### SETTING THE SCENE



#### PLAYER TO WATCH

Sophomore safety **Trey Cotton** posted a big game in the season opener by scoring the first points of the season via a 55-yard pick six in the first quarter.

Along with the interception, Cotton tallied nine tackles and forced a fumble in his first career start.

» The University of Tennessee at Martin football team continues its season-opening homestand on Saturday, Sept. 5 when the Skyhawks welcome first-year program Chicago State to Hardy M. Graham Stadium. Kickoff is scheduled for 6 p.m. on ESPN+.

» Saturday's matchup will serve as UT Martin's annual Hall of Fame Game, as the newest members of the UT Martin Athletics Hall of Fame will be recognized as part of the weekend's festivities. In a pregame ceremony, Stefanie Dubach (volleyball, 1999-2002), Dewayne Harper (football, 1991-94), Ben Reeves (golf, 2012-16) and Chris Rushing (volleyball, 1998-2004) will formally be inducted as the Class of 2026.

» The Skyhawks (0-1) will look to bounce back after dropping a 36-24 decision to Central Arkansas in their season opener. UT Martin held a 17-13 advantage late in the second quarter before the Bears scored 16 unanswered points to take control of the contest. Highlighting the game was a 55-yard interception return for a touchdown by safety Trey Cotton and a pair of rushing touchdowns for running back Tommy Ansley.

» The contest gives UT Martin another opportunity to play in front of its home fans at Hardy Graham Stadium before embarking on an extended road stretch. After beginning the season with back-to-back home games, the Skyhawks hit the road for four straight contests and won't return back home to their friendly confines until Oct. 17. The upcoming road stretch includes back-to-back FBS matchups against Big 12 foe West Virginia (Sept. 12) and in-state foe Memphis (Sept. 19) followed by matchups against Austin Peay (Sept. 26) and Tennessee State (Oct. 10).

» Saturday's opponent represents one of the newest programs in college football as Chicago State is competing in its inaugural season in 2026 under head coach Bobby Rome II. The Cougars are playing as an FCS independent and Saturday's trip to Martin will mark the first road game in program history.

» Chicago State (0-1) made its football debut in Week 0 with a matchup against Roosevelt University before ultimately falling 44-28. True freshman quarterback Ashton Pannell highlighted the Cougar offense by completing 29-of-40 passes for 264 yards and three touchdowns. Michael Dabney Jr. scored the first touchdown in Chicago State football history on a five-yard run, while the Cougars also received touchdown receptions from Kymari Gray and Arshawn Powell. Defensively, Armani Itote paced Chicago State with 11 total tackles.

## QUICK HITS

## HOME SWEET HOME

» UT Martin has found success at Hardy Graham Stadium with three unbeaten campaigns in the last four years. Additionally, the Skyhawks have won 27 of their last 33 contests at home since 2019 - including a 21-4 record over the past five seasons. Against OVC opponents, the Skyhawks have lost just one game since Apr. 3, 2020 - a record of 16-1.

## SUCCESS AGAINST THE LAND OF LINCOLN

» UT Martin has found success against programs hailing from the Land of Lincoln in recent years, boasting a 10-1 record against Illinois programs dating back to the 2019 season. Included in that stretch are perfect records against OVC foes Eastern Illinois (7-0) and Western Illinois (3-0).



## BLOCK THAT KICK

» After leading the FCS with eight blocked kicks in 2025, the Skyhawks picked up right where they left off in the season opener against Central Arkansas. On two point after attempts, defensive lineman Chris Wilson blocked a kick - tying the program single game record with Toby Camp (2025) and Dean Wathen (2010) for most blocked kicks in a single game. UT Martin currently leads the FCS once again in 2026 with its two blocked kicks.

## PICK SIX IS 100% COTTON

» Sophomore safety Trey Cotton made the most of his first career start in the season opener against Central Arkansas by catching a tipped pass by Jamal Mayers and returning an interception 55 yards for a touchdown in the first quarter. The interception marked the first of Cotton's career and first pick six for a Skyhawk since the 2024 season when the team returned four for touchdowns.

