SETTING THE SCENE

- >> The University of Tennessee at Martin football program hits the road for its fourth game of the season and final non-conference test with a matchup against United Athletic Conference foe North Alabama on Saturday, Sept. 23. Kickoff from Braly Municipal Stadium is scheduled for 6 p.m. on ESPN+.
- >> The Skyhawks (2-1) hit the road after an impressive homestand in which the squad picked up two victories over Missouri State and Houston Christian while averaging 52.0 points per game. After rushing for over 400 yards against the Bears, UT Martin continued to turn the screws on its opponents by racking up 707 yards of total offense while scoring nine touchdowns in a 66-7 blowout victory. Along with the team's potent offensive attack, the Skyhawks also forced four turnovers against HCU with three interceptions and a fumble recovery.
- >> UT Martin enters the matchup ranked amongst the nation's leaders in several categories. The Skyhawks currently rank second nationally in total offense (493.0 ypg) and third in rushing offense (269.0 ypg) while also sitting 11th with 71 first downs and 12th in scoring offense (37.0 ppg). On the defensive side of the ball, the Skyhawks rank 15th nationally with four interceptions while sitting 18th in turnovers game (six).
- >> Quarterback Kinkead Dent posted a breakout performance in the win over HCU, completing 20-of-27 attempts for 347 yards and five touchdowns. Along with his five passing touchdowns, he also added a nine-yard rushing score to give him six total touchdowns – a mark not reached by a Skyhawk quarterback against a FCS opponent since 2012. As a whole, the Skyhawks threw six passing touchdowns in the game to six different receivers for the first time in program history.
- >> North Alabama (2-2) has alternated wins and losses over the first four weeks of the season, including a 20-7 win at Tennessee Tech last weekend. UNA's defense shutout the Golden Eagle offense for the whole game – with TTU's lone score coming on a pick six – while forcing five turnovers in the win.
- >> In a long series which dates back to 1949, UT Martin and North Alabama meet on the gridiron for the first time since 1990 this weekend. After squaring off 32 times dating back to the two teams time in the Division II ranks, UNA holds a 19-12-1 advantage in the series. UT Martin's last win in Florence came by a 38-14 decision back in 1988.

QUICK HITS

SIMPSON ON OVC LEADERBOARD

>> UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson currently ranks fourth in OVC history with 108 wins and trails Charles Murphy for third place by nine.

>> Now in his 18th season at UTM, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while sitting first among active OVC coaches in victories and becoming just the sixth head coach to spend at least 15 years at the same institution - joining Roy Kidd (EKU), Boots Donnelly (Middle Tennessee), Charles Murphy (Middle Tennessee), Bob Spoo (EIU) and Don Wade (TTU).

>> In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 82-47 through 18 seasons, more than tripling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 81 conference wins rank third in OVC history.

700 YARDS OF TOTAL OFFENSE

>> UT Martin posted a dominating offensive performance against Houston Christian, racking up 707 yards of total offense. Not only did the yardage rank as a FCS single-game high this season, but ranked as the second-best yardage total in school history - sitting only behind a 821-yard performance against Murray State in 2007 - a stretch of 172 games.

OLD SERIES RENEWED

>> In a long series which dates back to 1949, UT Martin and North Alabama meet on the gridiron for the first time since 1990 this weekend. After squaring off 32 times dating back to the two teams time in the Division II ranks, UNA holds a 19-12-1 advantage in the series. UT Martin's last win in Florence came by a 38-14 decision back in 1988.

HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE

>> UT Martin has found success at Hardy Graham Stadium this season, winning 18 of its last 21 contests since 2019 - including a 11-1 record over the past three seasons.

OFFENSE IS ROLLING

>> UT Martin has put up back-to-back strong offensive outings against Missouri State and Houston Christian. The Skyhawks currently rank second nationally in total offense (493.0 ypg) and third in rushing offense (269.0 ypg) while also sitting 11th with 71 first downs and 12th in scoring offense (37.0 ppg).

