

- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will look to wrap up the 2020-21 spring season with a home matchup against Ohio Valley Conference foe Tennessee Tech on Sunday, April 11. Kickoff from Hardy M. Graham Stadium is scheduled for 3 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- This marks the third and final game in the coveted Sgt. York Trophy series which goes to the winner of the quadrangular season football series between the four OVC football-playing schools located in the state of Tennessee – Austin Peay, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. The Skyhawks need a win against the Golden Eagles to earn a piece of their eighth Sgt. York Trophy after winning the trophy outright or sharing honors in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2018 and 2019. The Skyhawks hold a 28-13 record in the series – the best mark of the four Tennessee OVC schools – that includes a 19-6 mark since 2012.
- UT Martin enters the weekend with a 2-4 mark overall and in the conference. UT Martin is hoping to end the season on a positive note after dropping its last two contests by an average of 3.5 points. The Skyhawks boast the league's top passing offense behind quarterback John Bachus III who ranks first in the OVC with 1,432 yards and 11 touchdowns while featuring three of the top-10 receiving leaders in Donnell Williams, Colton Dowell and Rodney Williams with 1,059 yards and 10 touchdowns split between the trio.
- Tennessee Tech (2-4, 2-4 OVC) snapped a four-game losing streak last week with a 24-10 home victory over Tennessee State. The Golden Eagles are led by dual-threat quarterback Willie Miller who averages 148.7 yards of total offense with four passing touchdowns and four rushing touchdowns.
- Sunday's matchup marks the 42nd meeting between the two programs in a series which dates back to 1926. Tennessee Tech holds a 22-17-2 advantage in the series while UT Martin enters the contest riding a seven-game winning streak since 2013. The Skyhawks last loss at Graham Stadium to the Golden Eagles came in 2011.

SERGEANT YORK TROPHY

In July 2007, the Nashville Sports Council and the Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of the Sergeant York Trophy which goes to the winner of the quadrangular season football series between the four Ohio Valley Conference schools located in the state of Tennessee – Austin Peay State University, University of Tennessee at Martin, Tennessee State University and Tennessee Technological University.

The award is only the second traveling trophy that involves more than two teams in college sports; the other is the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972.

The award is presented by Delta Dental of Tennessee and Farm Bureau Health Plans of Tennessee.

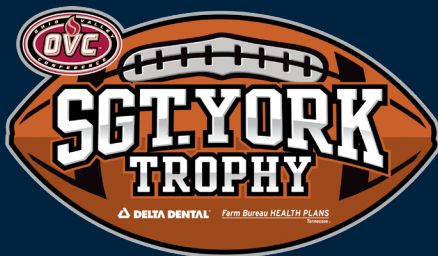
In a close race, Tennessee State and Austin Peay shared the inaugural award, finishing with identical 2-1 records in 2007. Tennessee State took the trophy home with it thanks to a one-point victory in overtime over the Governors; that game was decided by a blocked extra point by NFL First Round Draft Pick Dominique Rodgers-Cromartie.

The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. As a corporal in the 2nd battalion, 328th Infantry, in the Battle of the Meuse River-Argonne (Oct. 8, 1918), York and seven other soldiers captured 132 prisoners, was promoted to sergeant and received the Distinguished Service Cross, the French Croix de Guerre, the French Legion of Honor, the Croce di Guerra of Italy and the War Medal of Montenegro. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor.

Following the war York returned his home in Pall Mall, Tenn. (located in north central Tennessee, 55 miles northeast of Cookeville) where he dedicated his life to improving education and facilitating educational opportunities for children in the state of Tennessee. In 1927 he established the Alvin C. York Institute after spending several years raising money for the school which opened as a private institution. That school was established, in part, to provide educational opportunities denied to the boys and girls of Fentress County. In 1937, the Institute became a state special school after an appeal to the Tennessee State Legislature. The school, located in Jamestown, Tenn., is still in operation today.

York died on Sept. 2, 1964 and the foundation which he helped establish in 1920 – The Sergeant York Patriotic Foundation – was dormant for many years. The Foundation was re-established by Lipscomb Davis, Jr. in 1992 and is currently run by Sgt. York's grandson Gerald (U.S. Army Colonel, Retired). York's papers are archived by Michael E. Birdwell, Ph.D., who is an associate professor of history at Tennessee Technological University, one of the four institutions that will compete for the yearly honor.

After the completion of the football season, the Sergeant York Trophy is awarded to the institution with the best head-to-head record in the match-ups with their fellow Tennessee schools. In the event of a tie, the award is shared; however, the previous winner will retain the trophy if they are part of the tie. If the tie is between two other institutions, the trophy will go to the institution that has gone the most seasons without winning the trophy.

Notable Facts

- Simpson is the longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference
- Has a 70-43 career record against OVC foes (UTM won 20 OVC games in 14 seasons before Simpson)
- Coached 15 All-Americans at UT Martin
- Produced 14 players who have advanced to NFL opportunities. The list includes Montori Hughes, who became the first UT Martin player chosen in the NFL Draft since 1996 when the Indianapolis Colts snagged the defensive tackle in the fifth round of the 2012 draft.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 87-73 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 69-42 mark against OVC opponents (.621 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 94 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 87 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 69 conference wins come in at fourth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 15 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013), Tony Bell (2013, 2014) and Terry Williams (2019).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - seven times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018 and 2019 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 27-12 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.

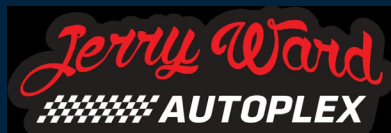

- Do **NOT** provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do **NOT** provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do **NOT** provide the use of an automobile.
- Do **NOT** provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do **NOT** provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do **NOT** use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You **MAY** provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You **MAY** employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy.
