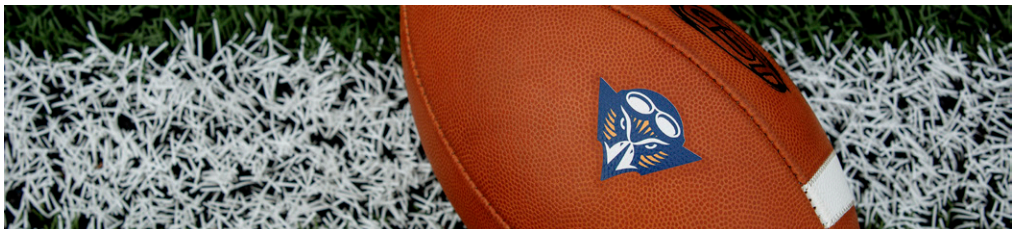

- The University of Tennessee at Martin opens its title defense by hosting OVC-Big South Football Association rival Southeast Missouri in both teams association opener on Saturday, Sept. 27. As part of Family Weekend, kickoff is scheduled for 6 p.m. on ESPN+.
- The Skyhawks (0-4, 0-0 OVC-Big South) enter the contest looking for their first win of the season. UT Martin is hoping its transition to league action will jump start the campaign as the program is looking to defend four consecutive conference championships dating back to 2021. During that span, the Skyhawks have boasted a 21-4 record against league opponents.
- Since the 2006 season, UT Martin ranks as the winningest active member in the Ohio Valley Conference with 93 victories. After winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league, the Skyhawks are 93-50 since 2006 while sitting 19 wins above the closest program in Eastern Illinois (74-68) during that span. The Skyhawks have finished .500 or above in conference play in 17 of the last 19 seasons - including nine top-two finishes.
- UT Martin's Jason Simpson and Southeast Missouri's Tom Matukewicz go head-to-head for the 12th time in Saturday's contest. The two head coaches rank as the longest tenured coaches in the OVC-Big South Association while combining for 188 wins and eight conference championships.
- Southeast Missouri (1-3, 0-0 OVC-Big South) has sat atop the Association standings with the Skyhawks by winning a share of league championships in 2022 and 2024. The Redhawks boast a high-powered offense averaging 24.8 points per game and 382.8 yards per game.
- Saturday's contest marks the 41st meeting between the two programs with the series split right down the middle with 20 wins a piece. UT Martin is 11-9 against Southeast Missouri at home - including wins in its last two contests at Hardy Graham Stadium in 2021 and 2023.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 19 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 124-92 record (.574 winning percentage) and a 93-50 mark against conference opponents (.650 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 174 all-conference players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 124 career victories rank third in OVC history while his 93 conference wins also sit in third place – with both totals only trailing Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky) and Boots Donnelly (Austin Peay/Middle Tennessee). Included in those victories are two wins over Football Bowl Subdivision programs with upset victories against Memphis (2012, 20-17) and Kennesaw State (2024, 24-13).

Six of the program's 10 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all six at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He is responsible for the program's only OVC championship teams in 2006, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2004. The 2006 team ended the season ranked No. 13 nationally with a 9-3 record while the 2021 team won the first playoff game in the Division I Era and finished the campaign ranked No. 12 nationally with a 10-3 overall mark. The Skyhawks completed back-to-back league titles with a 2022 championship after going 7-4 overall while posting the program's first unbeaten conference slate with a 5-0 record. The squad then rattled off a three-peat in the inaugural season of the Big South-OVC Football Association with an 8-3 overall mark while going 5-1 in league action. The program then became just the fifth in OVC history to win four or more consecutive titles after boasting a 9-5 record and advancing to the second round of the FCS playoffs.

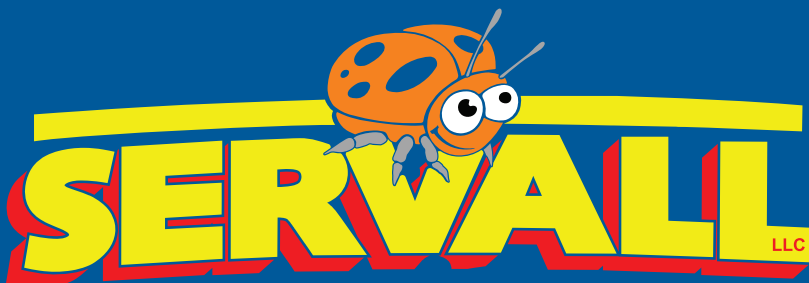

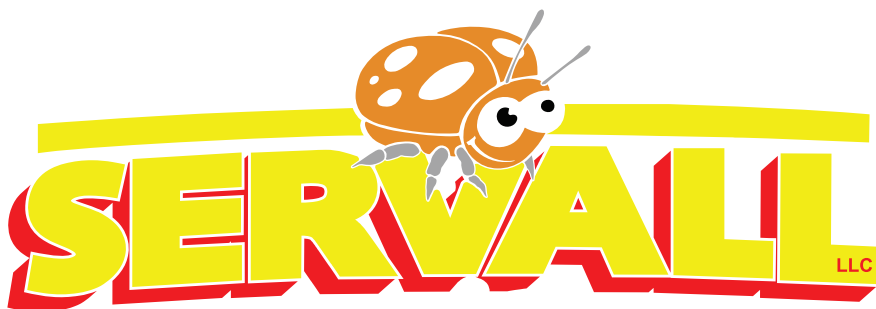

## UT MARTIN SKYHAWK ATHLETICS

### A note to UTM Supporters...

UT Martin's athletics department adheres to the rules and regulations of the NCAA and Ohio Valley Conference to protect the eligibility of our student-athletes. As a supporter of UTM Athletics, please do not provide any "extra benefits" to UTM student-athletes. The NCAA defines "extra benefits" as any special arrangement provided to a student-athlete or a student-athlete's family/friend that is not available to all other students at UT Martin. Therefore, please be aware of the following:

- Do **NOT** provide gifts, free or reduced cost services including meals, drinks, clothing, laundry, haircuts, legal fees or other benefits to student-athletes and their family and friends
- Do **NOT** provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do **NOT** provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do **NOT** provide the use of an automobile.
- Do **NOT** provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do **NOT** provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do **NOT** use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You **MAY** provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You **MAY** employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy.
