

SETTING THE SCENE

- >> The University of Tennessee at Martin football team hits the road for a non-conference matchup at Southland Conference foe Northwestern State on Saturday, Sept. 18. Kickoff from Turpin Stadium is scheduled for 6 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- >> This marks the fourth matchup against Northwestern State in series history with UT Martin holding a narrow 2-1 advantage. After splitting the previous home-and-home series back in the mid-60s, the Skyhawks claimed a 42-20 victory in the most recent matchup on Aug. 29, 2019.
- >> The Skyhawks (1-1) are coming off a thrilling comeback 33-27 victory against Samford on Saturday night. After falling behind 17-0 due to five turnovers in the first 16 minutes of the game, UT Martin strung together a stretch which included 26 unanswered points while holding Samford to just one scoring drive in the second half.
- >> Three players racked up Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Week honors as the trio of running back Peyton Logan (Offensive), linebacker D'Carrious Stephens (Defensive) and quarterback Keon Howard (Newcomer) produced big performances in the win. Logan tallied 169 all-purpose yards in the contest along with two long touchdown receptions of 60 and 51 yards, respectively. Stephens ranked second on the team with five tackles but tallied 1.5 tackles for loss and a key interception to seal the team's victory. Meanwhile Howard finished the game with 229 yards passing and 66 yards rushing to tally three total touchdowns.
- >> UT Martin enters the matchup ranked first in the OVC in scoring offense (27.0), total offense (432.5), rushing offense (220.5), rushing defense (73.0), interceptions (3), punting (40.7), PATS kicking (100%), sacks against (0.5/gm), first downs (23.5), third-down conversion (50.0%) and time of possession (38:26) as a team. Individually, the Skyhawks have 23 players ranked in the top-5 of various statistical categories.
- >> Northwestern State (0-2) is looking for the team's first win this season after opening the campaign by dropping back-to-back road games at North Texas (44-14) and Alcorn (13-10). The Demons average 12.0 points per game while averaging 340.5 yards of total offense. Quarterback Kaleb Fletcher is 35-of-53 on the year with 373 yards, two touchdowns and two interceptions. Wide receiver Kendrick Price, Jr. ranks as the team's top playmaker with seven catches for 129 yards and two touchdowns. Defensively, Jomard Valsin has a team-high 15 tackles on the season.

QUICK HITS



Senior running back **Peyton Logan** had a big game against Samford en route to OVC Offensive Player of the Week honors. Logan had 13 touches and 169 all-purpose yards while tallying two touchdown. He had touchdown receptions of 60 and 51 yards for a total of 122 receiving yards while tallying nine carries for 47 yards.

SKYHAWKS CLAIM THREE OVC WEEKLY AWARDS

» The Skyhawks claimed three OVC weekly honors after the Week 2 win over Samford as **Peyton Logan** [169 all-purpose yards and two touchdowns) was named the Offensive Player of the Week while **D'Carrious Stephens** [five tackles, 1.5 TFL and 1 INT] was tabbed the Defensive Player of the Week. **Keon Howard** [295 yards of total offense, three TDS] wrapped up the weekly accolades by being named Newcomer of the Week for the second straight week.

» This marks the second consecutive week that the Skyhawks have earned multiple player of the week honors from the conference.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

» After five turnovers in the first 16 minutes of the contest against Samford, UT Martin faced a 17-0 deficit in the first quarter. The Skyhawks would respond by outscoring the Bulldogs 33-3 until a late touchdown in the fourth quarter. The comeback victory marked the first rally of at least 14 points since 2015 against Murray State.

LOGAN IS PRIMED FOR A BIG PLAY

» With two receiving touchdowns against Samford of 60 and 51 yards, respectively, senior **Peyton Logan** once again showed his ability to make a big play. So far this season, Logan has tallied five plays totaling 25 yards or more while recording 50 in his career - including 8 touchdowns.

DUAL THREAT QUARTERBACK

» Graduate quarterback **Keon Howard** has quickly acclimated to life in a Skyhawk uniform while sitting amongst the league's elite. Heading into Week 3, Howard leads the OVC and ranks sixth in the NCAA with six total touchdowns responsible for after tallying three passing and three rushing scores.

