austin Pickett and safety JaQuez Akins.
- UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson enters his 15th season at the helm of the Skyhawks as the program's all-time wins leader and the league's longest tenured head coach. Simpson boasts an all-time mark of 87-74 and ranks sixth in OVC history in career victories.
- Eastern Illinois (0-1, 0-1 OVC) dropped its season-opener at home to Southeast Missouri, 47-7. The Panthers are looking to take the next step under second-year head coach Adam Cushing after going 1-11 in 2019. The Panthers tallied one touchown last week as Kendi Young boasted 11 rushing attempts for 88 yards and one touchdown. Defensively, the team was led by Anthony Shockey and Raymond Crittenden with nine tackles each and 3.5 combined tackles for loss.



•Produced 14 players who have advanced to NFL opportunities. The list includes Montori Hughes, who became the first UT Martin player chosen in the NFL Draft since 1996 when the Indianapolis Colts snagged the defensive tackle in the fifth round of the 2012 draft.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 87-73 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 69-42 mark against OVC opponents (.621 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 94 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 87 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 69 conference wins come in at fourth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 15 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013), Tony Bell (2013, 2014) and Terry Williams (2019).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - seven times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018 and 2019 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 27-12 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.

- Do **NOT** provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do **NOT** provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do **NOT** provide the use of an automobile.
- Do **NOT** provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do **NOT** provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do **NOT** use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You **MAY** provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You **MAY** employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy. 