DENT AIRS IT OUT

>> Skyhawk quarterback Kinkead Dent had a big day against Houston Christian after throwing five touchdowns in the victory. The contest marked the seventh time that a Skyhawk has thrown for five or more touchdowns, joining Derek Carr (3x), Jarod Neal (2x) and John Bachus III.

MOVE THE CHAINS

>> Along with the team's 707 yards of total offense in the win over Houston Christian, the Skyhawks also set a new school record by racking up 32 first downs. The performance bested the program's previous record of 30 set against Bethel in 1995.

SIX IS A SERIOUS NUMBER

>> While the Skyhawks did not set a school record for passing touchdowns against Houston Christian, the mixture of receivers did. The contest marked the first time in program history that six different receivers caught the team's six touchdown catches with DeVonte Tanksley, Trevonte Rucker, Shawn Hardy II, Ajay Smith, Marlon Cook, Jr. and Zoe Roberts each finding the endzone.

FRANKLIN ECLIPSES THE CENTURY MARK AGAIN

>> Running back Sam Franklin ranks second nationally in rushing yards per game after eclipsing the 100-yard rushing mark in back-to-back contests for the Skyhawks. After a near record-setting 259 yards against Missouri State, Franklin stayed hot with 127 yards against Houston Christian. For his career, Franklin has eclipse 100 rushing yards in four contests while tallying 1,175 yards fo his career.

POUNDING THE GROUND ATTACK

>> UT Martin put a heavy emphasis on the ground attack against Missouri State and racked up 405 rushing yards on 41 carries. The Skyhawks averaged 9.9 yards per rush and ranked as the most rushing yards since UT Martin ran for 531 yards against Murray State on Nov. 10, 2007 - a span of 171 games.

NO FLY ZONE

>> The Skyhawks boasted a stingy defense last season, ranking second nationally in turnovers gained with 28 while sitting third nationally with 17 interceptions. After notching multiple interceptions in five contests last season, the Skyhawks posted their first multi-interception contest of 2023 in a win against Houston Christian after tallying three picks.

FRANKLIN IS PRIMED FOR A BIG PLAY

>> With four touchdowns in his career of 65 yards or more, sophomore Sam Franklin has shown his ability to make a big play. After scoring touchdowns of 89, 86 and 65 yards on the ground in 2022, he ripped off an 81-yard touchdown on the opening drive against Missouri State. As a whole, he has tallied $1\bar{8}$ plays totaling 20 yards or more - including nine touchdowns

SCORING IN BUNCHES

>> The Skyhawks put up points in bunches in the team's win over Houston Christian. UT Martin scored on its opening offensive drive of the game and never looked back on the way to nine touchdowns and 66 points. The team's 66 points ranked as the highest scoring output against a FCS opponent since a 66-59 victory at Murray State on Oct. 13, 2012.

QUICK HITS

LEFLORE BREAKS LOOSE

>> Newcomer Narkel LeFlore has tallied three kickoff returns of 20 yards or more this season but his big return came against Houston Christian when he opened the second half with a 95-yard touchdown. The scamper ranked as the first kickoff return for a touchdown since Peyton Logan also returned a kick 95 yards against EKU in 2017.

OVC SUPREMACY

>> Since the 2006 season, UT Martin ranks as the winningest active member in the Ohio Valley Conference with 82 victories. After winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league, the Skyhawks are 82-47 since 2006 while sitting 14 wins above the closest program in Eastern Illinois (68-59) during that span. The Skyhawks have finished .500 or above in conference play in 15 of the last 17 seasons - including six top-two finishes.

QUEST FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE CROWNS

>> UT Martin enters 2023 looking for more after winning back-to-back OVC championships for the first time in school history. After notching the program's first league championship in 15 years in 2021, the Skyhawks cruised to an unbeaten record and its second straight OVC title in 2022. UT Martin is now the latest OVC program to win back-to-back titles since Jacksonville State reigned supreme from 2014-18.