LEADING THE GROUND ATTACK

» UT Martin has produced a strong ground attack this season, eclipsing 200 rushing yards in its first two games. The Skyhawks lead the league and rank 15th nationally with 220.5 rushing yards per game. The squad also boasts two of the top-five rushers in the league in **Peyton Logan** (61.0/gm, 4th) and **Keon Howard** (55.0/gm, 5th).

ADDING SOME CAJUN SPICE TO SCHEDULE

» With a trip to Northwestern State on the horizon, the Skyhawks are looking to add a like cajun flavor to the team's 2021 schedule. UT Martin is hoping to flip the script on it's previous history in the state of Louisiana where the program has posted a 2-12 mark all-time. The team's last win in the state came in 1977 against Nicholls.

JASON SIMPSON CHRONICLES

» UT Martin football coach **Jason Simpson** has been a pillar of consistency in the Ohio Valley Conference since taking over the Skyhawk program prior to the 2006 season. Now in his 16th season at the helm of the program, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while ranking first among active OVC coaches with 91 wins. He needs one more win to tie Bob Spoo (Eastern Illinois) for fifth place in OVC history.

» In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 72-46 through 15 seasons, more than doubling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 71 conference wins rank fourth in OVC history while he is just the sixth head coach in the league to coach at the same institution for at least 15 years - joining Roy Kidd (EKU), Boots Donnelly (Middle Tennessee), Charles Murphy (Middle Tennessee), Bob Spoo (EIU) and Don Wade (TTU).

HOWARD PUNCHES IT IN (TWICE)

» Graduate quarterback Keon Howard posted a big game in his debut against WKU. Along with tallying 239 yards of total offense, he espeically left his mark by tallying two rushing touchdowns in the contest to be named OVC Newcomer of the Week. With the two scores, Howard became the first Skyhawk quarterback to score two rushing touchdowns in a single game since Dexter Anoka accomplished the feat against Samford in 2007.

» Since the 2006 season, UT Martin ranks as the winningest active member of the Ohio Valley Conference with 72 victories. After winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league, the Skyhawks are 72-46 since 2006 while sitting six wins above the closest program in Eastern Illinois during that span. The Skyhawks have finished .500 or above in conference play in 13 of the last 15 seasons - including four top-two finishes during that span.

DIPPING INTO THE TRANSFER PORTAL

>> The Skyhawks added to a veteran return group this offseason by dipping into the transfer portal and acquiring talents from several FBS programs. The Skyhawks brought in three graduate transfer which are tabbed to play a big role including linebacker Robert Hicks (Louisville), quarterback Keon Howard (Tulane) and running back Tim Taylor (Memphis).

>> UT Martin also welcomes in former 5-star defensive end Eyabi Anoma (Alabama/Houston) along with defensive back Shawn Shamburger (Tennessee), wide receiver Randy Fields Jr. (West Virginia), defensive tackle Keion Willis (Missouri), defensive end Jay Rogers (Northern Colorado) and running back Jordan Castleberry (Maryland/Michigan).

SKYHAWK GARNER ESPN SPOTLIGHT

» UT Martin currently has all 11 of the team's games available to a national audience through the ESPN family of networks. The Skyhawks will have nine of its contests broadcasted live on ESPN+ while matchups against Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State will be broadcast on ESPN3.

SGT. YORK TROPHY SERIES

>> UT Martin finished last season with a 2-1 record in the annual Sqt. York Trophy series which pits Tennessee members of the Ohio Valley Conference for state supremacy for a share of the traveling trophy.

>> UT Martin has won or shared the Sqt. York Trophy in eight times in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2018, 2019 and 2020. The Skyhawks hold a 29-13 all-time record in the series - the best mark of the four Tennessee OVC schools (Austin Peay, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech).

