- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will host nationally ranked Ohio Valley Conference foe Jacksonville State on Sunday, March 14. Kickoff from Hardy Graham Stadium is scheduled for 1 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- UT Martin enters the contest at 1-1 (1-1 OVC) on the season after picking up a 28-15 win over Eastern Illinois in the team's home opener last week. The Skyhawks scored 21-unanswered points to open the contest while quarterback John Bachus III threw three touchdown passes finding Rodney Williams for a pair and Donnell Williams for the other. Junior linebacker John Ford also tallied his first career interception and returned it 50 yards for a touchdown.
- With the win against Eastern Illinois, UT Martin extended its home winning streak against OVC teams to six games dating back to the 2018 season, beginning with a 38-13 win against Tennessee Tech on Nov. 10, 2018.
- Today's coaching matchup features two of the league's winningest head coaches in UT Martin's Jason Simpson and Jacksonville State's John Grass. Simpson ranks sixth in OVC history with 88 career victories while Grass recently moved into the Top-10 with a 63-19 overall mark.
- Jacksonville State is 5-1 on the season and 2-0 in the conference slate. The Gamecocks went to the
 road and picked up a 38-16 win at Tennessee State last weekend behind 452 yards of total offense and
 five touchdowns. Quarterback Zion Webb leads the Gamecocks by completing 66 percent of his passes
 for 520 yards and four touchdowns this season while the ground attack has added 12 touchdowns as
 well. Defensively, the team has tallied seven interceptions while Nicario Harper leads the squad with
 48 tackles in six games.
- This marks the 42nd meeting between the two programs in a series which dates back to 1967.
 Jacksonville State holds a commanding lead in the series with a 33-8 mark. The Skyhawks snapped
 a six-game losing streak last season with a 22-17 victory on Homecoming over the then-17th ranked
 Gamecocks back on Nov. 2, 2019 in Graham Stadium.



Notable Facts

- •Simpson is the longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference
- •Has a 70-43 career record against OVC foes (UTM won 20 OVC games in 14 seasons before Simpson)
- •Coached 15 All-Americans at UT Martin
- •Produced 14 players who have advanced to NFL opportunities. The list includes Montori Hughes, who became the first UT Martin player chosen in the NFL Draft since 1996 when the Indianapolis Colts snagged the defensive tackle in the fifth round of the 2012 draft.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 87-73 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 69-42 mark against OVC opponents (.621 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 94 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 87 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 69 conference wins come in at fourth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 15 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013), Tony Bell (2013, 2014) and Terry Williams (2019).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee – seven times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018 and 2019 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 27-12 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.



- Do NOT provide gifts, free or reduced cost services including meals, drinks, clothing, laundry, haircuts, legal fees or other benefits to student-athletes and their family and friends
- Do NOT provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do NOT provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do NOT provide the use of an automobile.
- Do NOT provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do NOT provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do NOT use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial
 products or services.
- You MAY provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You MAY employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy.