FINAL CONTEST OF TWO-YEAR OVC-SOUTHLAND SCHEDULING ALLIANCE

>> Saturday's contest marks the second and final matchup for the Skyhawks in the OVC-Southland Scheduling Alliance announced back in October of 2021 which paired conference members during the 2022 and 2023 campaigns. To date, there have been nine matchups on the schedule with OVC teams going 7-2 against Southland schools - including the Skyhawks sweeping their two matchups against HCU.

» Under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson, the Skyhawks have taken pride in winning games against in-state opponents. » UT Martin has won or shared the Sgt. York Trophy 10 times including in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022. The Skyhawks hold a 35-13 all-time record in the series - the best mark of the three Tennessee OVC schools (Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin).

BATTLE FOR THE VOLUNTEER STATE

Football has been a storied part of the state of Tennessee's history for decades. Dating back to the 2010 season, UT Martin ranks second in the state - including all Division I universities - in winning percentage at 55.8 percent. The Skyhawks are 23-8 against in-state foes since 2014.

EIGHT SKYHAWKS NAMED TO BLUEBLOODS PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

>> The two-time defending OVC league champions were well represented on The Bluebloods 2023 Preseason All-Conference Team as eight Skyhawks garnered preseason honors. The group of Sam Franklin (running back), DeVonte Tanksley (wide receiver), DJ Nelson (tight end), Gavin Olson (offensive line), Lamar Morgan (offensive line), Daylan Dotson (defensive end), Jay Rogers (defensive tackle) and Oshae Baker (cornerback) highlighted the squad.

DOTSON FLOODS THE BACKFIELD

>> Junior defensive end Daylan Dotson made life hard for opposing offenses last season. Dotson paced the OVC in both tackles for loss (14.5) and sacks (9.5). He was also named both FCS National Defensive Player of the Week and OVC Defensive Player of the Week after registering 2.0 sacks (one solo, two assists), two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries and a defensive touchdown against Houston Christian.

RECORD-SETTING TURNOVER JACKPOT

>> The Skyhawk defense hit the jackpot in a win against Houston Christian last season by recording seven turnovers - including four fumble recoveries and three interceptions. The team's seven forced turnovers tied the program's Division I single-game record along with another seven-turnover outing against Eastern Illinois back in 2004. Additionally, the Skyhawks tallied five forced fumbles which set a new program single-game, surpassing the previous mark of four set against Lambuth back in 2010.

TANKSLEY BREAKS DIVISION I RECEIVING RECORD

>> Junior DeVonte Tanksley set a new program Division I record last year by becoming the first player in the team's 31-year history to eclipse 200 receiving yards in the team's win over Murray State. Tanksley hauled in nine catches for 220 yards, becoming just the second player in UT Martin's all-time history to eclipse 200 yards by joining William Mackall who tallied 283 against Troy in 1988 during the team's Division II Fra

SKYHAWKS IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 18 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 107-85 record (.559 winning percentage) and an 82-47 mark against OVC opponents (.636 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 147 All-OVC players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 107 career victories rank fourth in OVC history while his 82 conference wins sits in third place.

Four of the program's eight 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all four at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He is responsible for the program's only OVC championship teams in 2006, 2021 and 2022. The 2006 team ended the season ranked No. 13 nationally with a 9-3 record while the 2021 team won the playoff game in the Division I Era while finishing the campaign ranked No. 12 nationally with a 10-3 overall mark. The Skyhawks completed back-to-back league titles with a 2022 championship after going 7-4 overall while posting the program's first unbeaten conference slate with a 5-0 record.

Simpson is a four-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012, 2016 and 2021 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He is also a two-time recipient of the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award in 2006 and 2021 while being named the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 34 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. A collection of those players include Alex Atkins (2006), Tony Bell (2013, 2014), Josh Bey (2009), Jessie Burton (2006), Jeremy Butler (2013), Don Chapman (2006), Daylan Dotson (2022), CJ Estelle (2011), John H. Ford II (2022), Joe Gibbs (2009), Matthan Hatchie (2021, 2022), Montori Hughes (2012), Ben Johnson (2013), Dontrell Miller (2008), Brock Powers (2022), Quentin Sims (2012), Ray Williams (2008), Rodney Williams II (2020), Terry Williams (2019) and Josh Yarbrough (2007).

