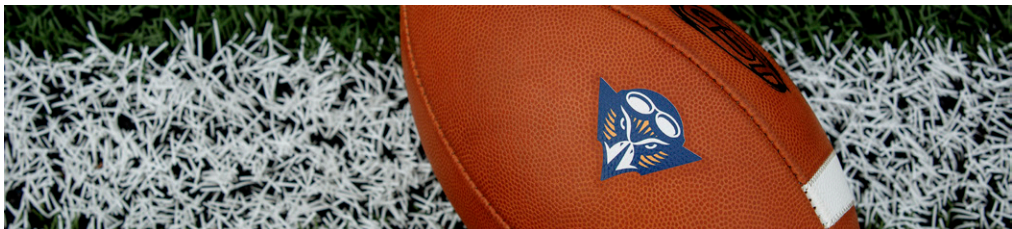

The University of Tennessee at Martin Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2025 includes **Dacotah Faught** (rifle, 2013-16), **Mark Guy** (football, 1983-84, 87-88), **Katie Jackson** (soccer, 2002-05) and **Ray Williams** (football, 2005-08).

An Amenia, ND native, **Faught** left UT Martin as one of the most decorated rifle student-athletes in program history. Heralded as a second-team All-American as a sophomore, she qualified for the NCAA Championships in each of her first two seasons before redshirting her junior campaign to train for the 2016 Olympic Games. She earned All-OVC accolades six times in her two seasons as a Skyhawk while also being tabbed the 2013-14 OVC Freshman of the Year. Her name is etched in the program record books while leaving with the top three individual scores in school history in both air rifle (597, still a school record) and smallbore (585). She later won the women's air rifle title at the 2014 USA National Championships held in Fort Benning, Ga. and earned a spot on Team USA at the World Championships.

Hailing from Olive Branch, Miss., **Guy** was a veteran playmaker on a squad which went 11-2, won the program's lone Gulf South Conference championship and earned a Division II quarterfinalist berth in 1988. Along with finishing as runner-up for GSC Freshman of the Year in 1983, he showed his versatility by contributing on offense as a wide receiver, on defense as a cornerback and as a kickoff return specialist. He finished his career with 117 career tackles, including 65 assists and 51 solo stops, while adding 11 pass breakups, four blocked kicks (including one returned for a touchdown), three fumble recoveries and an interception on defense. Switching to receiver for his senior season, he tallied 18 receptions for 247 yards and three touchdowns while averaging 13.7 yards per catch. On special teams, he returned 35 kickoffs for 573 yards while averaging 16.3 yards per return. Following his collegiate career, he enjoyed success in both the Canadian Football League and Arena Football League where he played for three titles and won two. He helped the Saskatchewan Roughriders claim the 1989 Grey Cup championship after tallying 100 receiving yards and 127 kickoff return yards in the contest before adding another championship with the Detroit Drive at Arena Bowl VI.

Jackson was a standout performer on the soccer pitch where she tied for the most OVC Offensive Player of the Week honors (four) in school history while also earning All-OVC honors in 2003. The Franklin, Tenn. native ranks second all-time in program history in points (70), second in goals (31), fifth in shots (181) and sixth in game-winning goals (six). She also still ranks in the top three in UT Martin single-season history in goals (16 in 2003, second), points (35 in 2003, third) and game-winning goals (4 in 2003, third). Her best performance came against Eastern Kentucky in 2005 when she became just the third player in school history to record a hat trick with three goals and an assist.

Williams put UT Martin football back on the map by helping the team to its first conference championship during the Division I era in 2006. The Demopolis, Ala. native was named an All-American and All-OVC first team defensive lineman in 2008 while also earning an all-conference second team nod in 2007. He finished his career with 137 total tackles, including 58 solo stops, while racking up 16.5 tackles for loss. The defensive stopper led the team in sacks in each of his final two seasons while racking up 9.5 sacks for his career. Additionally, he added eight quarterback hurries, two fumble recoveries and one forced fumble. After his career with the Skyhawks, he went on to become a world-renowned powerlifter, setting numerous world records.