## ANSLEY PUNCHES IT IN TWICE

» Junior running back Tommy Ansley posted his first multi-touchdown effort in a Skyhawk uniform in the team's season opener against Central Arkansas. Ansley punched in a seven-yard rush in the final minutes of the second quarter before breaking free for a 24-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter.



## SIMPSON RANKS THIRD ALL-TIME IN OVC

» UT Martin head coach Jason Simpson currently sits third in OVC history with 130 career victories. With his win against Gardner-Webb on Oct. 5, 2024 he surpassed former Middle Tennessee coach Charles Murphy. Now in his 20th season at UTM, Simpson ranks as the longest tenured coach in the league while sitting first among active OVC coaches in victories.

» In OVC play alone, Simpson has a career mark of 99-52 through 20 seasons, more than quadrupling the program's 20-win total which stretched through 14 seasons before his tenure. His 99 conference wins rank third in OVC history.

## OVC SUPREMACY

» Since the 2006 season, UT Martin ranks as the winningest active member in the Ohio Valley Conference with 99 victories. After winning just 20 games in the team's first 14 years in the league, the Skyhawks are 99-52 since 2006 while sitting 23 wins above the closest program in Eastern Illinois (76-74) during that span. The Skyhawks have finished .500 or above in conference play in 18 of the last 20 seasons - including 10 top-two finishes.

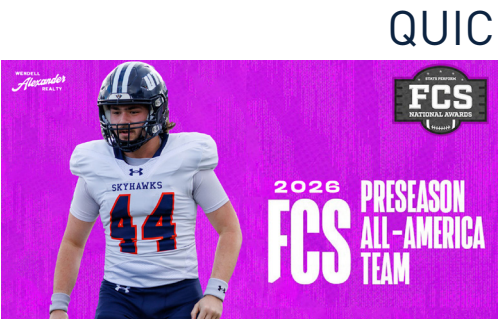
## DEWAYNE HARPER TO JOIN HALL OF FAME

» The Class of 2026 for the UT Martin Hall of Fame will be enshired at a Saturday luncheon. Joining the folds of the immortals will be Stefanie Dubach (volleyball, 1999-2002), Dewayne Harper (football, 1991-94), Ben Reeves (golf, 2012-16) and Chris Rushing (volleyball, 1998-2004).

» A two-time All-OVC first team defensive back, Dewayne Harper will be inducted into the UT Martin Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2026 on Saturday, Sept. 5. Harper was a key member of the program during its transition to the Division I level. Following his standout career, he still ranks among program leaders in interceptions (13, third), solo tackles (209, fifth), total tackles (339, sixth) and passes defended (29, eighth). He also ranks as the program leader in punt return yardage in a game (183 against Charleston Southern in 1994), season (564 in 1994) and career (955) while sitting atop leaderboards in punt returns in a season (48 in 1994) and career (93).

» Harper will become the 85th member of the UT Martin football program to join the Athletics Hall of Fame at his alma mater.

KING NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

>> Veteran long snapper Hayden King was named a preseason first team All-American by both Phil Steele and Stats Perform after earning all-conference first team honors last season. He started all 12 games as the team's primary long snapper and short snapper for a squad which led the country with zero allowed blocked kicks or punts. His specialists converted 95.4 percent of their kick attempts, including 15-of-17 field goal attempts and 27-of-27 PATs. Meanwhile, his punting unit averaged 41.1 yards per punt while adding two tackles on coverage.

UT MARTIN PICKED TO WIN OVC

>> After winning four of the last five conference championships, the Skyhawks are tabbed to return to a championship level in 2026 after being picked to first in the OVC's annual preseason poll. The Skyhawks received 47 total points and six of eight first place votes.

BACK IN THE OVC

>> The 2026 season marks a return to the OVC identity for the football brand. The return to the OVC identity follows three successful years of partnership with the Big South Conference under the names Big South-OVC Football Association (2023, 2024) and OVC-Big South Football Association (2025).

>> Schools who will play OVC football in 2026 are Charleston Southern, Eastern Illinois, Gardner-Webb, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, UT Martin and Western Illinois.