Simpson has also overseen the development of six major award winners, 58 All-OVC first team honorees, 69 second team selections and 20 OVC All-Newcomer picks. The Skyhawks have had two OVC Offensive Players of the Year in Don Chapman (2006) and Keon Howard (2021) and one OVC Defensive Player of the Year with John H. Ford II (2022). They have also boasted three OVC Freshmen of the Year honorees in Don Chapman (2004), John Bachus III (2019) and Sam Franklin (2022)

Two Skyhawks have been drafted during the Simpson Era with wide receiver Colton Dowell (2023) and defensive tackle Montori Hughes (2012) hearing their names called on the final day of their respective drafts. Hughes was taken in the fifth round (139th pick) of the 2012 NFL Draft by the Indianapolis Colts while Dowell was selected in the seventh round (228th pick) in 2023 by the Tennessee Titans. Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans), Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars), Caylon Weathers (Chicago Bears), Brett Thompson (Pittsburgh Steelers), Joe Este (Tennessee Titans), Jaylon Moore (Baltimore Ravens), Donnell Williams (Tennessee Titans and Washington Commanders), Rodney Williams II (Denver Broncos), Dowell (Tennessee Titans) and Dresser Winn (Los Angeles Rams) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee – 10 times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018, 2019 and 2020 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2021 and 2022. UT Martin owns a 34-13 all-time record in the Sqt. York Trophy series, which is the best mark out of the four OVC schools.

Prior to accepting his first head coaching job at UT Martin, Simpson was the offensive coordinator at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He was instrumental in the resurgence of the UTC football program. In 2005, Chattanooga posted a 6-5 campaign, the school's first winning season since 1997.

Before Chattanooga, Simpson coached at Texas State University, a member of the Southland Football League. He coached quarterbacks, receivers and served as the team's recruiting coordinator. In 2000, Texas State posted a 7-4 record, the school's first winning season in 10 years.

Simpson served as an assistant coach from 1997-1999 at Jacksonville State University. He coached quarterbacks and was the team's passing game coordinator. He also coached receivers and served as an assistant special teams coordinator. He was a member of the Jacksonville State staff responsible for the third best turnaround in Division I football for the 1997 and 1998 seasons.

An Ellisville, Miss. native, Simpson signed as a quarterback with Mississippi State and played for two seasons for the Bulldogs. He also played baseball for Ron Polk at Mississippi State before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992. At Southern Miss, Simpson was a two-time all-conference selection in baseball and was team captain his senior season.

After earning a bachelor's degree in 1994 from Southern Miss, he spent the next year as a graduate assistant football coach at Delta State, where he coached defensive backs. In the spring of 1995, Simpson served as an assistant football and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

Simpson and his wife, the former Julie Wilkerson, have two sons and a daughter: Ty, Emma and Graham. The family lives in Martin and attends First Baptist Church.

SKYHAWK FOOTBALL HANGS TOUGH BUT FALLS IN **SEASON OPENER AT NO. 1 GEORGIA**

The University of Tennessee at Martin battled throughout the evening against two-time defending Football Bowl Subdivision champion Georgia before falling 48-7 in front of a sellout crowd of 92,746 fans at Sanford Stadium.

The Skyhawk defense showed out in the first quarter, limiting the No. 1 ranked Bulldogs to seven points on just 59 total yards over three drives - including a pair of three-and-outs. Georgia scored 10 points in the second quarter to take a 17-0 halftime advantage. Following 21 unanswered Bulldog points, UT Martin got on the scoreboard with a touchdown with 6:39 remaining in the fourth quarter before Georgia registered 10 points over the final 2:09 to close out the contest.

The Skyhawks (0-1) committed only one turnover in the contest and allowed just one sack to a Bulldog (1-0) squad that won their school-record 18th consecutive game.

Graduate quarterback Kinkead Dent made his Skyhawk debut tonight, completing 18 passes for 128 yards and a touchdown. The Yazoo City, Miss. native also added a team-best 47 rushing yards on just six carries.

