




- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team makes its home finale when playing host to OVC-Big South Football Association foe Charleston Southern on Saturday, Nov. 15.
- Collectively, the Class of 2025 has been a part of four consecutive conference championships in 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 while posting the program's lone FCS playoff victories in 2021 and 2024. As a whole, the team has recorded 42 victories including a 26-5 mark (83.9 percent) against league opponents since 2021.
- The Skyhawks (5-5, 5-1 OVC-Big South) enter their final homestand riding a four-game winning streak and sitting
 in sole possession of second place in the Association standings. During the stretch, UT Martin has committed
 just one turnover while dominating the ground attack by tallying 233.5 rushing yards per game and limiting
 opponents to just 50.2 rushing yards per game.
- The ground attack was especially potent in last week's matchup against Tennessee State when UT Martin tallied 53 carries for 292 rushing yards while limiting the Tigers to -12 yards on the ground. Running backs Tommy Ansley (118 yards) and Chris Franklin (111 yards) both eclipsed the 100-yard mark for the first time in their Skyhawks careers while quarterback Jase Bauer found the endzone twice for the third time this season.
- Charleston Southern (4-6, 3-3 OVC-Big South) has turned a corner in the third season under Gabe Giardina
 while winning three straight games heading into last week's bye week. Linebacker Steve Zayachkowsky leads
 the Association with 92 tackles on the season while Justin Waters paces the group with eight forced fumbles.
- Saturday's contest marks the fourth meeting between the two programs in a series which dates back to 1994
 with UT Martin winning each of the three previous matchups. Charleston Southern has visited Martin on two
 prior occasions back in 1994 and 2023 with the Skyhawks averaging 33 points per game against the Buccaneers
 all-time.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 20 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 129-97 record (.571 winning percentage) and a 98-51 mark against conference opponents (.657 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 174 all-conference players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 128 career victories rank third in OVC history while his 97 conference wins also sit in third place – with both totals only trailing Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky) and Boots Donnelly (Austin Peay/Middle Tennessee). Included in those victories are two wins over Football Bowl Subdivision programs with upset victories against Memphis (2012, 20-17) and Kennesaw State (2024, 24-13).

Six of the program's 10 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all six at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He is responsible for the program's only OVC championship teams in 2006, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2004. The 2006 team ended the season ranked No. 13 nationally with a 9-3 record while the 2021 team won the first playoff game in the Division I Era and finished the campaign ranked No. 12 nationally with a 10-3 overall mark. The Skyhawks completed back-to-back league titles with a 2022 championship after going 7-4 overall while posting the program's first unbeaten conference slate with a 5-0 record. The squad then rattled off a three-peat in the inaugural mark while going 5-1 in league action. The program then became just the fifth in OVC history to win four or more consecutive titles after boasting a 9-5 record and advancing to the second round of the FCS playoffs.

A note to UTM Supporters...

UT Martin's athletics department adheres to the rules and regulations of the NCAA and Ohio Valley Conference to protect the eligibility of our student-athletes. As a supporter of UTM Athletics, please do not provide any "extra benefits" to UTM student-athletes. The NCAA defines "extra benefits" as any special arrangement provided to a student-athlete or a student-athlete's family/friend that is not available to all other students at UT Martin. Therefore, please be aware of the following:

- Do **NOT** provide gifts, free or reduced cost services including meals, drinks, clothing, laundry, haircuts, legal fees or other benefits to student-athletes and their family and friends
- Do NOT provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do NOT provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do NOT provide the use of an automobile.
- Do NOT provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do **NOT** provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do NOT use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You MAY provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You MAY employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy.