SKYHAWK DEBUTS

>> 20 different players made their UT Martin debut in the season opener against Central Arkansas. Included in that group are seven players who debuted in the starting lineup, including defensive end John Betts III, tight end Kaleb Costner, offensive tackle Travis Gray, offensive tackle Santiago Macias, wide receiver Makhia Sherrard, linebacker Jamarcus Smith and wide receiver Kaleb Washington.

TENNESSEE TOUGH, #MARTINMADE

>> Under the direction of head coach Jason Simpson, the Skyhawks have taken pride in winning games against in-state opponents. Since 2014, the Skyhawks have posted a 27-10 record against in-state foes while possessing the second-best overall winning percentage of all Division I programs in the state (FBS and FCS) since 2010 at 57.2 percent.

QUICK HITS

LIONS, TIGERS AND BEARS (OH MY)

>> The Skyhawks are taking a page out of the Wizard of Oz playbook this season with matchups against Lions (Lindenwood), Tigers (Memphis and Tennessee State) and Bears (Central Arkansas).

TOUGH ROAD STRETCH

>> After starting the season with back-to-back home games for the first time since 2002, UT Martin will then have to hit the road for a grueling four-game stretch. The Skyhawks will travel to Big 12 foe West Virginia (Sept. 5) for a first-time meeting before traveling down I-40 for an in-state matchup against Memphis (Sept. 12). From there the squad will make familiar treks to old OVC foe Austin Peay (Sept. 26) before opening league action against Tennessee State (Oct. 10).

>> The four-game road trip will mark the longest for the program since 2021 when finishing the regular season with two games on the road and a pair of road matchups in the playoffs. When counting regular season only contests, the Skyhawks have not played four consecutive games on the road since 1993 when they finished the year with games at Eastern Kentucky, Samford, Morehead State and Austin Peay.

>> 12 Skyhawk were named to the OVC Preseason Players to Watch List. The Skyhawk group includes five players on offense, three on defense and four specialist. Included is running back Tommy Ansley, wide receiver Phaizon Wilson, tight end Kaleb Costner, offensive lineman Travis Gray, all-purpose performer Chris Franklin, defensive lineman Broderick Tommie, Jr., linebacker Jamarcus Smith, defensive back Trey Cotton, place kicker Brandon Sims, punter Max Zuluaga, punt returner Deuce Oliver and long snapper Hayden King.

BATTLE FOR THE VOLUNTEER STATE

>> Football has been a storied part of the state of Tennessee's history for decades. Dating back to the 2010 season, UT Martin ranks second in the state (including all Division I universities) in winning percentage at 56.9 percent. The Skyhawks are 27-10 against in-state foes since 2014.

>> Earning a spot on the first team was long snapper Hayden King while wide receiver Phaizon Wilson, punter Max Zuluaga and offensive tackle Travis Gray earned spots on the second team. Making the third team was linebacker Jamarcus Smith, safety Trey Cotton, punt return specialist Deuce Oliver and all-purpose performer Chris Franklin.

CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

» Regardless of conference affiliation, UT Martin has won or shared four of the last five conference championships. The Skyhawks won back-to-back OVC championships in 2021 and 2022 before picking up back-to-back league trophies in the OVC-Big South Football Association.
 » UT Martin is the just the fifth program to win four or more consecutive titles in the OVC's history and only trails a five-year run by Jacksonville State from 2014-18.

SKYHAWKS OVER THE LAST FIVE YEARS

» UT Martin has seen unparralled success for the program over the last five season. During that stretch, the Skyhawks have racked four conference championship titles and posted a 27-6 record against conference members.

SKYHAWK TANDEM ECLIPSES 100 YARDS

» The Skyhawks had two players each eclipse 100 rushing yards in the same game for the first time since 2023 last year. Running backs Tommy Ansley (118 yards) and Chris Franklin (111 yards) each set new career highs with their first 100-yard rushing performances in a Skyhawk uniform against Tennessee State. The tandem joins a list of performers from 10 other FCS programs to have two players record 100 rushing yards in the same game.