Trevonte Rucker made an acrobatic one-handed catch for UT Martin's touchdown, hauling in a nine-yard scoring reception. He was one of nine Skyhawks to catch a pass tonight as Eastern New Mexico transfer Asa Wondeh tallied team-highs of four receptions and 42 yards.

On the ground, Sam Franklin gained 46 yards on a team-best 12 carries while Jordan Castleberry checked in with 56 all-purpose yards (31 rushing, 25 receiving).

Defensively, UT Martin was led by Jaylon Sharpe's game-high eight tackles and 0.5 tackles for loss. Chris Hunter had a big performance with seven tackles (five solo) and a tackle for loss while Oshae Baker managed five solo stops with a tackle for loss and a forced fumble. Calvontay Key (0.5 tackles for loss), Josh Hastings (five solo tackles) and Kaleb Almo (three tackles) also had pass breakups for the Skyhawk secondary. Jarid Johnson and Davonte Murray additionally secured 0.5 tackles for loss on the UT Martin defensive line.

On special teams, Aidan Laros boomed eight punts for an average of 50.2 yards per boot, including a long of 66 yards. He consistently pinned Georgia deep in its own territory, placing two punts inside the 20-yard line with impressive hang

Georgia was paced by Carson Beck's 294 passing yards as he completed 21of-31 passes with a touchdown. Brock Vandagriff also threw for a touchdown while Brock Bowers caught five passes for 77 yards to go along with a rushing score. Roderick Robinson II and Carson Beck both rushed for touchdowns while Mekhi Mews and Oscar Delp had touchdown receptions. Malaki Starks (eight tackles) and Kyron Jones (26-yard interception return for a touchdown) guided the Bulldog defense.

FRANKLIN RUNS WILD AS SKYHAWK FOOTBALL HOLDS OFF MISSOURI STATE. 38-31 IN HOME OPENER

A dominant rushing performance out of redshirt sophomore running back Sam Franklin set the tone for the University of Tennessee at Martin football team this evening as the Skyhawks defeated Missouri State by a 38-31 margin on Family Weekend at Hardy Graham Stadium.

UT Martin cruised to a 24-7 halftime advantage before the visiting Bears scored 17 unanswered points to even the score with 9:39 remaining. Both sides swapped touchdowns on their ensuing possessions before a Franklin touchdown from 20 yards out – his third score of the night – with 1:45 to go and one final defensive stand sealed the triumph. The victory increased the Skyhawks' record to 16-2 in home openers under head coach Jason Simpson.

Franklin ended his night with a career-best 259 rushing yards on 20 totes, averaging a whopping 13.0 yards per carry. The Little Rock, Ark. native ranked second in school history in single-game rushing yards, trailing only Don Chapman's 272 yards at Southeast Missouri on Oct. 30, 2004. Franklin took the opening play of the game 81 yards untouched for a rushing touchdown and also scored on a 49-yard scamper in the fourth quarter before his gamewinning touchdown. This contest marked the second outing with three rushing touchdowns in his career - joining his performance against Lindenwood in 2022.

As a unit, the UT Martin (1-1) offensive line showed out to the tune of 405 yards on 41 carries tonight – averaging 9.9 yards per rush. That performance on the ground was the most by a Skyhawk team since UT Martin ran for 531 yards against Murray State on Nov. 10, 2007 – a span of 171 games.

Kinkead Dent passed for a pair of touchdowns this evening, hitting Austin Bray and Marlon Cook, Jr. for scores in the first half. Devonte Tanksley set team-highs with four receptions and 44 yards as eight different UT Martin receivers hauled in passes

Defensively, Carson Evans tallied a career-high 14 tackles while Oshae Baker (two tackles for loss) accumulated a career-best 10 tackles. Daylan Dotson piled up 10 stops, a fumble recovery and a game-high four quarterback hurries while tying Giovanni Davis for the team lead with 2.5 tackles for loss. JaMichael McGoy came away with the first Skyhawk interception of the season while Jarid Johnson had a sack and forced fumble. The trio of Josh Hastings, Jack Lucas and Tevin Shipp registered two pass breakups apiece for UT Martin, who limited the Bears to 155 total yards in the opening half.

