SETTING THE SCENE

» The University of Tennessee at Martin football program hits the road this weekend with a inaugural visit to Hunter Stadium to take on OVC-Big South Football Association foe Lindenwood on Saturday, Oct. 4. Kickoff is slated for 1 p.m. and will be broadcast exclusively on ESPN+.

» The Skyhawks (1-4, 1-0 OVC-Big South) picked up their first win of the season last weekend with an impressive 34-10 victory over long-time rival Southeast Missouri. UT Martin scored on the first play of the game and never looked back as the squad outgained the Redhawks by 229 yards while holding them to just 30 rushing yards.

» Highlighting several standout performances was the play of quarterback Jase Bauer and outside linebacker Keyshawn Johnson who both earned OVC-Big South Player of the Week honors. Bauer accumulated 332 yards of total offense while combining for four touchdowns – including two through the air and two on the ground. Johnson was a menace in the backfield where he tallied seven total tackles and 2.5 tackles for loss – including a pair of sacks – while adding three quarterback hurries in the victory.

» UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson picked up the 125th victory of his decorated career. The 20-year veteran sits securely in third place among OVC leaders in career victories while possessing a 22-4 record against league foes since 2021.

» Lindenwood (2-3, 1-0 OVC-Big South) dropped its most recent contest to FBS foe Miami (Ohio) by a 38-0 margin following back-to-back FCS victories against Charleston Southern (35-28) and Stony Brook (30-27). Under the direction of head coach Jed Stugart, the Lions boast an offense which averages 18.2 points per game behind quarterback Nate Glantz who has throw for 1,117 yards and five touchdowns this season while primary target Rico Bond has hauled in 25 receptions for 327 yards and four touchdowns.

» Saturday's contest marks the third meeting between the two programs. UT Martin has won both matchups – including a non-conference meeting in 2022 – before picking up a thrilling 33-26 overtime victory in the regular season finale last season.



PLAYER TO WATCH

Senior receiver **Bryce Bailey** posted the best game of his career against Southeast Missouri after setting career highs in receiving yards (135) and receiving touchdowns (two).

Bailey hauled in a deep ball and took it to the house for a 75-yard touchdown on the opening play of the game before adding another scoring snag in the second quarter with a 21-yard leaping play.

Bailey leads the Skyhawks in receptions, yards and touchdowns while ranking fifth in receiving yards per game in the OVC-Big South.

QUICK HITS



BAUER & JOHNSON NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

» After an impressive win over Southeast Missouri, the Skyhawk tandem of quarterback Jase Bauer (offensive) and outside linebacker Keyshawn Johnson (defensive) garnered OVC-Big South Football Association Player of the Week honors.

» Bauer accounted for 332 yards of total offense and four touchdowns as UT Martin topped Southeast Missouri 34-10 for its first victory of the season. The senior completed 15-of-22 passes for 225 yards and two touchdowns and carried the ball 15 times for 107 yards (7.1 ypc) and two additional touchdowns. It marked the first UTM quarterback to rush for 100 yards since the 2005 season (Brady Wahlberg).

» Johnson had seven tackles (three solo), 2.5 tackles for loss (for -9 yards), 2.0 total sacks and three quarterback hurries as UT Martin topped Southeast Missouri to win its League opener. He helped key a Skyhawk defense that limited SEMO to just 239 yards of total offense (including 30 rushing yards).

100-YARD RUSHING GAMES BY QB

» Skyhawk quarterback Jase Bauer racked up a game-high 107 rushing yards in the team's win over Southeast Missouri. Bauer's performance marked the first 100-yard rushing outing by a UT Martin quarterback since Brady Wahlberg rushed for 100 yards against Jacksonville State on Oct. 15, 2005. Overall, Bauer is just the third individual in the program's Division I history to eclipse the 100-yard rushing mark - joining former quarterbacks Robert Hines and Brady Wahlberg.

SIMPSON RANKS THIRD ALL-TIME IN OVC

» UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson currently sits third in OVC history with 124 career victories. With his win against Gardner-Webb on Oct. 5 he surpassed former Middle Tennessee coach Charles Murphy. Now in his 19th season at UTM, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while sitting first among active OVC coaches in victories.

» In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 93-50 through 20 seasons, more than quadrupling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 93 conference wins rank third in OVC history.

