- » The University of Tennessee at Martin football program makes its longanticipated home debut this weekend when playing host to United Athletic Conference foe North Alabama on Saturday, Sept. 14. Kickoff from Hardy M. Graham Stadium is slated for 6 p.m. and will be broadcast exclusively on ESPN+.
- >> The annual Hall of Fame Game caps off a loaded weekend which includes the induction of the Class of 2024 for the UT Martin Athletics Hall of Fame. Jack Bendure (men's basketball, 1969-72), Kara Bergenty (equestrian, 2009-13), Tom Britt (broadcaster, 1981-2021), Joe Gibbs (football, 2006-09), Hunter Richardson (golf, 2014-18) and Leonard Williams (football, 1990-91) will be officially enshrined on Saturday before being recognized at halftime.
- >> The Skyhawks (0-2) enter the contest looking for their first win of the season and will lean on the friendly confines of Hardy Graham Stadium to propel them. UT Martin has won 21 of its last 24 games at home since 2019 - including a 14-1 record over the past three seasons.
- >> UT Martin suffered a tough loss in its previous matchup, dropping a doubleovertime showdown against Big South-OVC Football Association rival Southeast Missouri on the road by a final margin of 45-42. The Skyhawks led by 14 points in the fourth quarter but the Redhawks responded with the game-tying touchdown with 39 seconds to play. Both teams found touchdowns in the first overtime period but it was SEMO who converted its field goal attempt in the second overtime period to lift the home squad to an early lead in the conference
- >> North Alabama (0-3) also enters the weekend looking for its first win of the season. UNA opened the season in Week 0 with a neutral site matchup against Southeast Missouri (37-15) before falling to Memphis (40-0) and Illinois State [24-17] in consecutive weeks.
- » In a long series which dates back to 1949, UT Martin and North Alabama meet in back-to-back seasons for the first time since both programs were in the Division II ranks. While UNA holds a 19-13-1 advantage in the all-time series, the Skyhawks came out of last season's matchup with a 37-21 road victory in Florence.

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK LEAGUE CHAMPIONS

>> For the third consecutive season. UT Martin has won its conference championship after finishing the league slate with a 5-1 record and clinching at least a share of the inaugural Big South-OVC Football Association title. After winning back-to-back OVC championships in 2021 and 2022, the Skyhawks now await Gardner-Webb's final league matchup to see if the title will be shared or not after a headto-head loss against the Runnin' Bulldogs. A win by Gardner-Webb would also secure GWU a share and the association's automatic bid.

» UT Martin is the sixth program to win three or more consecutive titles in the OVC's history and the first since Jacksonville State reigned supreme from 2014-18.

GIBBS AND WILLIAMS ELECTED TO HALL OF FAME >> Former UT Martin standouts Joe Gibbs (2006-09)

and Leonard Williams (1990-91) will join four other former student-athletes when they are enshired into the UT Martin Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2024. >> Gibbs logged 31 consecutive starts on the offensive line and did not allow a sack in 23 starts over his final two seasons while leading Williams was a dynamic quarterback in the program's final two seasons at the NCAA Division II level while leaving the program ranking first in career touchdown passes (40), second in career passing yards (4,518) and career total offense (4,850).

QUICK HITS

SKYHAWKS STALL REDHAWKS GROUND ATTACK

>> While the offensive numbers were eye-popping in the head-to-head matchup between UT Martin and Southeast Missouri, the Skyhawks kept the Redhawks rushing attack at bay. The Skyhawks held SEMO to -11 rushing yards in the contest while allowing a combined -6 yards against the Redhawks in the last two meetings.

SMITH RUSHES FOR OVER 100 YARDS

>> Vanderbilt transfer running back **Patrick Smith** received his first start in a Skyhawk uniform against Southeast Missouri and made the most of it by setting new career-highs with 26 carries for 148 yards and a touchdown. His previous career high was 95 yards and a touchdown as a true-freshman against Missouri in 2021.