BATTLE FOR THE VOLUNTEER STATE

Football has been a storied part of the state of Tennessee's history for decades. Dating back to the 2010 season, UT Martin ranks third in the state - including all Division I universities - in winning percentage at 52.6 percent. The Skyhawks are 18-7 against in-state foes since 2014.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 16 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 91-78 record (.538 winning percentage) and a 72-46 mark against OVC opponents (.610 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 102 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 90 career victories rank sixth in OVC history while his 72 conference wins come in at fourth place.

Three of the program's seven 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all three at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He was responsible for the program's first-ever OVC championship team in 2006, as that team ended the season with a national No. 13 ranking after finishing 9-3.

Simpson is a three-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012 and 2016 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He won the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award and the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year accolade in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 16 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. Those include Alex Atkins (2006), Don Chapman (2006), Jessie Burton (2006), Josh Yarbrough (2007), Dontrell Miller (2008), Ray Williams (2008), Joe Gibbs (2009), Josh Bey (2009), CJ Estelle (2011), Montori Hughes (2012), Quentin Sims (2012), Jeremy Butler (2013), Ben Johnson (2013), Tony Bell (2013, 2014), Rodney Williams II (2020) and Terry Williams (2019).

In April 2012, Hughes became the 12th UT Martin player and first since 1996 to be selected in the NFL Draft. Hughes was picked by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round (139th overall). Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots),

Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans) and Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaquars) have all received opportunities with NFL

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee - eight times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018, 2019 and 2020 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015 and 2016. UT Martin owns a 29-13 all-time record in the Sqt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.

Prior to accepting his first head coaching job at UT Martin, Simpson was the offensive coordinator at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He was instrumental in the resurgence of the UTC football program. In 2005, Chattanooga posted a 6-5 campaign, the school's first winning season since 1997.

Before Chattanooga, Simpson coached at Texas State University, a member of the Southland Football League. He coached quarterbacks, receivers and served as the team's recruiting coordinator. In 2000, Texas State posted a 7-4 record, the school's first winning season in 10 years.

Simpson served as an assistant coach from 1997-1999 at Jacksonville State University. He coached quarterbacks and was the team's passing game coordinator. He also coached receivers and served as an assistant special teams coordinator. He was a member of the Jacksonville State staff responsible for the third best turnaround in Division I football for the 1997 and 1998 seasons.

An Ellisville, Miss, native, Simpson signed as a quarterback with Mississippi State and played for two seasons for the Bulldogs. He also played baseball for Ron Polk at Mississippi State before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992. At Southern Miss, Simpson was a two-time all-conference selection in baseball and was team captain his senior season.

After earning a bachelor's degree in 1994 from Southern Miss, he spent the next year as a graduate assistant football coach at Delta State, where he coached defensive backs. In the spring of 1995, Simpson served as an assistant football and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

Simpson and his wife, the former Julie Wilkerson, have two sons and a daughter: Ty, Emma and Graham. The family lives in Martin and attends First Baptist Church.

UT MARTIN FOOTBALL COMES UP SHORT IN OFFENSIVE SHOOTOUT AT WKU 59-21

BOWLING GREEN, Ky. – The University of Tennessee at Martin football team showed glimpses of an explosive offensive unit but could not outmatch a gunslinging Western Kentucky squad, dropping the season opener on the road by a score of 59-21.

The Skyhawks (0-1) jumped out to an early lead with a strong scoring drive on the opening possession followed up by an impressive interception on the Tops first drive to give fans a glimpse of the team's potential. After the early score, WKU settled down and found its grove in a big way behind its star quarterback before rattling off 59 points – including eight passing touchdowns.

UT Martin began the season by tallying 396 yards of total offense while posting a strong ground attack with 201 rushing yards. The Skyhawks averaged 5.9 yards per carry on the team's 34 rush attempts while the passing game saw the squad throw for 195 yards while tossing one touchdown.

While the offensive day would have ranked as the second-best outing during the shortened 2020 campaign, it was no match for the explosive Hilltopper offense. WKU made easy work of the UT Martin defense after its opening drive, tallying 587 yards of total offense while 478 of those yards came through the air. With the nation's passing leader in Bailey Zappe playing his first game in a Tops uniform, he picked up where he left off at Houston Baptist with over 10,000 passing yards by completing 28-of-35 pass attempts for 424 yards and seven touchdowns.