OVC SUPREMACY

» Since the 2006 season, UT Martin ranks as the winningest active member in the Ohio Valley Conference with 93 victories. After winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league, the Skyhawks are 93-50 since 2006 while sitting 19 wins above the closest program in Eastern Illinois (74-68) during that span. The Skyhawks have finished .500 or above in conference play in 17 of the last 19 seasons - including nine top-two finishes.

FOUR STRAIGHT LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIPS

» Regardless of conference affiliation, UT Martin has won at least a share of four consecutive conference championships. The streak began with an outright Ohio Valley Conference title in 2021 before sharing another OVC title in 2022. After a conference merger with the Big South, the Skyhawks have claimed a piece of back-to-back Big South-OVC Football Association crowns in 2023 and 2024.

» UT Martin is the just the fifth program to win four or more consecutive titles in the OVC's history and only trails a five-year run by Jacksonville State from 2014-18.

HOME SWEET HOME

» UT Martin has found success at Hardy Graham Stadium with three unbeaten campaigns in the last four years. Additionally, the Skyhawks have won 25 of their last 30 contests at home since 2019 - including a 19-3 record over the past four seasons. Against OVC-Big South opponents, the Skyhawks have lost just one game since Apr. 3, 2020 - a record of 14-1.

UT MARTIN PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION POLL

» After winning four consecutive league championships, including a share of back-to-back OVC-Big South Football Association championship, UT Martin has been picked to finish second in the association's annual preseason poll. The Skyhawks received 56 points and two first place votes - finishing out point out of first place - to finish second.

OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

» This is the third season of the OVC-Big South Football Association. The Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The modified agreement will now extend through at least 2030.

» Schools in the association are Charleston Southern, Eastern Illinois, Gardner-Webb, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois.

SKYHAWKS FORCE THREE TURNOVERS VS SIU

» UT Martin forced a season-high three turnovers in the team's home opener against Southern Illinois. The Skyhawks recorded their first interception of the season in the first quarter when **Joel Castleberry** snagged a one-handed interception. Then **Tah Mac Bright Banda** hauled in a tipped pass by Lebron Edmond to stall a midfield drive in the second period. The final blow came in the fourth quarter when **Jacob Stevenson** stripped the Salukis a foot prior to the redzone.

BLOCK THAT KICK

» UT Martin did something it had not done in 10 years in its matchup against UTEP by blocking two kicks in one game. The Skyhawks saw **Chris Wilson** block a PAT in the second quarter against the Miners before **Lebron Edmond** swatted a field goal attempt in the fourth quarter. The last time the Skyhawks blocked multiple kicks in one contest was back on Oct. 10, 2010 when the team rejected a pair of field goal attempts by Tennessee State.

JOHNSON CAUSES HAVOC IN BACKFIELD

» Junior outside linebacker **Keyshawn Johnson** has posted a big start to his second season in a Skyhawk uniform by registering sacks in both contests. After tallying two tackles for loss and a 10-yard sack in the season opener against Oklahoma State, he added to his season total with five-yard sack against UTEP in Week 2.

SLINK GETS LOOSE AGAINST UTEP

» Graduate defensive end **Jabaree Dawkins** recorded the best game of his career against UTEP in Week 2. The former offensive lineman has successfully flipped sides of the line and wrecked havoc against the Miners by tallying career highs in tackles (nine) and tackles for loss (2.5) in the contest. His biggest play came in the first quarter when he tallied a six-yard strip sack to force the fumble loose which was recovered and led to a scoring drive just five plays later for the Skyhawks.

MCGOY TABBED AS CONSENSUS ALL-AMERICAN

» After setting a school record with 18 pass breakups and ranking third nationally in passes defended last season, cornerback **JaMichael McGoy, Jr.** enters the 2025 season as a consensus preseason All-American after earning recognitions from FCS Football Central, Phil Steele and Stats Perform.

SKYHAWK DEBUTS

» 26 different players have made their UT Martin debut in the season opener against Oklahoma State. Six Skyhawks made their debut as starters including **Jase Bauer** (QB), **John Gentry** (RB), **Phaizon Wilson** (WR), **Drake Martinez** (TE), **Eric Lane** (LG) and **Tah Mac Bright Banda** (LB).

