SETTING THE SCENE

• The University of Tennessee at Martin football team will officially end its 472-day hiatus from competition with the opening of its 2020-21 campaign against Ohio Valley Conference regional rival Murray State on Sunday, Feb. 28. Kickoff from Stewart Stadium is scheduled for 2 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.

• UT Martin will open its 92nd season of football and 29th as a Division I program in 2020-21. The Skyhawks are looking to improve upon their 11-3 mark in OVC openers under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson.

• The Skyhawks (0-0, 0-0 OVC) enter the season coming off a 7-5 record in 2019 while finishing 6-2 in league play. UT Martin boasts four Preseason All-OVC selections in running back Peyton Logan (109 carries, 784 yards, six TDs), wide receiver/tight end Colton Dowell (38 receptions, 765 yards, four TDs), defensive tackle Austin Pickett (38 tackles, 7.0 TFL, 4.5 sacks) and safety JaQuez Akins (92 tackles, 5.5 TFL, 6 PBU). The Skyhawks also feature 2019 OVC Freshman of the Year John Bachus III at quarterback who completed 188-of-332 pass attempts for 2,549 yards and 18 touchdowns.

• UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson enters his 15th season at the helm of the Skyhawks as the program's all-time wins leader and the league's longest tenured head coach. Simpson boasts an all-time mark of 87-73 and ranks sixth in OVC history in career victories.

• Murray State (0-0, 0-0 OVC) enters its first year under head coach Dean Hood with a career record of 55-38. While this is Hood's first year with the Racers, he is no stranger to the OVC after previously serving as head coach at Eastern Kentucky for eight years from 2008-15 where he won two league titles (2008 and 2011) and earned three FCS Playoff berths (2008, 2011 and 2014).

• The Racers return their quarterback Preston Rice who started in all 12 games last season, throwing for 2,932 yards and 20 touchdowns while rushing for over 600 yards and a pair of scores. The squad also welcomes back a pair of Preseason All-OVC receivers in LaMartez Brooks (47 catches, 819 yards and seven touchdowns) and Malik Honeycutt who missed the previous season due to injury. On defense, the top returning tackler is Alec Long with 52 tackles – including 6.0 tackles for loss and 3.0 sacks – while Marcis Floyd led the secondary with two interceptions and five pass breakups.

• Sunday's contest marks the 60th meeting between the two programs in a series which originated in 1924. Murray State holds a 37-21-1 overall lead in the series but UT Martin has won 11 of the last 14 meetings.

Sophomore quarterback **John Bachus III** completed 16-of-25 passes for 216 yards and three touchdowns as UT Martin topped Tennessee State 28-17 to finish the home portion of its schedule 5-0. Bachus ranks 19th nationally in passing yards/completion (13.99). A candidate for the Jerry Rice Award, Bachus has been named OVC Newcomer of the Week four times.

SEASON 92

» The 2020-21 campaign is UT Martin's 92nd season of football despite suspending play during Great Depression (1933) and World War II (1942-45). The Skyhawks are in their 29th season at the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and compiled an overall record of 122-193 with one Ohio Valley Conference title (2006) and one NCAA Playoff appearance (2006) as a D-I program.

UT MARTIN PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

» The Ohio Valley Conference announced its preseason polls and all-conference performers in conjunction with the league's Football Media Day. UT Martin was picked to finish third in the preseason poll as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors as well as the Preseason Media Poll. The Skyhawks tallied 97 overall points.

JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

» UT Martin football coach **Jason Simpson** has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now in his 15th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 87 wins - sitting sixth in OVC history.

- In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 69-42 through 14 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 69 conference wins rank fourth in OVC history.

SUNDAYS IN THE SPRING

» The Conference portion of the 73rd season of Ohio Valley Conference football was postponed to the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This year's spring OVC schedule will include a round-robin format, featuring the eight teams that elected to play competing in seven conference games over an eight-week period (with an open date at the end of the schedule for potential make-up games). Games will be contested on Sundays (with the exception of Easter weekend when the games will be played on Saturday) and start during a 1-3 p.m. window local time.

NCAA DIVISION I PLAYOFF INFORMATION

» The 2020 FCS Playoffs were pushed to the spring. This year's field will be 16 teams (down from 24) and include 10 automatic qualifiers and six at-large selections. The NCAA will announce the selections for a revised 16-team playoff field on Sunday, April 18. The first round is scheduled for the weekend April 24 with the FCS National Championship game to be played on May 16 in Frisco, Texas.

