- UT Martin is looking to give the fans a show in the team's home opener after posting a 13-2 mark in its home debut at Graham Stadium since 2006. Historically, the Skyhawks have averaged 46.3 points per game in home openers while posting an average margin of victory of 31.9 points during that span.
- The Skyhawks (0-1) are coming off a 59-21 loss in the team's season opener last week at FBS foe Western Kentucky. UT Martin jumped out to an early lead by scoring a touchdown on its first drive while recording an interception on the team's first defensive drive to take the early momentum. After the quick start by the Skyhawks, the Hilltoppers took control from there by throwing for eight touchdowns through the air including seven from the nation's leading passer Bailey Zappe.
- Highlighting the contest was the play of graduate transfer quarterback Keon Howard who tallied 239 yards of total offense while posting three total touchdowns including two rushing and one passing en route to OVC Newcomer of the Week honors. Howard's two rushing touchdowns marked the first time a Skyhawk quarterback has rushed for multiple touchdowns in a single game since 2007 against Samford. Junior receiver Colton Dowell also impressed, tallying his sixth 100-yard receiving game of his career while notching his 12th career touchdown reception.
- Tyler Larco earned his third OVC Specialist of the Week honor of his career after averaging 46.3 yards
 per punt including a 67-yard attempt. Graduate cornerback Jay Woods forced the lone turnover for
 the Skyhawk defense, snatching an interception on the opening defensive drive of the game. Junior
 safety Deven Sims also posted a big game, leading all players with 10 total tackles.
- Samford (1-0) opened the season with a 52-14 home victory over Tennessee Tech last Thursday. The
 Bulldogs posted 475 yards of total offense along with six touchdowns. Quarterback Liam Welch threw
 for 370 yards and four touchdowns while receiver Montrell Washington tallied eight catches for 170
 yards. On the defensive end, Lamar Anderson led the team with nine total tackles while the team as a
 whole posted 7.0 tackles for loss including three sacks.
- Saturday's contest marks the 20th meeting between the former OVC rivals with Samford holding a 15-3-1 advantage in the series. The two teams have not met since 2007 while the Skyhawks enter the contest winning the last two matchups against the Bulldogs.



Notable Facts

- •Simpson is the longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference
- •Has a 72-46 career record against OVC foes (UTM won 20 OVC games in 14 seasons before Simpson)
- •Coached 16 All-Americans at UT Martin
- •Produced 14 players who have advanced to NFL opportunities. The list includes Montori Hughes, who became the first UT Martin player chosen in the NFL Draft since 1996 when the Indianapolis Colts snagged the defensive tackle in the fifth round of the 2012 draft.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 15 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 90-77 record (.539 winning percentage) and a 72-46 mark against OVC opponents (.610 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 102 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 14 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 90 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 72 conference wins come in at fourth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 16 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013), Tony Bell (2013, 2014), Rodney Williams II and Terry Williams (2019).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee – eight times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018, 2019 and 2020 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 29-13 all-time record in the Sgt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.



- Do NOT provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do NOT provide the use of an automobile.
- Do NOT provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do NOT provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do NOT use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You MAY provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You MAY employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy.