» Meanwhile, **Thomas Ansley** (RB), **Jordan Beasley** (WR), **Duston Chavis** (DL), **CJ Cobbins** (CB), **Trey Cotton** (S), **Zamaryion Farmer-McCray** (S), **Cade Hechter** (K), **Jordan Johnson** (S), **Hayden King** (LS), **Jordan Lee** (S), **Burke Mickelsen** (TE), **Mike Moment** (OL), **Deuce Oliver** (WR), **Ty Perry** (DL), **Stefan Ponder** (LB), **Cameron Powell** (S), **Iese Puni** (LB), **Chris Rhodes** (CB), **Ajai Russell** (OLB) and **Brandon Sims** (KO) also made their debuts.

UNLIKELY PASSING CONNECTION

» The Skyhawks got on the board for the first time in 2025 with a bit of trickery as wide receiver **Bryce Bailey** converted a perfect pass to running back **John Gentry** for a 39-yard touchdown in the first quarter against Oklahoma State. The play marked the first collegiate pass attempt for Bailey and first touchdown of Gentry's Skyhawk career.

QUICK HITS

**MCGOY NAMED BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD FINALIST**

» Cornerback **JaMichael McGoy, Jr.** is regarded as one of the best defensive players in the country after being named a finalist for the prestigious Buck Buchanan Award by Stats Perform. The 2025 Buck Buchanan Award celebrates its 31th anniversary season and is presented to the national defensive player of the year in Division I FCS college football. The award is named for legendary defensive lineman Junious "Buck" Buchanan, who starred at Grambling State as part of his Hall of Fame career.

» A 2024 first-team OVC-Big South selection, McGoy ranked third nationally with 1.5 pass breakups per game while leading the Association with 18 pass breakups. He also tallied three interceptions – including one featured on SportsCenter Top 10 with a one-handed snag against nationally ranked New Hampshire in the first round of the FCS playoffs. In total, he tallied 43 total tackles and three TFLs.

THREE TEAMS FROM BIG SOUTH-OVC IN PLAYOFFS

» Three members of the OVC-Big South Football Association earned bids to the 2024 NCAA Division I Football Championship. Southeast Missouri won the Association's automatic bid while both Tennessee State and UT Martin earned at-large bids. It marked just the second time that three members of the OVC have earned playoff bids – joining a group in 2013 which saw all three teams win their first round matchups.

DIPPING INTO THE TRANSFER PORTAL

» The Skyhawks added to a veteran return group this offseason by dipping into the transfer portal and acquiring talent. UT Martin welcomes in 15 FBS/FCS transfers, including **Tah Mac Bright Banda** (Lamar), **Jase Bauer** (Sam Houston), **Jordan Beasley** (Middle Tennessee), **Tanner Bushee** (Charlotte), **Kaleb Costner** (Stetson), **John Gentry** (Sam Houston), **Armoni Goodwin** (UAB), **Ashton Guilbeau** (Southeastern Louisiana), **Jordan Johnson** (Southern Miss), **Polo Mahoni** (FIU), **Drake Martinez** (Houston Christian), **Jeff Miller** (West Georgia), **Mike Moment** (WKU), **Ty Perry** (Troy), **Keyshaun Pipkin** (Northern Illinois), **Cameron Powell** (Western Michigan), **Iese Puni** (West Georgia), **Eunique Valentine** (Missouri State), **Phaizon Wilson** (Akron) and **Dazalin Worsham** (West Georgia).

TENNESSEE TOUGH, MARTIN MADE

» Under the direction of head coach **Jason Simpson**, the Skyhawks have taken pride in winning games against in-state opponents. Since 2014, the Skyhawks have posted a 26-9 record against in-state foes while possessing the second-best overall winning percentage of all Division I programs in the state (FBS and FCS) since 2010 at 57.0 percent.

EIGHT SKYHAWKS NAMED BIG SOUTH-OVC PRESEASON PLAYERS TO WATCH LIST

» Eight Skyhawk were named to the OVC-Big SouthFootball Association Preseason Player to Watch List. The Skyhawk group includes five players on offense, two on defense and one specialist. The team was headlined by quarterback **Jase Bauer**, running back **Armoni Goodwin**, wide receiver **Phaizon Wilson**, tight end **Drake Martinez**, offensive lineman **Josiah Tingley**, linebacker **Tah Mac Bright Banda**, defensive back **JaMichael McGoy, Jr.** and punter **Jaren Van Winkle**.

