



- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will open its final homestand of the season with a matchup against Ohio Valley Conference rival Southeast Missouri on Saturday, April 3. Kickoff from Hardy Graham Stadium is scheduled for 1 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- UT Martin enters the contest at 2-3 (2-3 OVC) on the season after falling short in its comeback attempt at Tennessee State last week. The Skyhawks rallied to score 17 points in the fourth quarter – scoring two touchdowns and a field goal in the final period – but could not convert a two-point conversion on their final touchdown with less than two minutes to go to tie the contest before ultimately dropping the road contest 26-24.
- The Skyhawks passing offense ranks amongst league leaders in multiple categories including passing yards (242.4, first), touchdowns (nine, second) and completion percentage (57.1%, third). Quarterback John Bachus III has completed 56.9 percent of his attempts for 1,157 yards and nine touchdowns while upping his career total to 31 which ranks seventh in program history. Meanwhile, the receiving trio of Colton Dowell (5.4), Donnell Williams (4.6) and Rodney Williams (4.4) each rank in the top-five in the OVC in receptions per game.
- On special teams, UT Martin has blocked five kicks this season to lead the country. The Skyhawks have blocked two PATs, two field goals and a punt in five games this spring.
- Southeast Missouri is 2-4 (2-3 OVC) on the year after picking up a 24-21 win over Tennessee Tech last weekend. The Redhawks jumped out to an early 21-0 lead in the first quarter before clinging to their advantage down the stretch for the narrow victory in their home finale. SEMO now must finish the final two games of the regular season on the road with matchups at UT Martin and Tennessee State.
- Saturday's matchup marks the 36th meeting between the two programs in a series which dates back to 1966. UT Martin holds a narrow 18-17 advantage over Southeast Missouri while boasting a 9-8 mark at home. The Skyhawks have held their own in recent history however, winning 11 of the last 15 meetings.



#### **Notable Facts**

- Simpson is the longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference
- Has a 70-43 career record against OVC foes (UTM won 20 OVC games in 14 seasons before Simpson)
- Coached 15 All-Americans at UT Martin
- Produced 14 players who have advanced to NFL opportunities. The list includes Montori Hughes, who became the first UT Martin player chosen in the NFL Draft since 1996 when the Indianapolis Colts snagged the defensive tackle in the fifth round of the 2012 draft.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 87-73 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 69-42 mark against OVC opponents (.621 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 94 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 87 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 69 conference wins come in at fourth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 15 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013), Tony Bell (2013, 2014) and Terry Williams (2019).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - seven times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018 and 2019 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 27-12 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.



The NCAA defines "extra benefits" as any special arrangement provided to a student-athlete or a student-athlete's family/friend that is not available to all other students at UT Martin. Therefore, please be aware of the following:

- Do **NOT** provide gifts, free or reduced cost services including meals, drinks, clothing, laundry, haircuts, legal fees or other benefits to student-athletes and their family and friends
- Do **NOT** provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do **NOT** provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do **NOT** provide the use of an automobile.
- Do **NOT** provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do **NOT** provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do **NOT** use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You **MAY** provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You **MAY** employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy.