RUCKER FINDS THE ENDZONE TWICE

» Senior wide receiver **Trevonte Rucker** posted a big game against Southeast Missouri by posting his first multi-touchdown effort of his collegiate career. Rucker scored twice in the second quarter on touchdown catches of 20 and three yards on back-to-back drives.

BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

>> This is the second season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The modified agreement will now extend through at least 2030. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. >> Schools in the association are Charleston Southern, Eastern Illinois, Gardner-Webb, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois.

OVC SUPREMACY

» Since the 2006 season, UT Martin ranks as the winningest active member in the Ohio Valley Conference with 87 victories. After winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league, the Skyhawks are 87-49 since 2006 while sitting 15 wins above the closest program in Eastern Illinois (68-60) during that span. The Skyhawks have finished .500 or above in conference play in 16 of the last 18 seasons - including six top-two finishes.

» UT Martin defensive back **Oshae Baker** has been tabbed as a consensus preseason All-American through the offseason. Baker has earned Preseason All-American honors from FCS Football Central, Phil Steele and Stats Perform.

EIGHT SKYHAWKS NAMED BIG SOUTH-OVC PRESEASON PLAYERS TO WATCH LIST

» Eight Skyhawk were named to the Big South-OVC Football Association Preseason Player to Watch List. The Skyhawk group includes four players on offense, three on defense and one specialist. The team was headlined by quarterback Kinkead Dent, running back Narkel LeFlore, wide receiver DeVonte Tanksley, offensive guard Drake Carroll, defensive end Charles Perkins, linebacker Jaylon Sharpe and defensive back Oshae Baker. DEFENSE HOLDS THE RUSHING ATTACK

» UT Martin's defense made moving the ball on the ground difficult all last season as the squad ranked sixth in FCS with 96.3 rushing yards allowed per game. The Skyhawks limited opponents to fewer than 100 rushing yards in five contests - including a season-low five yards against Southeast Missouri.

» For the 11th time in program history, UT Martin won the annual **Sgt. York Trophy** after knocking off Tennessee State (20-10) and Tennessee Tech (44-41). The Sgt. York Trophy goes to the winner of the season football series between the Ohio Valley Conference schools located in the state of Tennessee - including Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin.

» UT Martin has claimed the Sgt. York Trophy every year since 2018 and 11 times overall. The Skyhawks boast a 36-13 record in the series - the best mark of the three school - and have won outright or shared the traveling trophy in 2010, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023.

>> The Skyhawks finished 2023 with the seventh rated total offense in FCS with 439.8 yards per game while boasting the eighth ranked 223.0 passing yards per game.

» Senior Narkel LeFlore tallied 12 kickoff returns of 20 yards or more last season but his big return came against Houston Christian when he opened the second half with a 95-yard touchdown. The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 18 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 115-87 record (.569 winning percentage) and an 87-48 mark against conference opponents (.644 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 160 all-conference players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 115 career victories rank fourth in OVC history while his 87 conference wins sits in third place.

Five of the program's nine 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all five at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He is responsible for the program's only OVC championship teams in 2006, 2021, 2022 and 2023. The 2006 team ended the season ranked No. 13 nationally with a 9-3 record while the 2021 team won the first playoff game in the Division I Era and finished the campaign ranked No. 12 nationally with a 10-3 overall mark. The Skyhawks completed back-to-back league titles with a 2022 championship after going 7-4 overall while posting the program's first unbeaten conference slate with a 5-0 record. The squad then rattled off a three-peat in the inaugural season of the Big South-OVC Football Association with an 8-3 overall mark while going 5-1 in league action.

Simpson is a four-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012, 2016 and 2021 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He is also a two-time recipient of the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award in 2006 and 2021 while being named the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 38 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. A collection of those players include Alex Atkins (2006), Tony Bell (2013, 2014), Josh Bey (2009), Jessie Burton (2006), Jeremy Butler (2013), Don Chapman (2006), Daylan Dotson (2022, 2023), CJ Estelle (2011), John H. Ford II (2022), Sam Franklin (2023), Joe Gibbs (2009), Matthan Hatchie (2021, 2022), Montori Hughes (2012), Ben Johnson (2013), Aidan Laros (2023), Dontrell Miller (2008), Gavin Olson (2023), Charles Perkins (2023), Brock Powers (2022), Quentin Sims (2012), Ray Williams (2008), Rodney Williams II (2020), Terry Williams (2019) and Josh Yarbrough (2007).