SEASON 97

» The 2026 campaign is UT Martin's 97th season of football despite suspending play during Great Depression (1933) and World War II (1942-45). The Skyhawks are in their 34th season at the NCAA Division I FCS level. UT Martin joined the NCAA Division I ranks in 1992 and have compiled an overall record of 172-223 with three Ohio Valley Conference titles (2006, 2021 and 2022), two OVC-Big South titles (2023 and 2024) and three NCAA Playoff appearance (2006, 2021 and 2024) as a Division-I program.

Jason Simpson enters his 21st season at the helm of the UT Martin football program in 2026 after transforming the Skyhawks into one of the most consistent and accomplished programs in the Football Championship Subdivision.

Since taking over the program in 2006, Simpson has compiled a 130-99 overall record while posting a remarkable 99-52 mark in conference play. His 130 career victories rank third in Ohio Valley Conference history, while his 99 league wins also stand third all-time behind legendary coaches Roy Kidd and Boots Donnelly.

Under Simpson's leadership, UT Martin has captured five conference championships, earned three FCS playoff berths, produced 45 All-Americans and developed nearly 200 all-conference performers. The Skyhawks have also defeated a pair of Football Bowl Subdivision opponents, knocking off Memphis in 2012 and Kennesaw State in 2024.

Simpson's tenure has produced the most successful sustained stretch in UT Martin's Division I history.

The Skyhawks have claimed conference championships in 2006, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024, including an unprecedented run of four consecutive titles from 2021-24. UT Martin became just the fifth program in OVC history to win at least four straight conference championships.

Six of the program's 10 eight-win seasons have come during Simpson's tenure, including each of UT Martin's six such campaigns at the FCS level.

His teams have also reached the FCS playoffs three times. UT Martin earned its first Division I postseason berth under Simpson in 2006 before returning to the playoffs in 2021 and 2024. The Skyhawks recorded the first two FCS playoff victories in school history during the latter two appearances.

The historic run has earned Simpson recognition among the nation's top coaches. He is a four-time finalist for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award and a two-time OVC Roy Kidd Coach of the Year, earning the league's top coaching honor in 2006 and 2021. Simpson was also selected as the AFCA Region 3 Coach of the Year following his debut season in 2006.

The success of the Simpson era has represented a dramatic shift in UT Martin's standing within its conference.

The Skyhawks have won 99 conference games during his tenure after the program recorded just 20 OVC victories over its first 14 seasons as a league member. Likewise, Simpson has coached 187 all-conference selections after UT Martin totaled only 33 during its first 15 seasons in the OVC.

His program has produced 44 All-Americans, along with 81 first-team all-conference selections, 84 second-team honorees and 20 all-newcomer selections.

Among the major individual award winners developed during Simpson's tenure are OVC Offensive Players of the Year Don Chapman and Keon Howard, along with defensive standouts John H. Ford II and Keyshawn Johnson, who earned conference Defensive Player of the Year honors.

Aidan Laros was named the inaugural Big South-OVC Football Association Special Teams Player of the Year in 2023, while Chapman, John Bachus III and Sam Franklin each earned OVC Freshman of the Year accolades during their Skyhawk careers.

Two Skyhawks have been selected in the NFL Draft during his tenure. Defensive tackle Montori Hughes was selected by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round, while wide receiver Colton Dowell was chosen by the Tennessee Titans in the seventh round of the 2023 NFL Draft. Numerous other Skyhawks have earned opportunities with NFL organizations, including Rodney Williams II, Dresser Winn, Jeremy Butler, Joe Gibbs, Quentin Sims, Jaylon Moore and others. The program enjoyed a particularly noteworthy moment in 2023 when Dowell, Williams and Winn simultaneously held spots on NFL active rosters.

UT Martin has also enjoyed tremendous success against its in-state conference rivals during Simpson's tenure. The Skyhawks have won or shared the Sgt. Alvin C. York Trophy 11 times since the award was established in 2007. UT Martin captured the trophy in 2010 and shared the honor in 2012, 2018, 2019 and 2020 before winning outright in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2021, 2022 and 2023. UT Martin has established the best record in Sgt. York Trophy competition with a 37-14 all-time mark.

