- Saturday's matchup will serve as UT Martin's annual Hall of Fame Game, as the newest members of the UT Martin Athletics Hall of Fame will be recognized as part of the weekend's festivities. In a pregame ceremony, Stefanie Dubach (volleyball, 1999-2002), Dewayne Harper (football, 1991-94), Ben Reeves (golf, 2012-16) and Chris Rushing (volleyball, 1998-2004) will formally be inducted as the Class of 2026.
- The Skyhawks (0-1) will look to bounce back after dropping a 36-24 decision to Central Arkansas in their season opener. UT Martin held a 17-13 advantage late in the second quarter before the Bears scored 16 unanswered points to take control of the contest. Highlighting the game was a 55-yard interception return for a touchdown by safety Trey Cotton and a pair of rushing touchdowns for running back Tommy Ansley.
- The contest gives UT Martin another opportunity to play in front of its home fans at Hardy Graham Stadium before embarking on an extended road stretch. After beginning the season with back-to-back home games, the Skyhawks hit the road for four straight contests and won't return back home to their friendly confines until Oct. 17. The upcoming road stretch includes back-to-back FBS matchups against Big 12 foe West Virginia (Sept. 12) and in-state foe Memphis (Sept. 19) followed by matchups against Austin Peay (Sept. 26) and Tennessee State (Oct. 10).
- Saturday's opponent represents one of the newest programs in college football as Chicago State is competing in its inaugural season in 2026 under head coach Bobby Rome II. The Cougars are playing as an FCS independent and Saturday's trip to Martin will mark the first road game in program history.
- Chicago State (0-1) made its football debut in Week 0 with a matchup against Roosevelt University before ultimately falling 44-28. True freshman quarterback Ashton Pannell highlighted the Cougar offense by completing 29-of-40 passes for 264 yards and three touchdowns. Michael Dabney Jr. scored the first touchdown in Chicago State football history on a five-yard run, while the Cougars also received touchdown receptions from Kymari Gray and Arshawn Powell. Defensively, Armani Itote paced Chicago State with 11 total tackles.

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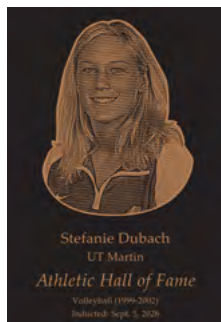
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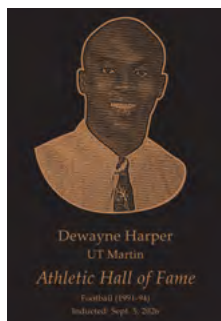
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## UT MARTIN ATHLETICS



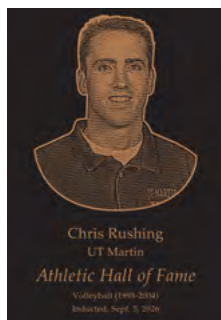
**Stefanie Dubach** played a key part in the program's first two Ohio Valley Conference regular season championships in 2001 and 2002 while punching the school's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament with an OVC Tournament title in 2002. As part of a Skyhawk squad which posted a remarkable 42-6 conference record in her final three seasons, she played in all 443 sets spread out over 120 matches in four seasons under fellow Class of 2026 inductee Chris Rushing. She left the program as the team's all-time leader in digs (1,401) and still ranks in the program's top-10 in service aces (113, seventh) and digs per set (3.16, 10th). Additionally, she still holds the school record for most service aces in a match with eight against Southern Illinois in 2001.



A two-time All-Ohio Valley Conference first team defensive back, **Dewayne Harper** was a key member of the program during its transition to the Division I level. Following his standout career, he still ranks among program leaders in interceptions (13, third), solo tackles (209, fifth), total tackles (339, sixth) and passes defended (29, eighth). He also ranks as the program leader in punt return yardage in a game (183 against Charleston Southern in 1994), season (564 in 1994) and career (955) while sitting atop leaderboards in punt returns in a season (48 in 1994) and career (93). He was named OVC Specialist of the Week in 1994 after returning a pair of punts for touchdowns (87 yards and 73 yards) against Charleston Southern.



Beginning his career with the program's first OVC Freshman of the Year honor, **Ben Reeves** saw his career only take off from there. The two-time All-OVC honoree in 2014 and 2016 became just the second UT Martin golfer to earn multiple All-OVC awards in a career while also adding All-OVC Newcomer honors in 2013. Team success came during his senior season after leading the program to its first-ever OVC Championship in 2016. He also made history as the first Skyhawk golfer to win multiple OVC Golfer of the Week honors after he collected three during his decorated career which saw him with two tournaments - coming at the Frito Lay/Taco Bell Intercollegiate and the F&M Bank APSU Intercollegiate. Finishing his career with 16 top-10 finishes, arguably his best honor came in 2014-15 when he was named the program's first OVC Scholar-Athlete, which is considered the league's highest individual accolade.



A two-time OVC Coach of the Year, **Chris Rushing** left the program as the school's leader in wins with 110 at the NCAA Division I level. He coached UT Martin to its first two OVC regular season championships in 2001 and 2002 while adding an OVC Tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2002. Most notably, he led the Skyhawks to a combined record of 70-20 - including a 42-6 conference mark - over a dominant three-season span from 2000-02. During his tenure he coached 15 All-OVC honorees and 16 OVC Player of the Week selections.

Jason Simpson has established himself as one of the most successful and longest-tenured head coaches in Ohio Valley Conference history during his tenure at the University of Tennessee at Martin. Entering his 21st season at the helm in 2026, Simpson has guided the Skyhawks to a 130-98 overall record, five conference championships and three FCS playoff appearances.

Simpson's 130 career victories rank third in OVC history while his 99 conference wins also sit in third place – with both totals only trailing Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky) and Boots Donnelly (Austin Peay/Middle Tennessee). Included in those victories are two wins over Football Bowl Subdivision programs with upset victories against Memphis (2012, 20-17) and Kennesaw State (2024, 24-13).

Since taking over the program in 2006, Simpson has transformed UT Martin into a consistent contender, earning OVC Roy Kidd Coach of the Year honors twice and AFCA Region 3 Coach of the Year recognition in his first season. He has also been a four-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award. Under his leadership, 44 Skyhawks have earned All-America honors, while numerous players have received all-conference and major individual awards.

Before arriving at UT Martin, Simpson served as offensive coordinator at Chattanooga, quarterbacks coach at Texas State and Jacksonville State, and began his collegiate coaching career as a graduate assistant at Delta State. A former Mississippi State football player and Southern Miss baseball player, Simpson has built a lasting legacy as the winningest head coach in UT Martin football history.