- The University of Tennessee at Martin football program will host Missouri Valley Football Conference foe Southern Illinois for the team's home opener and annual Hall of Fame Game on Saturday, Sept. 13. Kickoff from Hardy Graham Stadium is scheduled for 6 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN+.
- The annual Hall of Fame Game caps off a loaded weekend which includes the induction of the Class of 2025 for the UT Martin Athletics Hall of Fame. Dacotah Faught (rifle, 2013-16), Mark Guy (football, 1983-84, 87-88), Katie Jackson (soccer, 2002-05) and Ray Williams (football, 2005-08) will be officially enshrined on Saturday before being recognized at halftime.
- The Skyhawks (0-2) enter the contest looking for their first win of the season and will lean on the friendly confines of Hardy Graham Stadium to propel them. UT Martin has won 25 of its last 30 games at home since 2019 – including an 18-3 record over the past four seasons. The Skyhawks have been especially strong in home openers where they have boasted wins in six straight seasons dating back to 2019.
- UT Martin will play its first Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) game of the season when playing host to Southern Illinois after back-to-back Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) matchups to open the campaign. The Skyhawks dropped road contests at Big 12 foe Oklahoma State (27-7) and Conference USA member UTEP (42-17) to open the season.
- Southern Illinois (1-1) enters the contest ranked nationally in both polls, sitting as high as No. 14 in the AFCA Coaches' Poll after winning its season opener against Thomas More (49-3) before falling to Big 10 foe Purdue (34-17) last week. The Salukis boast a dual-threat quarterback in DJ Williams who leads the team with six total touchdowns – four passing and two rushing – while throwing for 429 yards in two games. Defensively, Andrew Behm leads the team with 22 tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss.
- This marks the 10th meeting between the two programs in a series which began 99 years ago in 1926. Southern Illinois has held the upper hand in the series, winning eight of nine meetings. UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson has squared off against current SIU head coach Nick Hill on two occasions, once as a player in 2006 in the first round of the FCS Playoffs and then as an opposing coach in 2019.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 19 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 124-92 record (.574 winning percentage) and a 93-50 mark against conference opponents (.650 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 174 all-conference players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 124 career victories rank third in OVC history while his 93 conference wins also sit in third place – with both totals only trailing Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky) and Boots Donnelly (Austin Peay/Middle Tennessee). Included in those victories are two wins over Football Bowl Subdivision programs with upset victories against Memphis (2012, 20-17) and Kennesaw State (2024, 24-13).

Six of the program's 10 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all six at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He is responsible for the program's only OVC championship teams in 2006, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2004. The 2006 team ended the season ranked No. 13 nationally with a 9-3 record while the 2021 team won the first playoff game in the Division I Era and finished the campaign ranked No. 12 nationally with a 10-3 overall mark. The Skyhawks completed back-to-back league titles with a 2022 championship after going 7-4 overall while posting the program's first unbeaten conference slate with a 5-0 record. The squad then rattled off a three-peat in the inaugural season of the Big South-OVC Football Association with an 8-3 overall mark while going 5-1 in league action. The program then became just the fifth in OVC history to win four or more consecutive titles after boasting a 9-5 record and advancing to the second round of the FCS playoffs.

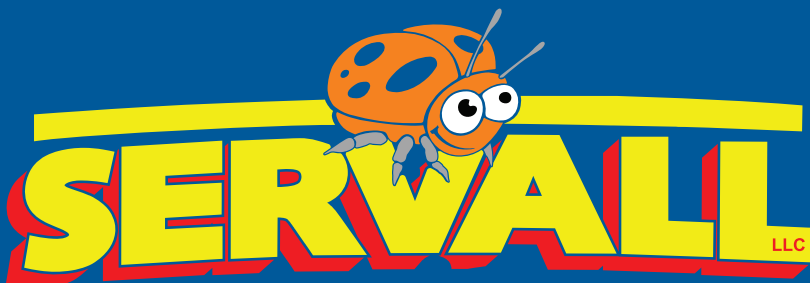

A note to UTM Supporters...

UT Martin's athletics department adheres to the rules and regulations of the NCAA and Ohio Valley Conference to protect the eligibility of our student-athletes. As a supporter of UTM Athletics, please do not provide any "extra benefits" to UTM student-athletes. The NCAA defines "extra benefits" as any special arrangement provided to a student-athlete or a student-athlete's family/friend that is not available to all other students at UT Martin. Therefore, please be aware of the following:

- Do **NOT** provide gifts, free or reduced cost services including meals, drinks, clothing, laundry, haircuts, legal fees or other benefits to student-athletes and their family and friends
- Do **NOT** provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do **NOT** provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do **NOT** provide the use of an automobile.
- Do **NOT** provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do **NOT** provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do **NOT** use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You **MAY** provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You **MAY** employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy.