Simpson has also overseen the development of seven major award winners, 65 all-conference first team honorees, 75 second team selections and 20 OVC All-Newcomer picks. The Skyhawks have had two OVC Offensive Players of the Year in Don Chapman (2006) and Keon Howard (2021) and one OVC Defensive Player of the Year with John H. Ford II (2022). He also oversaw the development of Big South-OVC Special Teams Player of the Year Aidan Laros during the 2023 campaign. They have also boasted three OVC Freshmen of the Year honorees in Don Chapman (2004), John Bachus III (2019) and Sam Franklin (2022).

Two Skyhawks have been drafted during the Simpson Era with wide receiver Colton Dowell (2023) and defensive tackle Montori Hughes (2012) hearing their names called on the final day of their respective drafts. Hughes was taken in the fifth round (139th pick) of the 2012 NFL Draft by the Indianapolis Colts while Dowell was selected in the seventh round (228th pick) in 2023 by the Tennessee Titans.

The program had a shining moment in 2023 when three former Skyhawks earned spots on active NFL rosters with Dowell (Tennessee Titans), Rodney Williams II (Pittsburgh Steelers) and Dresser Winn (Los Angeles Rams) representing UT Martin. Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butter (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans), Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars), Caylon Weathers (Chicago Bears), Brett Thompson (Pittsburgh Steelers), Joe Este (Tennessee Titans), Jaylon Moore (Baltimore Ravens), Donnell Williams (Tennessee Titans and Washington Commanders), Rodney Williams II (Denver Broncos), Dowell (Tennessee Titans) and Winn (Los Angeles Rams) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the four OVC teams located in Tennessee – 11 times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018, 2019 and 2020 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2021, 2022 and 2023. UT Martin owns the best record in the Sgt. York Trophy series while boasting a 36-13 all-time mark.

Prior to accepting his first head coaching job at UT Martin, Simpson was the offensive coordinator at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He was instrumental in the resurgence of the UTC football program. In 2005, Chattanooga posted a 6-5 campaign, the school's first winning season since 1997.

Before Chattanooga, Simpson coached at Texas State University, a member of the Southland Football League. He coached quarterbacks, receivers and served as the team's recruiting coordinator. In 2000, Texas State posted a 7-4 record, the school's first winning season in 10 years.

Simpson served as an assistant coach from 1997-1999 at Jacksonville State University. He coached quarterbacks and was the team's passing game coordinator. He also coached receivers and served as an assistant special teams coordinator. He was a member of the Jacksonville State staff responsible for the third best turnaround in Division I football for the 1997 and 1998 seasons.

An Ellisville, Miss. native, Simpson signed as a quarterback with Mississippi State and played for two seasons for the Bulldogs. He also played baseball for Ron Polk at Mississippi State before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992. At Southern Miss, Simpson was a two-time all-conference selection in baseball and was team captain his senior season.

After earning a bachelor's degree in 1994 from Southern Miss, he spent the next year as a graduate assistant football coach at Delta State, where he coached defensive backs. In the spring of 1995, Simpson served as an assistant football and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

Simpson and his wife, the former Julie Wilkerson, have two sons and a daughter: Ty, Emma and Graham. The family lives in Martin and attends First Baptist Church.



FLORENCE, Ala. – A swarming defensive unit set the tone this evening for the University of Tennessee at Martin football squad as the Skyhawks piled up 27 unanswered second-half points in a 37-21 nonconference victory at North Alabama.

UT Martin (3-1) rolled to its third straight win after mounting a memorable comeback in the final 30 minutes. Trailing 21-7 at the halftime break, the Skyhawk defense limited the host Lions to only 160 yards of total offense on 48 plays from that point forward – keeping North Alabama off the scoreboard in the process.

