


- The University of Tennessee at Martin football team returns to the friendly confines of Hardy Graham Stadium to welcome alumni and friends for its annual Homecoming matchup on Saturday, Oct. 11 when playing host to OVC-Big South Football Association foe Western Illinois.
- Saturday's contest marks the program's annual Homecoming Game with the Skyhawks welcoming the Fighting Leathernecks to campus for the first time as an Association foe. UT Martin is 41-31 all-time in Homecoming games while the program is 13-5 during the Jason Simpson Era.
- UT Martin is looking to lean on its homefield advantage once again. After a thrilling 34-10 victory over Southeast
 Missouri the last time at home for Family Weekend, the Skyhawks have won 25 of their last 30 contests at
 home since 2019 including a 19-3 record over the past four seasons. Against OVC-Big South opponents, the
 Skyhawks are even better, boasting a 14-1 record since 2020 at home.
- The Skyhawks (1-5, 1-1 OVC-Big South) dropped their most recent contest on the road to Association member Lindenwood by a final margin of 30-14. Quarterback Jase Bauer found the endzone in the second quarter with his third rushing touchdown of the season before backup quarterback Julian Calvez found Shawn Hardy II for a touchdown connection in the final seconds of the contest.
- Western Illinois (1-5, 0-2 OVC-Big South) enters the contest looking to snap a three-game losing streak
 – including back-to-back Association contests. Last week the Leathernecks struggled on the road, falling to
 No. 9 Tennessee Tech by a 66-20 margin. Despite the setback, quarterback Cason Carswell was tabbed as the
 Association's Freshman of the Week after throwing for 343 yards and two touchdowns.
- This marks the fourth meeting between the two programs with UT Martin holding a 2-1 advantage in the alltime series. The Skyhawks have won the last two meetings in 2022 and 2024 while averaging 43.5 points per game in those contests and winning by an average margin of 22.5 points per game.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 19 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to an 124-92 record (.574 winning percentage) and a 93-50 mark against conference opponents (.650 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 174 all-conference players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 124 career victories rank third in OVC history while his 93 conference wins also sit in third place – with both totals only trailing Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky) and Boots Donnelly (Austin Peay/Middle Tennessee). Included in those victories are two wins over Football Bowl Subdivision programs with upset victories against Memphis (2012, 20-17) and Kennesaw State (2024, 24-13).

Six of the program's 10 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all six at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He is responsible for the program's only OVC championship teams in 2006, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2004. The 2006 team ended the season ranked No. 13 nationally with a 9-3 record while the 2021 team won the first playoff game in the Division I Era and finished the campaign ranked No. 12 nationally with a 10-3 overall mark. The Skyhawks completed back-to-back league titles with a 2022 championship after going 7-4 overall while posting the program's first unbeaten conference slate with a 5-0 record. The squad then rattled off a three-peat in the inaugural season of the Big South-OVC Football Association with an 8-3 overall mark while going 5-1 in league action. The program then became just the fifth in OVC history to win four or more consecutive titles after boasting a 9-5 record and advancing to the second round of the FCS playoff.

A note to UTM Supporters...

UT Martin's athletics department adheres to the rules and regulations of the NCAA and Ohio Valley Conference to protect the eligibility of our student-athletes. As a supporter of UTM Athletics, please do not provide any "extra benefits" to UTM student-athletes. The NCAA defines "extra benefits" as any special arrangement provided to a student-athlete or a student-athlete's family/friend that is not available to all other students at UT Martin. Therefore, please be aware of the following:

- Do **NOT** provide gifts, free or reduced cost services including meals, drinks, clothing, laundry, haircuts, legal fees or other benefits to student-athletes and their family and friends
- Do NOT provide tickets to any athletic, institutional, or community event for a student-athlete or their family friends.
- Do NOT provide cash, entertainment, use of your home, or other items of value.
- Do NOT provide the use of an automobile.
- Do NOT provide rent free or reduced cost housing for any length of time.
- Do NOT provide student-athletes with special discounts, payment arrangements (e.g., co-sign a loan), credit on a purchase, or services.
- Do NOT use student-athletes for the purpose of advertising, endorsing, or promoting commercial products or services.
- You MAY provide a meal to UTM student-athletes on an infrequent, special occasion at your home or UTM campus.
- You MAY employ a student-athlete in the same manner as the general public and provide compensation for work actually performed at the going rate for similar services.

The acceptance by a student-athlete of any of the above extra benefits is a violation of NCAA regulations and places the student-athlete's eligibility for intercollegiate competition in jeopardy. 