Aidan Laros continued the spectacular start to his Skyhawk career as the redshirt sophomore from Cape Town, South Africa booted four punts to a 44.5-yard average and made a 29-yard field goal. He also split the uprights on all five PAT attempts.

Missouri State (0-2) was led by quarterback Jacob Clark, who passed for 332 yards and three touchdowns. Raylen Sharpe posted seven receptions for 142 yards and a touchdown while Jacardia Wright (team-high 46 rushing yards), Jmariyae Robinson and D'Vontae Key each found the endzone while Todric McGee amassed a game-high 15 tackles with three pass breakups.

SKYHAWK FOOTBALL COASTS TO DOMINANT 66-7 IN ONE-SIDED HOME ROUT OF HCU

All three phases shined for the University of Tennessee at Martin football squad this evening as the Skyhawks soared for a complete 66-7 triumph over Southland Conference opponent HCU at Hardy Graham Stadium.

UT Martin (2-1) outgained the visiting Huskies by a 707-213 margin in total offense as the Skyhawk offense posted 8.3 yards per play on the way to eight touchdowns (six passing, two rushing). The scoring performance were the most points for UT Martin against a Football Championship Subdivision opponent since a 66-59 victory at Murray State on Oct. 13, 2012.

Defensively, the Skyhawks held HCU to only seven first downs and 39 rushing yards (1.6 yards per carry). The Huskies (1-2) were limited to 3-for-15 on third down conversions as UT Martin recorded four sacks, 10 tackles for loss and forced three turnovers (two interceptions and a fumble recovery).

On special teams, Narkel LeFlore returned the opening kickoff of the second half 95 yards to the house for the Skyhawks' first kick return touchdown since Oct. 21, 2017 at Eastern Kentucky. Aidan Laros was a perfect 9-for-9 in PAT attempts and added a 33-yard field goal for UT Martin.

Kinkead Dent was on fire tonight as the graduate signal-caller from Yazoo City, Miss. was responsible for six combined scores. He completed 20 of his 27 pass attempts for 347 yards with five touchdowns, connecting with five different wide receivers for scores. The Ole Miss transfer also rushed for his first career touchdown to become the first UT Martin quarterback with six scores against a FCS opponent since Nov. 3, 2012. Kody Sparks came in with 6:45 to go in the third quarter and went 7-for-9 for 90 yards and his first career touchdown to give the Skyhawks 437 yards of passing offense.

Ten different UT Martin wide receivers hauled in a catch this evening as DeVonte Tanksley (team-highs of six receptions and 120 yards), Trevonte Rucker, Shawn Hardy II, Zoe Roberts, Marlon Cook, Jr. and Ajay Smith each reeled in touchdown catches. Asa Wondeh also had a big game with five receptions for 99 yards for the Skyhawks, who generated 247 yards after catch as a unit.

Sam Franklin paced the UT Martin rushing attack with 127 yards on 17 carries in addition to a touchdown. Corey Harris (six rushes for 49 yards) and Glover Cook, Jr. (six rushes for 42 yards) also performed well in the second half for the Skyhawks, who ran for 270 yards and 5.5 yards-per-carry behind another excellent performance by the offensive line.

Kaleb Almo made the most out of his first career start, racking up a teambest seven tackles out of the UT Martin secondary. Oshae Baker (interception) and LaMarion Pierce (interception), JaMichael McGoy (forced fumble) and Jack Lucas (fumble recovery, game-high two pass breakups) all had their hands in turnovers for the Skyhawks. Daylan Dotson came away with 1.5 sacks while Charles Perkins (one), Bryce Dailey (one) and Giovanni Davis (0.5) also amassed sacks to pace 11 different UT Martin players with tackles for loss. Tevin Shipp broke through the line for a game-high three quarterback hurries to cap off a thorough effort for the Skyhawk defense.