Meanwhile, the UT Martin offense dialed up four touchdowns in the final 19:46 to seize momentum and silence the crowd of 8,836 fans in Braly Municipal Stadium. Zoe Roberts caught the go-ahead touchdown with 1:53 remaining in the third quarter before Sam Franklin iced the game with scoring runs of 74 and 43 yards in the fourth stanza.

Jack Lucas wrapped up a team-best nine tackles (seven solo) for UT Martin with Jaylon Sharpe and Jay Rogers following closely behind with eight stops apiece. Chris Hunter, Jr. snagged his first career interception to stall a Lion drive in the fourth quarter while Jarid Johnson (two tackles for loss), Daylan Dotson (two tackles for loss) and Giovanni Davis each came away with sacks. In the secondary, Oshae Baker batted away three of the Skyhawks' eight pass breakups tonight.

Offensively, Franklin shouldered a heavy load with a career-high 32 carries for 221 yards. This evening's performance marked his second 200-plus yard rushing outing in three weeks for the redshirt sophomore out of Little Rock, Ark., who tied Bobby Fowler (1956-59) for the second-most 200-yard rushing games in school history in just his 17th career game.

Narkel LeFlore registered the first rushing touchdown of his young UT Martin career, finding the endzone on the opening drive of the game. Marlon Cook, Jr. capped off a 17-play drive with a rushing touchdown on a reverse to open the scoring in the second half.

Kinkead Dent completed 13 passes for 172 yards and the aforementioned touchdown to Roberts, also extending several drives with 37 rushing yards on eight carries. Remaining upright for the entire evening thanks to zero sacks allowed from the Skyhawk offensive line, Dent's favorite targets consisted of Trevonte Rucker (team-highs of four receptions and 60 yards), Roberts (four catches, 44 yards) and DeVonte Tanksley (three receptions for 44 yards).

On special teams, Aidan Laros split the uprights for a 20-yard field goal in the second quarter while additionally placing four of his five punts inside the Lions' 20-yard line. The redshirt sophomore from Cape Town, South Africa averaged 44.6 yards per punt and successfully converted four PAT's.

North Alabama [2-3] could only muster 95 yards of rushing on 36 carries. Noah Walters passed for 286 yards and three touchdowns while Kobe Warden posted 11 receptions for 106 yards and a touchdown. Takairee Kenebrew and Dakota Warfield additionally tallied catches for scores in the first quarter. Defensively, Edwin White Schultz secured a game-high 10 tackles and had a fumble recovery to guide the Lions.

SKYHAWK FOOTBALL PUTS UP A FIGHT BUT FALLS AT NO. 17 KANSAS STATE IN SEASON OPENER

The University of Tennessee at Martin football team left it all on the field this evening in its 2024 opener but fell to Football Bowl Subdivision No. 17 ranked Kansas State by a 41-6 margin.

The Skyhawks won the turnover margin, forcing a pair of Wildcat mistakes while not turning the ball over tonight. UT Martin also controlled the time of possession (33:30 to K-State's 26:30) and committed just four penalties as it was an 11-point game nearly 40 minutes into the contest before the Wildcats scored 24 unanswered points to wrap up the night.

Chris Hunter, Jr. (third career interception), Lanard Harris (forced fumble) and Steven Ballard (fumble recovery) each helped force turnovers for the Skyhawks. Jaylon Sharpe collected a team-best five stops – including a gamehigh two tackles for loss – while Jabaree Dawkins also contributed a tackle for loss. Hunter tacked on a pass breakup to pace a UT Martin defense that limited K-State to 4-for-10 on third-down conversions.

Offensively, Kinkead Dent threw for 87 yards while Kaiya Sheron also saw time at quarterback, completing all three of his pass attempts over the final three drives. Dent hit Trevonte Rucker for a 45-yard completion – the longest pass play of the night for either side – while the trio of DeVonte Tanksley, Max Dowling and Airius Trice each had a team-best two receptions. On the ground, Narkel LeFlore and Patrick Smith both posted a team-high nine carries for the Skyhawks.