Graduate transfer quarterback Keon Howard led the Skyhawk offense on the gridiron with a strong debut. Howard completed 20-of-43 pass attempts while throwing for 195 yards and one touchdown. He also used his mobility to rattle off 44 yards on the ground while punching in a pair of rushing touchdowns from two and nine yards out, respectively. With his day, he became the first Skyhawk quarterback to rush for two touchdowns in a game since Dexter Anoka accomplished the feat on Oct. 13, 2007 against Samford.

Other top contributors on the offensive end was Peyton Logan who made the most of his seven carries by scampering for 75 yards on the afternoon, highlighted by a big 31-yard carry. In the passing game, the team's two All-OVC receivers in Colton Dowell and Donnell Williams posted nice season debuts. Dowell tallied his sixth career 100-yard receiving game with 102 yards and his 12th career touchdown. Williams led the team with seven catches while tallying 80 yards – including a 32-yard one-handed snag.

Defensively, All-OVC graduate cornerback Jay Woods left an early impression by snagging his first career interception on the opponent's first offensive drive. Meanwhile, another All-OVC selection in Deven Sims continued his trend after leading the team with tackles last season by recording a game-high 10 stops. The pair of Carson Evans and D'Carrious Stephens also posted nice individual efforts with eight tackles while Louisville transfer Robert Hicks tallied seven of his own.

On special teams, All-OVC specialist Tyler Larco posted a big night in the punting game by averaging 46.3 yards per punt. His best punt came in the second quarter when he flipped the field inside the team's own 20 by booting a career-long 67-yard attempt which ranks as the 10th longest punt in program history. He also made three PATS for three total points.

BIG COMEBACK EFFORT LEADS SKYHAWKS TO WIN IN HOME OPENER OVER SAMFORD 33-27

MARTIN, Tenn. – A large first quarter deficit proved to be surmountable for the University of Tennessee at Martin football team on Saturday evening as the squad overcame an early 17-point hole before picking up a 33-27 non-conference victory in the home opener.

The Skyhawks [1-1] stumbled out of the gates by compounding mistakes which led to five first half turnovers and 17 unanswered points by the visiting Bulldogs. With Samford visiting Graham Stadium for the first time since 2007 when both teams were members of the Ohio Valley Conference, UT Martin turned to its home crowd of 5,869 fans and big plays to spark its rally.

While a quick look at a box score can be deceiving, the Skyhawks were dominant during large stretches. As a whole, UT Martin tallied 469 yards of total offense along with four total touchdowns while the defense limited an explosive Samford team to just 254 yards – including 37 yards on the ground. With the win, the Skyhawks recorded their first victory after trailing by 14 points or more since 2015.

After being held scoreless for the first quarter, UT Martin wasted little time getting on the board in the opening minutes of the second. The Skyhawks needed just two plays to find the endzone as quarterback Keon Howard connected with Peyton Logan with a screen pass on the left side before the running back broke free and scampered 60 yards down the sideline for a touchdown. Following another scoring driving – this time punctuated by a seven-yard rushing touchdown by Howard – the tandem connected again on a nearly identical play as Logan tip-toed down the sideline and into the endzone to give the Skyhawks their first lead of the night at 21-20.

With a new game at hand, UT Martin went into halftime holding a 24-20 advantage after a 31-yard field goal by Tyler Larco split the uprights as time expired in the second quarter.

UT Martin added to its margin in the second half as Zak Wallace polished a long 14-play scoring drive which eclipsed eight minutes by punching in a touchdown from two yards out with 5:13 to play in the third. The team tallied their final points with 9:54 to play in the game as JaQuez Akins got to the quarterback for a sack and a safety in the endzone.

The game took another dramatic turn in the fourth quarter as Samford saw the home team score 19 unanswered points. Wanting to find a final push, the Bulldogs traveled 87 yards over 2:15 before Liam Welch found Montrell Washington for a 24-yard touchdown. With the contest back down to a six-point margin, the Bulldogs hoped for a late comeback but an interception by D'Carrious Stephens with 1:29 to play sealed the victory for UT Martin.