SKYHAWKS VS FBS

» UT Martin has played 33 different FBS games since 2006, including a stretch from 2011-16 in which UT Martin played at least two FBS games per year. The Skyhawks are 2-31 in games against FBS opponents under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson.

» UT Martin will play three FBS opponents this season with Oklahoma State (Aug. 28), UTEP (Sept. 6) and Missouri State (Sept. 20). This marks the second time the program has played three FBS opponents in a single season – matching the 2016 campaign which traveled to Cincinnati, Hawai'i and Georgia State.

The longest tenured head football coach in the Ohio Valley Conference is Jason Simpson, who has transformed the University of Tennessee at Martin program into one of the winningest teams in the OVC since his first season in 2006.

In 19 years, Simpson has led UT Martin to a 124-92 record (.574 winning percentage) and a 93-50 mark against conference opponents (.650 winning percentage). That comes after the program had won 20 OVC games in its first 14 seasons in the league. He also has presided over 174 all-conference players after the program tallied 33 such players in its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

Simpson's 124 career victories rank third in OVC history while his 93 conference wins also sit in third place – with both totals only trailing Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky) and Boots Donnelly (Austin Peay/Middle Tennessee). Included in those victories are two wins over Football Bowl Subdivision programs with upset victories against Memphis (2012, 20-17) and Kennesaw State (2024, 24-13).

Six of the program's 10 8-win seasons have come under Simpson, including all six at the Football Championship Subdivision level. He is responsible for the program's only OVC championship teams in 2006, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024. The 2006 team ended the season ranked No. 13 nationally with a 9-3 record while the 2021 team won the first playoff game in the Division I Era and finished the campaign ranked No. 12 nationally with a 10-3 overall mark. The Skyhawks completed back-to-back league titles with a 2022 championship after going 7-4 overall while posting the program's first unbeaten conference slate with a 5-0 record. The squad then rattled off a three-peat in the inaugural season of the Big South-OVC Football Association with an 8-3 overall mark while going 5-1 in league action. The program then became just the fifth in OVC history to win four or more consecutive titles after boasting a 9-5 record and advancing to the second round of the FCS playoffs.

Simpson is a four-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award in 2006, 2012, 2016 and 2021 while finishing fourth overall in 2006. He is also a two-time recipient of the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year award in 2006 and 2021 while being named the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year in 2006, his debut season at UT Martin.

A total of 41 Skyhawks have been named an All-American under Simpson. A collection of those players include Alex Atkins (2006), Oshae Baker (2024), Tony Bell (2013, 2014), Josh Bey (2009), Jessie Burton (2006), Jeremy Butler (2013), Drake Carroll (2024), Don Chapman (2006), Daylan Dotson (2022), Christian Dowell (2024), CJ Estelle (2011), John H. Ford II (2022), Joe Gibbs (2009), Matthan Hatchie (2021, 2022),

Montori Hughes (2012), Chris Hunter, Jr. (2024), Ben Johnson (2013), JaMichael McGoy, Jr. (2024), Dontrell Miller (2008), Charles Perkins (2023, 2024), Brock Powers (2022), Jaylon Sharpe (2024), Quentin Sims (2012), Vance Van Every (2024), Ray Williams (2008), Rodney Williams II (2020), Terry Williams (2019) and Josh Yarbrough (2007).

Simpson has also overseen the development of seven major award winners, 74 all-conference first team honorees, 80 second team selections and 20 OVC All-Newcomer picks. The Skyhawks have had two OVC Offensive Players of the Year in Don Chapman (2006) and Keon Howard (2021) and one OVC Defensive Player of the Year with John H. Ford II (2022). He also oversaw the development of Big South-OVC Special Teams Player of the Year Aidan Laros during the 2023 campaign. They have also boasted three OVC Freshmen of the Year honorees in Don Chapman (2004), John Bachus III (2019) and Sam Franklin (2022).

Two Skyhawks have been drafted during the Simpson Era with wide receiver Colton Dowell (2023) and defensive tackle Montori Hughes (2012) hearing their names called on the final day of their respective drafts. Hughes was taken in the fifth round (139th pick) of the 2012 NFL Draft by the Indianapolis Colts while Dowell was selected in the seventh round (228th pick) in 2023 by the Tennessee Titans.