DOWELL PICKS UP NUMEROUS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN HONORS

» UT Martin junior wide receiver/tight end **Colton Dowell** made the rounds with several preseason All-American honors from various publications. He garnered All-American honors from Stats Perform (first team), HERO Sports (second team) and Phil Steele (second team).
 » Dowell used his 2019 campaign to breakout as a spotlight contributor for the Skyhawk offense. He led the team with 765 receiving yards while ranking second in receptions (38) and touchdowns (four). The athletic target averaged 20.1 yards per reception and tallied 63.8 receiving yards per game.

FOUR SKYHAWKS NAMED TO HERO SPORTS PRESEASON OVC ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

» Four Skyhawk football standouts have been named to the Preseason Ohio Valley Conference All-Conference team by HERO Sports. The trio of **Peyton Logan** (running back), **Colton Dowell** (wide receiver/tight end) and **Aries Davis** (offensive line) garnered offensive honors while **JaQuez Akins** (safety) earned a spot on the defensive squad.

TEN SKYHAWKS EARN SPOT ON PHIL STEELE PRESEASON ALL-OVC LIST

» A total of 10 UT Martin football players garnered 11 spots on the annual Phil Steele Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference teams. The group of **Peyton Logan** (running back and all-purpose), **Aries Davis** (offensive guard) and **JaQuez Akins** (defensive back) took home first team honors while **Rodney Williams II** (wide receiver), **Colton Dowell** (tight end) and **Austin Pickett** (defensive line) were second team selections. The quartet of **John Bachus III** (quarterback), **Donnell Williams** (wide receiver), **Korbin Harmon** (defensive line) and **D'Carrious Stephens** (linebacker) wrapped up the third team.

FIVE SKYHAWKS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-OVC

» A total of five Skyhawk football standouts were honored today by the Ohio Valley Conference as Preseason All-OVC performers by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.
 » The Skyhawk group includes three players on offense and two on defense. Joining the list is running back Peyton Logan, wide receiver/tight end Colton Dowell, offensive guard Aries Davis, defensive tackle Austin Pickett and safety JaQuez Akins. The team's five OVC selections ranked as the second-most in the league.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 14 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 87-73 record (.543 winning percentage) and a 69-42 mark against OVC opponents (.621 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 94 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 87 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 69 conference wins come in at fourth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 15 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013), Tony Bell (2013, 2014) and Terry Williams (2019).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ

Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - seven times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018 and 2019 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 27-12 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.

UT Martin posted a 7-5 record while going 6-2 in the OVC in 2019 to finish one game out of first place. The Skyhawks went 5-0 at home while ranking amongst OVC leaders in scoring offense (30.5 ppg, second), scoring defense (19.5, first), pass efficiency (144.7, second), pass defense efficiency (111.0, first), punt return average (16.9, first), interceptions (nine, second), sacks (25, first) and turnover margin (+5, first). As a whole, nine Skyhawks garnered 11 postseason honors as the group of Aries Davis, Austin Pickett, TJ Jefferson, JaQuez Akins and Terry Williams earn All-OVC first team honors while Peyton Logan, Colton Dowell and DaVonte Maura picked up second team honors. Freshman quarterback John Bachus III - a finalist for the Jerry Rice Freshman of the Year Award - was named the program's second OVC Freshman of the Year along with All-Newcomer honors.

Prior to accepting his first head coaching job at UT Martin, Simpson was the offensive coordinator at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He was instrumental in the resurgence of the UTC football program. In 2005, Chattanooga posted a 6-5 campaign, the school's first winning season since 1997.

Before Chattanooga, Simpson coached at Texas State University, a member of the Southland Football League. He coached quarterbacks, receivers and served as the team's recruiting coordinator. In 2000, Texas State posted a 7-4 record, the school's first winning season in 10 years.

Simpson served as an assistant coach from 1997-1999 at Jacksonville State University. He coached quarterbacks and was the team's passing game coordinator. He also coached receivers and served as an assistant special teams coordinator. He was a member of the Jacksonville State staff responsible for the third best turnaround in Division I football for the 1997 and 1998 seasons.

An Ellisville, Miss. native, Simpson signed as a quarterback with Mississippi State and played for two seasons for the Bulldogs. He also played baseball for Ron Polk at Mississippi State before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992. At Southern Miss, Simpson was a two-time all-conference selection in baseball and was team captain his senior season.

After earning a bachelor's degree in 1994 from Southern Miss, he spent the next year as a graduate assistant football coach at Delta State, where he coached defensive backs. In the spring of 1995, Simpson served as an assistant football and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

Simpson and his wife, the former Julie Wilkerson, have two sons and a daughter: Ty, Emma and Graham. The family lives in Martin and attends First Baptist Church.