Prior to earning his first collegiate head coaching opportunity at UT Martin, Simpson built an extensive résumé as an assistant coach throughout the Southeast. He came to Martin after serving as offensive coordinator at Chattanooga, where he helped engineer the resurgence of the Mocs' program. Chattanooga finished 6-5 in 2005, recording its first winning season since 1997.

Before his stint at Chattanooga, Simpson coached quarterbacks and wide receivers while serving as recruiting coordinator at Texas State. He helped the Bobcats to a 7-4 record in 2000, their first winning season in a decade. Simpson also spent three seasons at Jacksonville State from 1997-99, working with quarterbacks and receivers while serving as passing game coordinator and assistant special teams coordinator. He was part of a staff that engineered one of the largest turnarounds in Division I football during the 1997 and 1998 seasons.

His collegiate coaching career began at Delta State, where he worked as a graduate assistant with the defensive backs after earning his bachelor's degree from Southern Miss in 1994. He also spent time as an assistant football coach and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

A native of Ellisville, Mississippi, Simpson originally signed with Mississippi State as a quarterback and spent two seasons with the Bulldogs football program. A talented two-sport athlete, he also played baseball for legendary Mississippi State head coach Ron Polk before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992. Simpson became a two-time all-conference baseball selection for the Golden Eagles and served as team captain during his senior season before earning his bachelor's degree in 1994.

Simpson and his wife, Julie, have three children – Ty, Emma and Graham. Their oldest son, Ty, played quarterback at Alabama, serving as a team captain and guiding the Crimson Tide to the College Football Playoff quarterfinals before being selected 13th overall by the Los Angeles Rams in the first round of the 2026 NFL Draft.

NO. 22 UT MARTIN FALLS TO CENTRAL ARKANSAS IN 2026 FOOTBALL SEASON OPENER

MARTIN, Tenn. - The No. 22 ranked University of Tennessee at Martin football squad battled tonight in its season opener but fell by a 36-24 margin to Central Arkansas in front of 5,516 fans at Hardy Graham Stadium.

The Skyhawks led late in the second quarter before 16 unanswered points by Central Arkansas tilted the score in favor of the Bears. UT Martin pulled within five points with 9:49 to go in the contest but the Bears answered with the final touchdown of the contest six-plus minutes later.

Sophomore safety Trey Cotton opened the scoring with the Skyhawks' first pick-six since Oct. 26, 2024, taking Central Arkansas' first pass of its second drive 55 yards to the house in the opening quarter. Cotton also forced a fumble while Jamarcus Smith (10 tackles, team-best 1.5 tackles for loss) and Jamal Mayers (nine tackles, three pass breakups) each recorded double-digit stops to pace UT Martin defensively. Chris Wilson additionally blocked a pair of PAT's to tie a school record with Toby Camp (at Lindenwood in 2025) and Dean Wathen (at Murray State in 2010).

Tommy Ansley found the endzone twice out of the Skyhawk backfield, also topping the team with 61 rushing yards on 10 carries. Julian Calvez made his first UT Martin start under center, completing 13 of his 24 passes for 147 yards while adding 37 rushing yards on nine totes. Kaleb Washington tied for the team lead with three catches and tallied a team-best 53 receiving yards in his Skyhawk debut.

Brandon Sims converted a 25-yard field goal in the second quarter, went 3-for-3 in PAT opportunities and placed four of his five kickoff chances for touchbacks. Max Zuluaga also landed his only punt for 48 yards tonight to guide the UT Martin special teams.

"Central Arkansas has a good football team - we don't lose much at home so give them credit," Skyhawk head coach Jason Simpson said. "If you look at the stats, they were 10-of-15 on third downs and we were 3-of-11 and only snapped the ball 57 times. It's a long season and we'll know more about us as we go forward - tonight was some growing pains with 53 new players but we're not going to overreact. We're all in this together - we'll watch the tape, make some adjustments and find an identity for ourselves."