The program had a shining moment in 2023 when three former Skyhawks earned spots on active NFL rosters with Dowell (Tennessee Titans), Rodney Williams II (Pittsburgh Steelers) and Dresser Winn (Los Angeles Rams) representing UT Martin. Since 2011, Gibbs (St. Louis Rams, Green Bay Packers), Sims (Atlanta Falcons, New England Patriots), Derek Carr (New York Giants), Johnson (Kansas City Chiefs), Butler (Baltimore Ravens), DJ Roberts (Baltimore Ravens), Abou Toure (Indianapolis Colts), Charles Sweeton (Kansas City Chiefs), Bell (Tennessee Titans), Corey Jordan (Jacksonville Jaguars), Caylon Weathers (Chicago Bears), Brett Thompson (Pittsburgh Steelers), Joe Este (Tennessee Titans), Jaylon Moore (Baltimore Ravens), Donnell Williams (Tennessee Titans and Washington Commanders), Rodney Williams II (Denver Broncos), Dowell (Tennessee Titans), Winn (Los Angeles Rams), Christian Dowell (Denver Broncos), Tevin Shipp (Indianapolis Colts and Seattle Seahawks), DeVonte Tanksley (Miami Dolphins) and Kinkead Dent (Jacksonville Jaguars) have all received opportunities with NFL teams.

Simpson also coached Chapman for two seasons, who became just the 14th Division-I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. He was named the program's first-ever OVC Offensive Player of the Year in 2006.

The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy - which was established in 2007 and is given annually to the best of the OVC teams located in Tennessee - 11 times. The Skyhawks won the trophy in 2010 and shared it in 2012, 2018, 2019 and 2020 while claiming the trophy outright in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2021, 2022 and 2023. UT Martin owns the best record in the Sgt. York Trophy series while boasting a 37-14 all-time mark.

Prior to accepting his first head coaching job at UT Martin, Simpson was the offensive coordinator at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He was instrumental in the resurgence of the UTC football program. In 2005, Chattanooga posted a 6-5 campaign, the school's first winning season since 1997.

Before Chattanooga, Simpson coached at Texas State University, a member of the Southland Football League. He coached quarterbacks, receivers and served as the team's recruiting coordinator. In 2000, Texas State posted a 7-4 record, the school's first winning season in 10 years.

Simpson served as an assistant coach from 1997-1999 at Jacksonville State University. He coached quarterbacks and was the team's passing game coordinator. He also coached receivers and served as an assistant special teams coordinator. He was a member of the Jacksonville State staff responsible for the third best turnaround in Division I football for the 1997 and 1998 seasons.

An Ellisville, Miss. native, Simpson signed as a quarterback with Mississippi State and played for two seasons for the Bulldogs. He also played baseball for Ron Polk at Mississippi State before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992. At Southern Miss, Simpson was a two-time all-conference selection in baseball and was team captain his senior season.

After earning a bachelor's degree in 1994 from Southern Miss, he spent the next year as a graduate assistant football coach at Delta State, where he coached defensive backs. In the spring of 1995, Simpson served as an assistant football and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

Simpson and his wife, the former Julie Wilkerson, have two sons and a daughter: Ty, Emma and Graham. The family lives in Martin and attends First Baptist Church.

MARTIN, Tenn. – It took more than 60 minutes to declare a winner of today's regular season football finale between the University of Tennessee at Martin and Lindenwood but the Skyhawks prevailed via a 33-26 decision at Hardy Graham Stadium.

The victory, combined with a Tennessee Tech and Tennessee State win, resulted in the fourth consecutive conference championship for the UT Martin football program. The Skyhawks conclude the 2024 regular season with an 8-4 overall record and 6-2 mark in Big South-OVC play, tying Southeast Missouri, Tennessee Tech and Tennessee State for the 2024 league crown.

It was an emotional day from the start as 16 members of the squad were recognized with a pregame Senior Day ceremony. UT Martin took its first lead of the day with 1:45 to go in the third quarter before the Lions (5-7, 4-4 Big South-OVC) forced overtime with the game-tying touchdown and ensuing two-point conversion with 32 seconds remaining in regulation. The Skyhawks got the ball first in overtime and scored on five plays, capped off with a 1-yard pass from Kinkead Dent to Tyler Dostin. UT Martin's defense then flexed its muscles, pushing the Lindenwood offense back 22 yards with a pair of sacks, a pass interference penalty and a game-ending interception by JaMichael McGoy, Jr. in the endzone.