Newcomer Jaren Van Winkle accounted for both of UT Martin's scores, nailing field goal tries from 34 and 31 yards out. The redshirt junior out of Clay, Ala. also handled punting duties, booting eight punts for an average of 42.4 yards, landing a 65-yarder in the first guarter.

"It was a 17-6 game in the third quarter and I thought our defense did some really good things but they got tired at the end and our offense couldn't stay on the field," Skyhawk head coach Jason Simpson said. "Give Kansas State credit – it was a great environment and a great college football atmosphere. There's a lot that we can learn from tonight – we need to show improvement and grow from this. We'll get back to work and get ready for a conference game next week."

UT MARTIN FOOTBALL DROPS DOUBLE-OVERTIME SHOWDOWN TO SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The University of Tennessee at Martin football went toe-to-toe with Big South-OVC Football Association rival Southeast Missouri in a double-overtime matchup but ultimately fell short in the road contest by a final 45-42 margin.

The Skyhawks (0-2, 0-1 Big South-OVC) led by two touchdowns in the fourth quarter before the Redhawks charged back in the final minutes - including a touchdown with 39 seconds to play by the home squad to force overtime.

Once in the overtime period, the game continued its see-saw affair in a game which saw six lead changes. In the first period, SEMO connected quickly on an 11yard pass from Paxton DeLaurent to Mitchell Sellers for their third consecutive touchdown connection to take the early advantage. Then the Skyhawks found some new life when a potential game-ending interception was overturned, setting up a seven-yard jet sweep from Kinkead Dent to Asa Wondeh to tie the game and send it to double-overtime. A 36-yard field goal attempt by the Skyhawks was pushed right, opening the door for SEMO who converted its 37-yard field goal attempt to walk-off with the 45-42 victory.

In an offensive matchup, UT Martin tallied 470 yards of total offense by delivering 277 yards through the air and 193 yards with the rushing attack. Dent paced the offense with an efficient game, completing 23-of-33 pass attempts for 277 yards and four touchdowns through the air. Meanwhile on the ground, Patrick Smith carried a heavy lead with 26 attempts for 148 yards and a touchdown.

One of Dent's top targets was graduate receiver DeVonte Tanksley who caught seven of his 12 targets for 113 yards. Then a pair of first half connects from Dent to Trevonte Rucker resulted in passing touchdowns – scoring on receptions of 20 and three yards, respectively.

On the defensive side of the ball, transfer cornerback Rob Johnson played a gutsy game in the secondary. Despite battling an injury throughout the second half, he led the team with seven tackles and a staggering four pass breakups. Meanwhile the trio of Jaylon Sharpe, Josh Hastings and Oshae Baker each tallied five tackles while Baker tied the program record for career pass breakups with a pair to bring his all-time total up to 30 - tying Chris Jones atop the UT Martin leaderboard. Rounding out the top defensive contributors was outside linebacker Michael Pleas, Jr. who tallied 1.5 sacks in the contest.

Southeast Missouri (2-1, 1-0 Big South-OVC) continued its impressive play at home, pushing its home winning streak against the Skyhawks to three games. The Redhawks passed it 64 times and racked up 365 yards of total offense behind the arm of DeLaurent, who completed 36-of-63 pass attempts for 376 yards and six touchdowns. SEMO posted a pair of 100-yard receivers in the contest with Cam Pedro pacing the team with nine receptions for 126 yards while Dorian Anderson hauled in eight catches for 127 yards and a pair of scores. Sellers did most of the damage however as he tallied six receptions for 60 yards - including

A fourth quarter forced fumble by Bryce Norman played a big key in the comeback victory as the Preseason Big South-OVC Defensive Player of the Year racked up 13 tackles in the victory. Khalani Riddick (11 tackles) and Mali Walton (10 tackles) also reached double figures for the Redhawks.