Trevonte Rucker hauled in a pair of touchdown receptions - his third game this season with multiple catches for scores - as part of a six-catch, 69-yard day while DeVonte Tanksley had a team-high six catches for 69 yards. Kinkead Dent completed 66.7 percent (18-for-27) of his pass attempts for 272 yards and three touchdowns while adding 64 rushing yards on nine carries. Patrick Smith ran for a game-high 80 yards on 15 totes while Glover Cook III contributed a touchdown on the ground for the Skyhawks.

The swarming UT Martin defense tallied 10 tackles for loss, seven sacks, five pass breakups, eight quarterback hurries and two forced fumbles today. Tevin Shipp corralled a game-high 10 tackles for UT Martin with two sacks while Davonte Murray had 2.5 sacks, a forced fumble and six overall stops. Chris Hunter, Jr. (eight tackles, two quarterback hurries), LaMarion Pierce (seven tackles, one tackle for loss, three pass breakups), Jaylon Sharpe (seven tackles, one sack, one interception), Taylor Burton (1.5 tackles for loss, one fumble recovery) and Charles Perkins (one sack, one forced fumble) also enjoyed big games for the Skyhawk defense.

On special teams, Jaren Van Winkle booted four punts for an average of 46.0 yards, including a long of 52 yards with a pair of punts that landed inside the 20-yard line.

The Lions were paced by quarterback Nate Glantz's 348 passing yards, 42 rushing yards and two combined touchdowns (one passing, one rushing). Jeff Caldwell caught eight passes for 99 yards with a touchdown while Jared Rhodes tacked on a 13-yard rushing score. Defensively, Vincent King's eight tackles led the way.

SKYHAWKS COMPETE THROUGHOUT IN 27-7 SETBACK AT OKLAHOMA STATE

The University of Tennessee at Martin football team battled for all 60 minutes in its season opener tonight but fell by a 27-7 margin to Big 12 Conference member Oklahoma State in front of 44,809 fans at Boone Pickens Stadium.

The Skyhawk defense overcame a slow start to shine for most of the contest, conceding just six points over a near 49-minute span of clock time. UT Martin tallied nine tackles for loss as a unit, putting together three consecutive three-and-outs in the first half and five punts on the Cowboys' 11 drives.

Jacob Stevenson and Shamari Weir paced the Skyhawk defense with seven tackles apiece while Weir had 1.5 tackles for loss (including a sack). Keyshawn Johnson registered a team-best two tackles for loss (including one sack) in his first start in a UT Martin uniform.

Offensively, John Gentry had 96 all-purpose yards in his Skyhawk debut - compiling team-highs of 51 rushing yards on 16 carries and 45 yards on a pair of receptions, including a touchdown. Jase Bauer made the start at quarterback, passing for 70 yards while adding 51 yards on the ground. Wide receiver Bryce Bailey threw UT Martin's touchdown on a trick play while Deuce Oliver hauled in a team-high three receptions.

Jaren Van Winkle punted eight times for an average of 38.6 yards, placing a pair of punts inside the 20-yard line. Cade Hechter split the uprights on his only PAT attempt of the evening for the Skyhawks.

Oklahoma State was led offensively by Zane Flores (136 passing yards), Kalib Hicks (56 yards on 21 carries) and Gavin Freeman (five receptions for 46 yards and one touchdown). Hauss Hejny started the game at quarterback and had a pair of touchdowns (one passing, one rushing) while Sesi Vailahi added a late rushing touchdown. Defensively, Bryan McCoy, Jr. had a game-high 14 tackles while Wendell Gregory (three sacks), Jaleel Johnson (2.5 tackles for loss) and Kale Smith (interception) also stood out for the Cowboys, who won their 30th consecutive home opener - the longest such streak in the Football Bowl Subdivision ranks.

After Oklahoma State scored touchdowns on its first two drives, the Skyhawks executed a double pass for their first score of the season. Bauer found Bailey behind the line of scrimmage on the left side before Bailey perfectly lobbed a strike to a streaking John Gentry for an over-the-shoulder, one-handed snag. The four-play, 65-yard drive sliced UT Martin's deficit in half at 14-7 with 2:15 remaining in the first quarter.

The Skyhawk defense showed out for the remainder of the first half. UT Martin held the Cowboys to three consecutive three-and-outs, allowing just 15 yards on those nine plays. Oklahoma State scored on a 42-yard field goal with 2:43 to go before halftime to make the score 17-7 at the break.

The Cowboys were limited to just a field goal in the third quarter but a costly Skyhawk interception in the redzone paired with a late touchdown was enough to solidify the victory for Oklahoma State.

SKYHAWKS FALL AT FBS FOE UTEP

The second quarter proved costly for the University of Tennessee at Martin football squad this evening as the Skyhawks fell 42-17 at Conference USA member UTEP.

The contest was in a 43-minute lightning delay late in the first quarter but that didn't stop UT Martin from doubling up the host Miners in total yards (92 to 46) while holding an 11:25 to 3:35 advantage in time of possession through 15 minutes of play.

A turnover created by the Skyhawk defense led to a UT Martin touchdown on the first play of the second quarter, knotting the score at 7-all. However, UTEP scored 21 unanswered points to close out the first half on the way to the win.

As a team, the Skyhawks passed for 295 yards tonight – their highest since throwing for 318 yards at Tennessee Tech on Nov. 4, 2023. Jase Bauer completed 69.7 percent (23-for-33) of his passes for 273 yards and a touchdown while Julian Calvez added a 22-yard completion late in the fourth quarter. Phaizon Wilson snatched a game-high seven receptions for 74 yards and a touchdown while Bryce Bailey had four catches for a team-best 92 yards – including a 71-yard snag in the second quarter – and a rushing touchdown.

Jabaree Dawkins had a standout game defensively for UT Martin, making a team-high nine tackles with 2.5 tackles for loss, a sack and a forced fumble. Jacob Stevenson tallied eight tackles while Shamari Weir (sack), Keyshawn Johnson (sack), Chris Wilson (blocked PAT) and Lebron Edmond (fumble recovery, blocked field goal) also contributed big plays for the Skyhawk defense.

On special teams, Cade Hechter was 2-for-2 in PAT's while adding a 21-yard field goal. Jaren Van Winkle booted six punts for an average of 47.0 yards per punt with a long of 56. Jordan Beasley averaged 19.8 yards over four kick returns for the Skyhawks (0-2).

The Miners were paced by Malachi Nelson's 278 passing yards and four touchdowns. Ashten Emory (three total touchdowns), Hahsaun Wilson (117 rushing yards, one touchdown), Kenny Odom (124 receiving yards, one touchdown) and Toric Goins, Jr. (105 receiving yards, one touchdown) guided the UTEP offense while Micah Davey (14 tackles) and Neil Campbell (2.5 tackles for loss) led the Miners defensively.

UT MARTIN DROPS HOME OPENER TO #14 SIU

The University of Tennessee at Martin football team held its home opener at Hardy Graham Stadium but could not slow down a high-powered No. 14 ranked Southern Illinois squad in a 37-10 loss Saturday night.

The Skyhawks (0-3) dropped their third straight game after a disappointing performance in the team's home opener against a nationally ranked foe. UT Martin was outgained offensively by a 490-to-291-yard margin with No. 14 Southern Illinois racking up a season-high 273 rushing yards.

UT Martin put 10 points on the board courtesy of a two-yard scoring pass from Jase Bauer to Drake Martinez in the second quarter while adding a 33-yard field goal by Cade Hechter in the third to cap off the evening's scoring performance.

Bauer completed 22-of-29 pass attempts for 173 yards and one touchdown. He also added 52 yards rushing. John Gentry rolled off a big 25-yard gain but finished the night with 42 yards on the ground while Bryce Bailey paced the team with six receptions for 70 yards.

On the defensive side of the ball, the safety tandem of Josh Hastings and Jacob Stevenson combined for 24 total tackles, 2.0 tackles for loss and a forced fumble. Hastings led the way with a game and career-high 13 tackles in the contest while adding 1.5 tackles for loss totaling nine yards. Stevenson reached double-digits with 11 tackles while stalling a potential scoring opportunity by the Salukis as he stripped Williams right before he crossed the endzone.

In total, the Skyhawks forced three turnovers in the contest as the squad tallied a pair of interceptions and the forced fumble. Joel Castleberry had a one-handed snag in the first quarter before Tah Mac Bright Banda hauled in a tipped pass by Lebron Edmond to thwart a midfield drive early in the second period.

Southern Illinois (2-1) picked up its second win of the season behind an impressive performance from veteran quarterback DJ Williams who racked up 245 yards of total offense – including 128 yards on the ground – while totaling four touchdowns. While Williams found the endzone three times on the ground, Chandler Chapman (44-yard rushing touchdown) and Fabian McCray (56-yard reception) also posted big scoring plays for the Salukis.

SKYHAWKS FALL AT FBS MEMBER MISSOURI STATE

The University of Tennessee at Martin's third Football Bowl Subdivision opponent of the early 2025 season proved to be too much as the Skyhawks dropped a 42-10 decision at Missouri State this evening.

In their first season participating in Conference USA, the Bears (2-2) scored 21 points in the first quarter en route to a 35-0 halftime lead. After Missouri State scored seven points in the third quarter, UT Martin (0-4) tallied the final 10 points of the contest – all coming in the final 15 minutes.

Tommy Ansley scored his first touchdown in a Skyhawk uniform while Jase Bauer completed 70.4 percent (19-for-27) of his passes for 112 yards and had a team-high seven carries. Scottie Alexander, Shawn Hardy II and Armoni Goodwin each had a team-best three receptions for UT Martin.

The Skyhawk defense was led by Tah Mac Bright Banda's game-high seven tackles. Toby Camp had six tackles and a sack while Keyshawn Johnson managed a pair of tackles for loss. Lamar Smith (forced fumble) and JaMichael McGoy (two pass breakups also guided UT Martin defensively.

On special teams, Cade Hechter got the Skyhawks on the scoreboard with a 32-yard field goal to cap off a 21-play, 78-yard drive that lasted 11:13. Jaren Van Winkle punted five times for 214 yards (42.8 per punt).

The Bears were led by quarterback Jacob Clark's five total touchdowns (three passing, two rushing) as he threw for 271 yards on 20-of-28 passing. Dash Luke had nine receptions for 110 yards and a touchdown while Shomari Lawrence (rushing), James BlackStrain (receiving) and Connor Lair (receiving) also found the endzone.

SKYHAWKS ROLL TO 34-10 VICTORY OVER OVC-BIG SOUTH FOE SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Four-time defending OVC-Big South Football Association champion University of Tennessee at Martin opened its league schedule with a commanding 34-10 triumph against Southeast Missouri in front of 6,769 fans at Hardy Graham Stadium.

The Skyhawk offense nearly doubled up the visiting Redhawks in total offense, gaining 468 yards to Southeast Missouri's 239 yards. UT Martin scored a pair of touchdowns – including a 75-yard pass play on the first play of the game – in the first 2:16 and never trailed throughout the contest.

Jase Bauer was responsible for four combined touchdowns (two passing, two rushing) and became the first Skyhawk quarterback to rush for over 100 yards since UT Martin Hall of Famer Brady Wahlberg on Oct. 15, 2005. The redshirt senior out of Ankeny, Iowa ran 15 times for 107 yards and completed 15 of his 22 passes for 225 yards.

Bryce Bailey established career-highs in receptions (seven), receiving yards (135) and touchdowns (two) while Tommy Ansley finished with 99 rushing yards on a game-high 16 carries in his first career start for the Skyhawks.

Defensively, Jacob Stevenson led the way with eight tackles while adding three pass breakups and one interception – the first of his Skyhawk career. Outside linebacker Keyshawn Johnson posted a big day in the backfield as he tallied seven tackles and a team-high 2.5 tackles for loss while recording 2.0 total sacks. A dazzling interception by LaMarion Pierce highlighted the stat sheet for the fourth of his career while lese Puni racked up seven tackles, 1.5 TFLs and one forced fumble to pace a UT Martin defense that conceded just three points over the final 46:52 of clock time.

Cade Hechter drilled field goals from 31 and 27 yards out as part of a 10-point effort (4-for-4 PAT's) for the Skyhawks. Jaren Van Winkle booted four punts for an average of 41.2 yards to cap off a successful outing for the UT Martin special teams unit.

Coming off a Football Championship Subdivision playoff berth a year ago, the Redhawks were limited to 30 rushing yards. Brandon Epton, Jr. scored Southeast Missouri's lone touchdown late in the first quarter while Johnny Weber (87 passing yards) and Calvin Gilbert (53 yards on three catches) secured team-highs in their respective statistical categories. Landon Sylvie (11 tackles) and Slade Dollar (10 tackles) paced the Redhawk defense.
